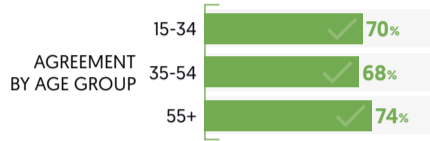


ACCEPTANCE

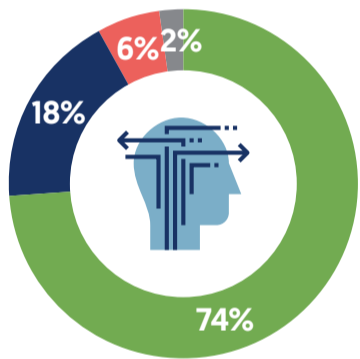

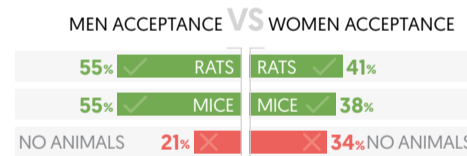
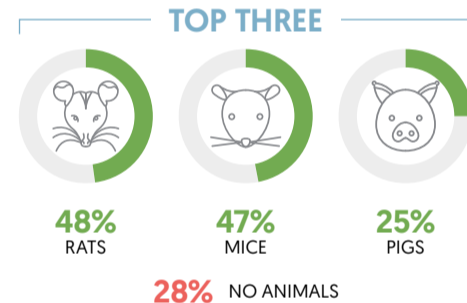
THE UK GOVERNMENT SHOULD BAN THE USE OF ANIMALS FOR ANY FORM OF RESEARCH

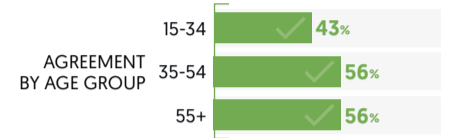
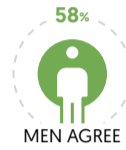

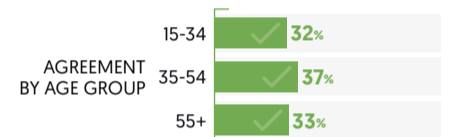


TRUST IN THE REGULATORY SYSTEM

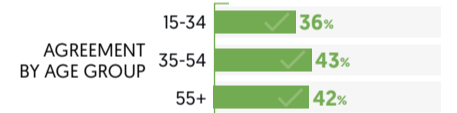
34% BELIEVE THE RULES ARE WELL-ENFORCED



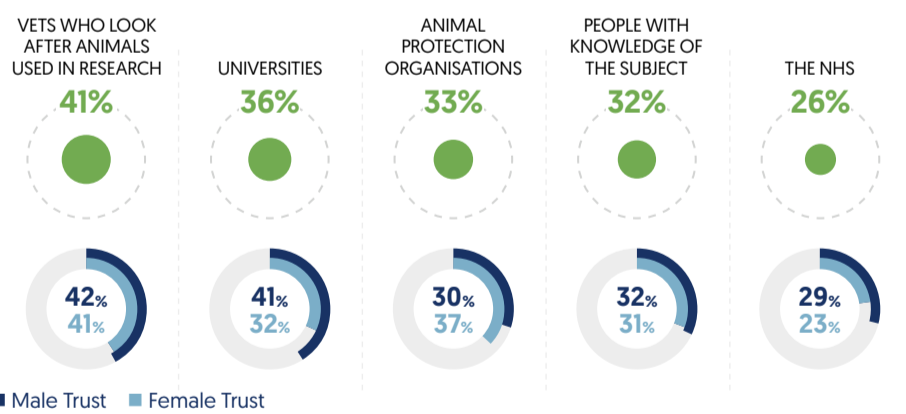
41% TRUST THE REGULATORS TO UNCOVER ANY MISCONDUCT AT ANIMAL RESEARCH FACILITIES

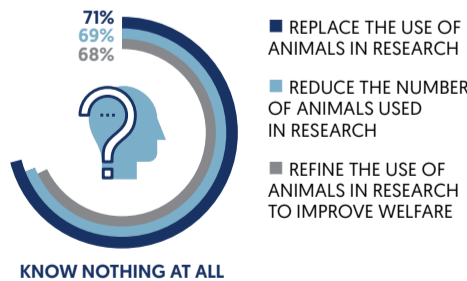
AWARENESS
