Laurence Stoclet is a member of several Board of directors and Audit committees. She has extensive experience in finance, technology and international operations management. She is also a specialist in market and survey research, having held various executive positions at Ipsos for twenty-four years and having directed the "ESCP Research" a student association at ESCP Business School for three years.

She recently became a member on the Board of Ingenico, the world leader in payment solutions owned by Apollo, where she chairs the Audit and Risk Committee.

In 1998, she joined Ipsos as Chief Financial Officer to prepare its IPO and, in 2010, was appointed Deputy Chief Executive Officer, a position she held until September 2022. In this role, she set up the infrastructure and systems that enabled Ipsos to complete more than 100 acquisitions and successful integration plans, contributing in developing Ipsos as one of the leaders in its industry, present in 90 countries. She directly managed investments in new technologies as well as the Group's 1,000 IT professionals.

At the beginning of her career, she was a financial analyst at Goldman Sachs, then for six and a half years Manager in Audit and Consulting at Arthur Andersen. She then spent two years as Head of Treasury and Investor Relations at Metaleurop, a publicly listed manufacturing company.

Today, she remains a director of Ipsos Board and a member of its audit committee. She also sits on the boards of a number of Ipsos minority investments, including a Chinese company "OneWorld", which invests in CRM marketing platforms, and a Norwegian company "Tivian", which develops customer and employee experience management software.

In January 2023, Laurence Stoclet was elected President of the DFCG Ile de France, the national association of CFOs. An expert in financial, legal and tax matters, she holds a DESCF certificate (Higher Diploma in Accounting and Finance). Finally, she obtained the Ecodac certification (the Confederation of European associations of directors), with a specialization in audit committees in April 2023.
