Patrick Artus is currently Chief Economist at Natixis and Professor of Economics at PSE (Paris School of Economics).

A graduate of the École Polytechnique, the École Nationale de la Statistique et de l'Administration Economique (ENSAE) and the Institut d'études politiques de Paris, Patrick Artus began his career at the French National Institute of Statistics and Economic Studies (INSEE), where he mainly worked on forecasting and modeling. He then worked at the Economics Department of the OECD (1980), later becoming Head of Research at ENSAE from 1982 to 1985. He subsequently served as Scientific Advisor at the Banque de France Research Department, before moving to the Natixis Group as Head of Research.

He has been a member of the Executive Committee since May 2013. He is also a member of the Cercle des Économistes.
