Q1. Out of every 100 people in [Country], about how many do you think have access to the internet at home either through a computer or mobile device?

Q2. Out of every 100 people in [Country], about how many do you think do not affiliate themselves with any religion – that is, atheists, agnostics and those who say they do not identify with any religion?

Q3. How old do you think the average person in [country] is?

Q4. Out of every 100 people in [Country], how many do you think are aged 14 or younger?

Q5. Out of every 100 people in [Country] aged 25-64, how many do you think have completed education to university degree level, or higher?

Q6. What do you think the average annual wage for a full-time worker is in [Country]?

Q7a. What proportion of [country's] total household wealth do you think the wealthiest 1% own? When thinking about wealth, we want you to think of the total value of everything someone owns (including their bank account, savings, property, stocks, shares... etc) minus any debt that they owe (like loans and mortgages).

Q7b. And what proportion of [country's] total household wealth do you think the wealthiest 1% ideally should own?

Q8. Out of every 100 people aged 20 years or over in [Country], how many do you think are either overweight or obese?

Q9. What percentage of [politicians in lower or single house – eg in Britain would be Members of Parliament (MPs)]* in [Country] are women?

Q10. What percentage of people in [Country] live in a rural area, that is, outside of a big town or city?

Q11. What percentage of the [Country] population do you think are immigrants to this country (i.e. not born in [Country])?

Q12. Out of every 100 working-age women in [Country], how many do you think are in employment?

Q13. Out of every 100 young adults aged 25-34 in [Country], how many do you think live with their parents?
