

We need someone strong who understands the poor to help the poor






These days I feel like a stranger in my own country

When jobs are scarce, employers should prioritize hiring people of this country over immigrants






### America First & System is Broken Increasingly Political Drivers




#### **Global Perceptions of Broken System**

Q. To what extent, if at all, do you agree or disagree with the following statements? - Traditional parties and politicians don't care about people like me – Agree






#### **Key Drivers: Nativism + System is Broken**


#### **Policy Conditionalities**

	Global Average	Select Countries
The government should control the price of Basic Foodstuffs (staples)	55%	Argentina, 82%
should prioritize hiring [nationalities] over foreigners even if that means slower job growth	42%	Turkey, 72%
should stop terrorism at all costs even if that means ignoring people's civil rights	43%	France, 61%
The government should nationalize natural resources even if this means slower job growth	34%	India, 58%
