Laurence Stoclet is a Board Member at Ipsos since 2002. She is a senior executive with extensive experience in Finance, Technology and Management of international operations.

She has recently joined the Board of Ingenico, a global leader in Payment solutions owned by Apollo, and is chairing its Audit Committee.

In 1998, she joined Ipsos as the Group Chief Financial Officer to prepare its IPO, and later was appointed Deputy Chief Executive Officer, position she held until September 2022. In her role, she oversaw more than 100 acquisitions, which contributed to make Ipsos a leader of its industry with presence in 90 countries. She was also managing directly all investments in new technologies and 1,000 talented IT engineers.

With an MBA from ESCP Business School (Banking and Finance), Laurence Stoclet also holds a postgraduate diploma in Accounting. Earlier in her career, she was an intern financial analyst at Goldman Sachs, then spent more than six years at Arthur Andersen, as an Audit and Consulting Manager, and two years at the listed manufacturing company, Metaleurop, as Head of Treasury, Financing and Investor Relations.

She is also a Director of a Chinese fund - "Oneworld" - which invests in big data and marketing platforms in China – and a Director of a Norwegian Company – "Tivian" – which is developing employee and customer experience management software.
