
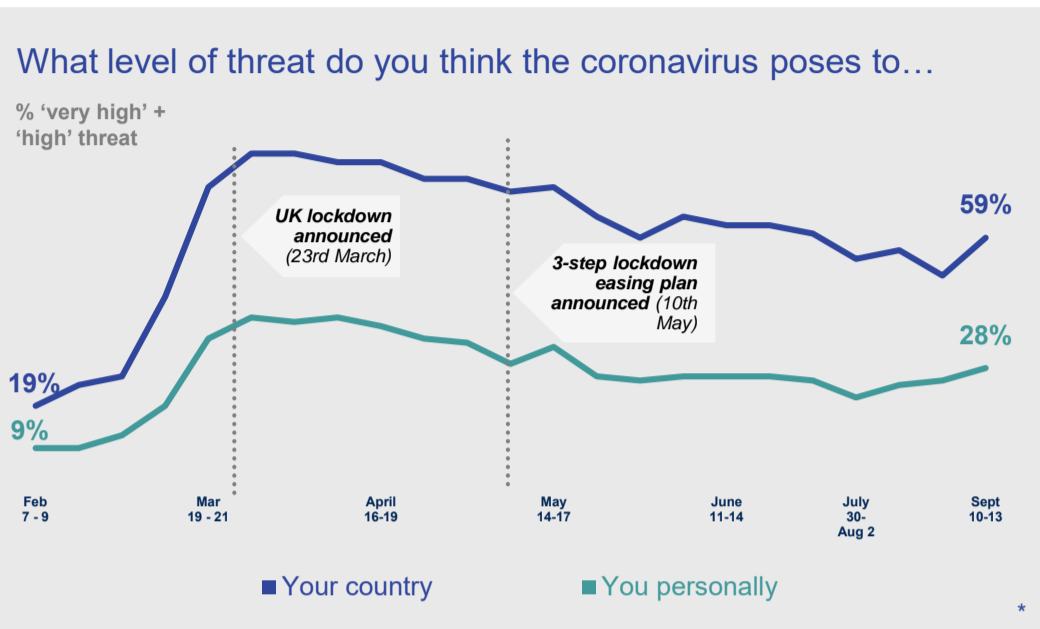

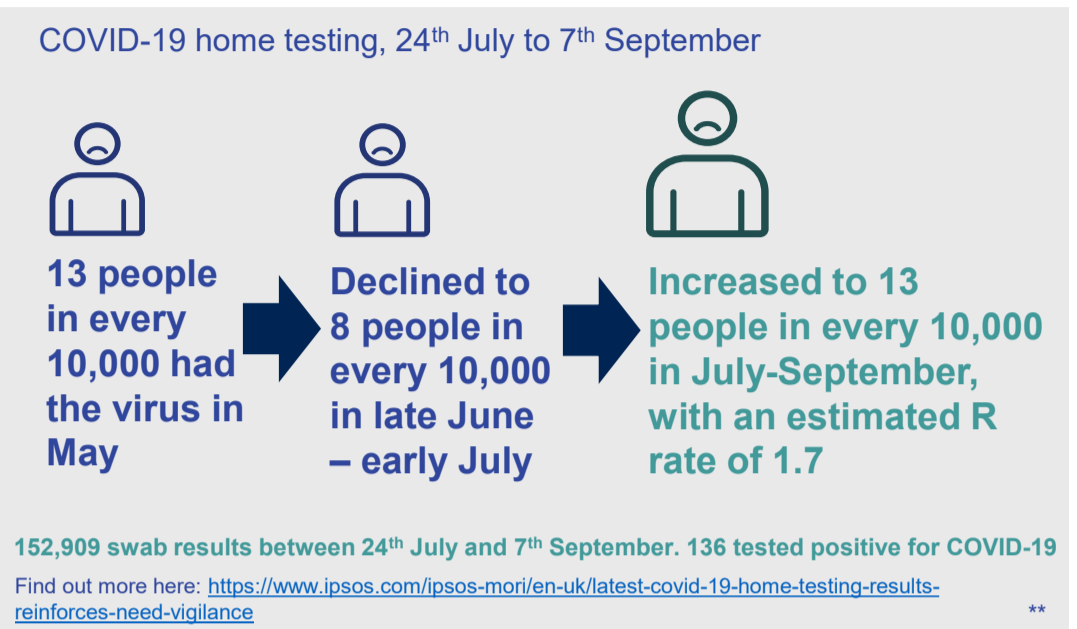
THREAT

Perception of threat gradually dropped since March, but has recently risen again

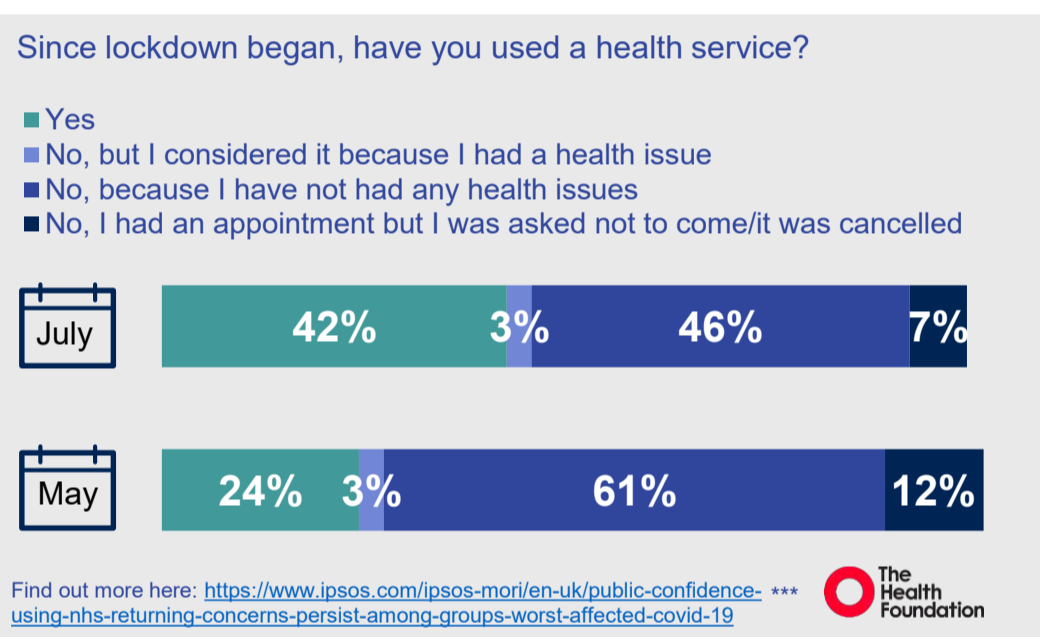
HOME TESTING STUDY

The largest testing programme for coronavirus confirms the need for vigilance across England


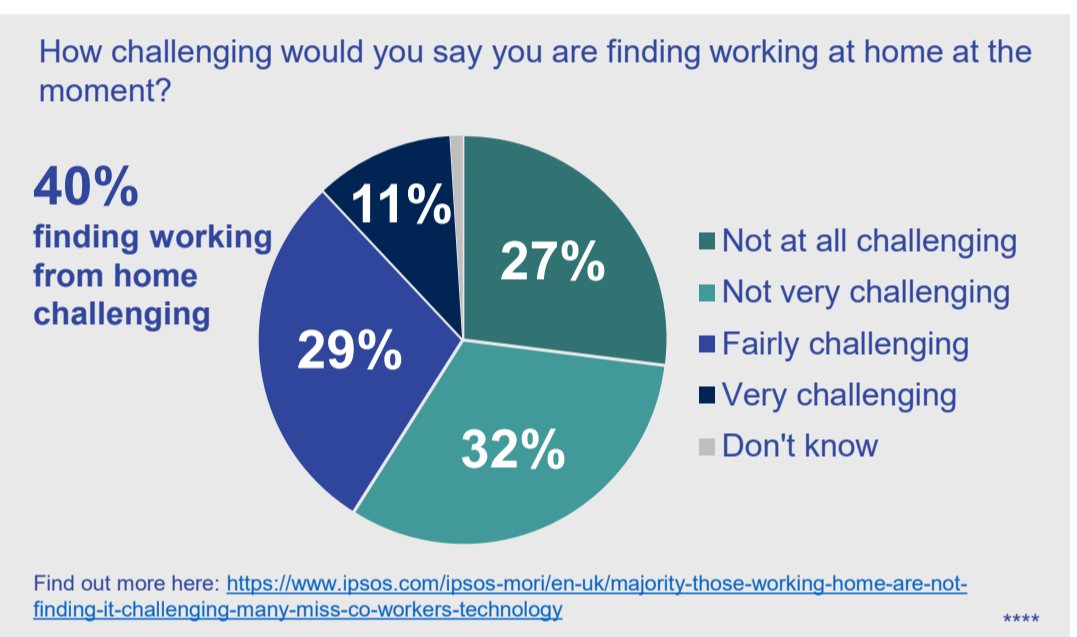
USE OF HEALTH SERVICES

Public confidence in using the NHS is returning


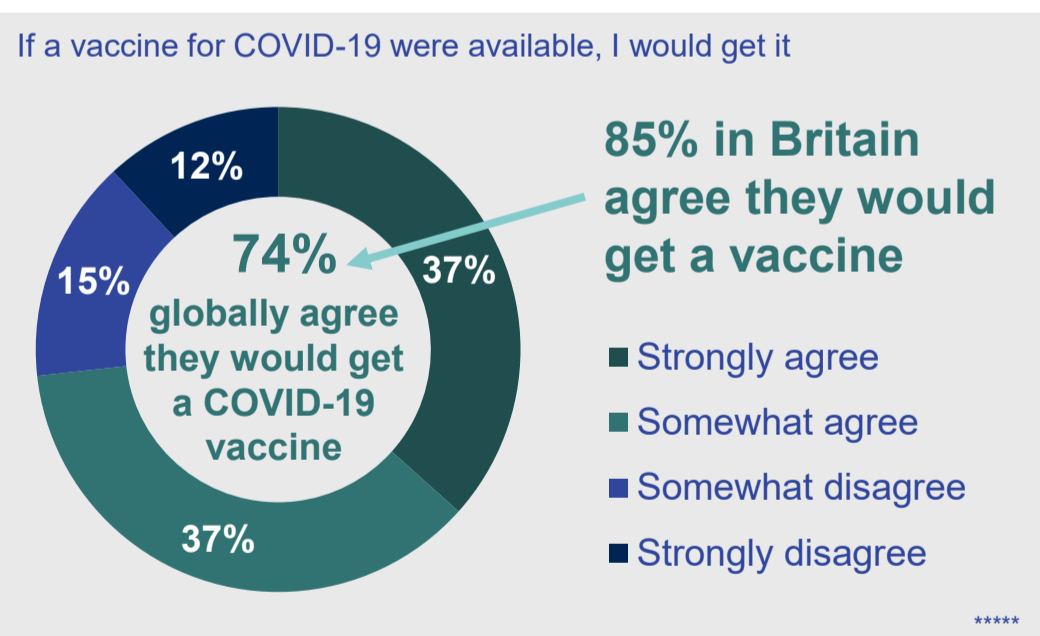
WORKING FROM HOME

The majority of those working from home are not finding doing so challenging


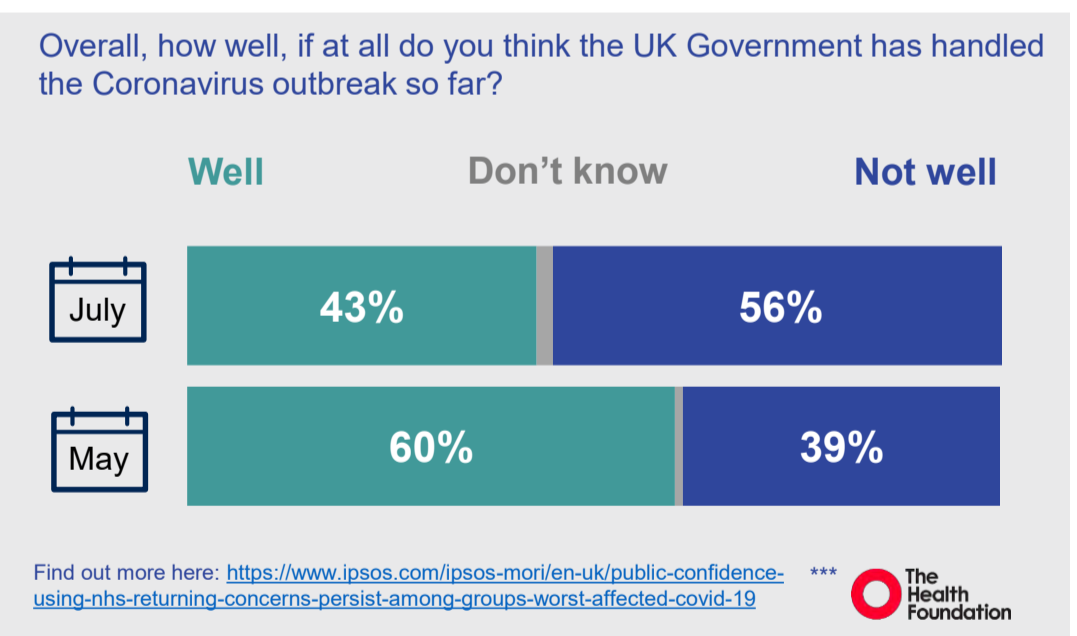
VACCINE

Across 27 countries, three-quarters say they would get a COVID-19 vaccine if one were available

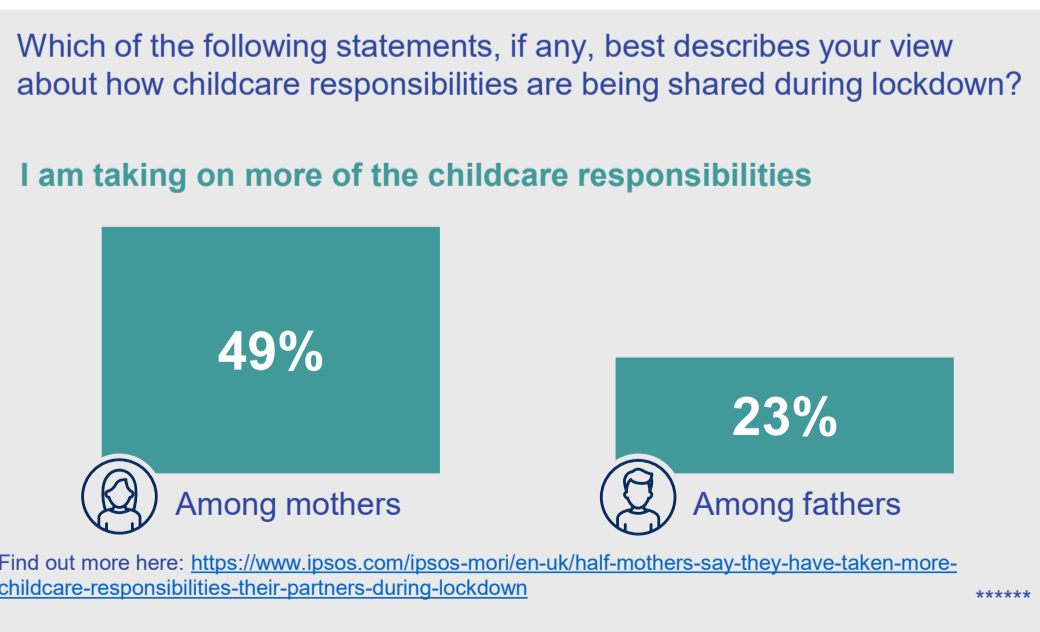
HANDLING OF COVID-19
