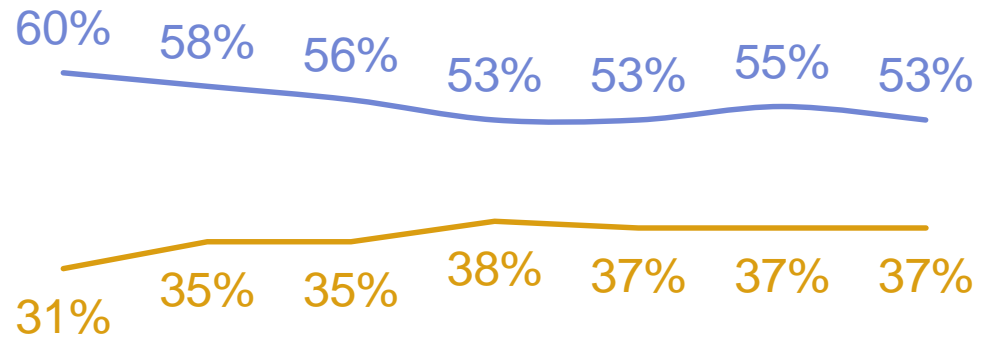

Overall, do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling his job as President (previously president-elect)?



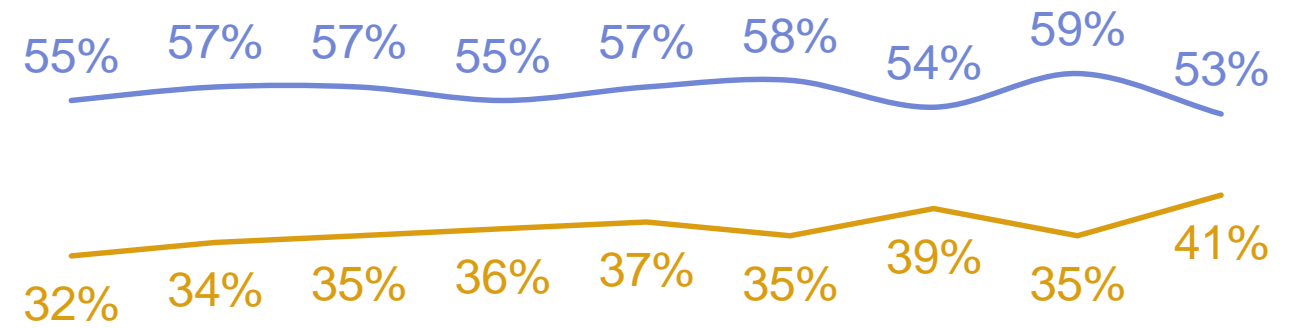

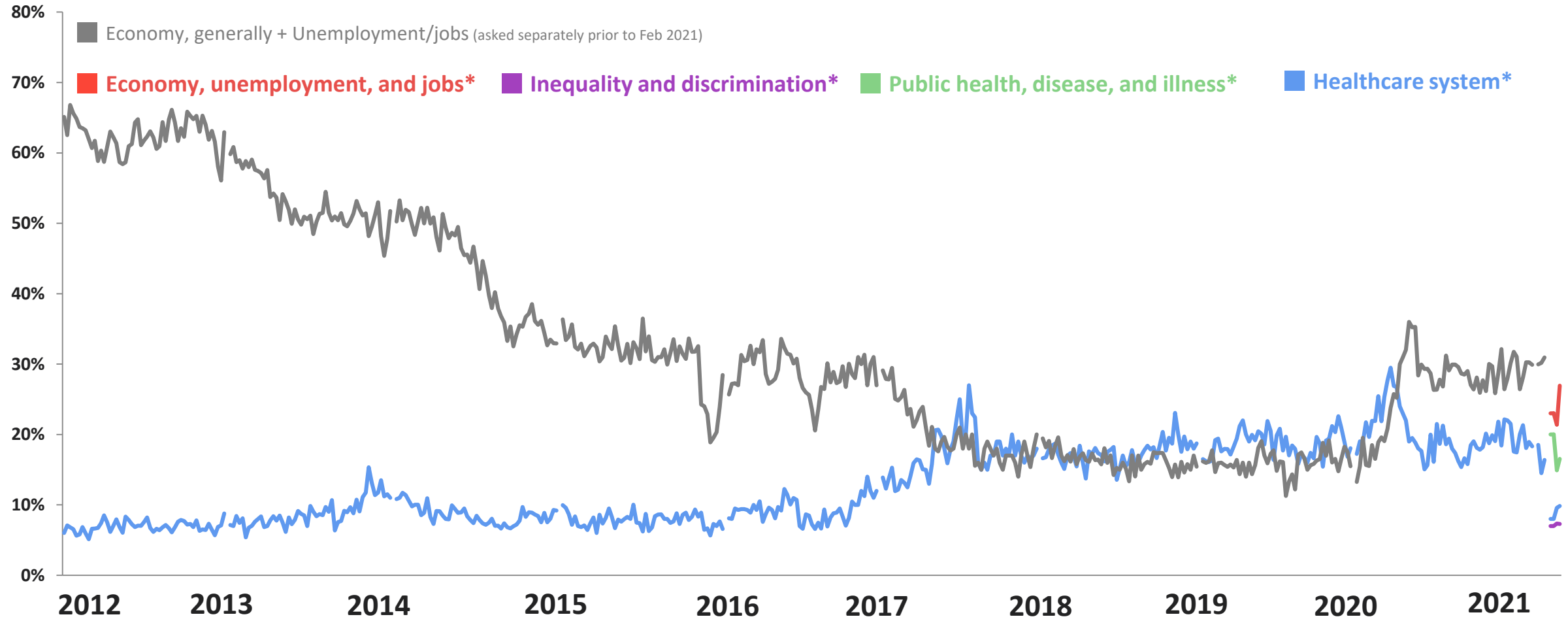

In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the U.S. today?

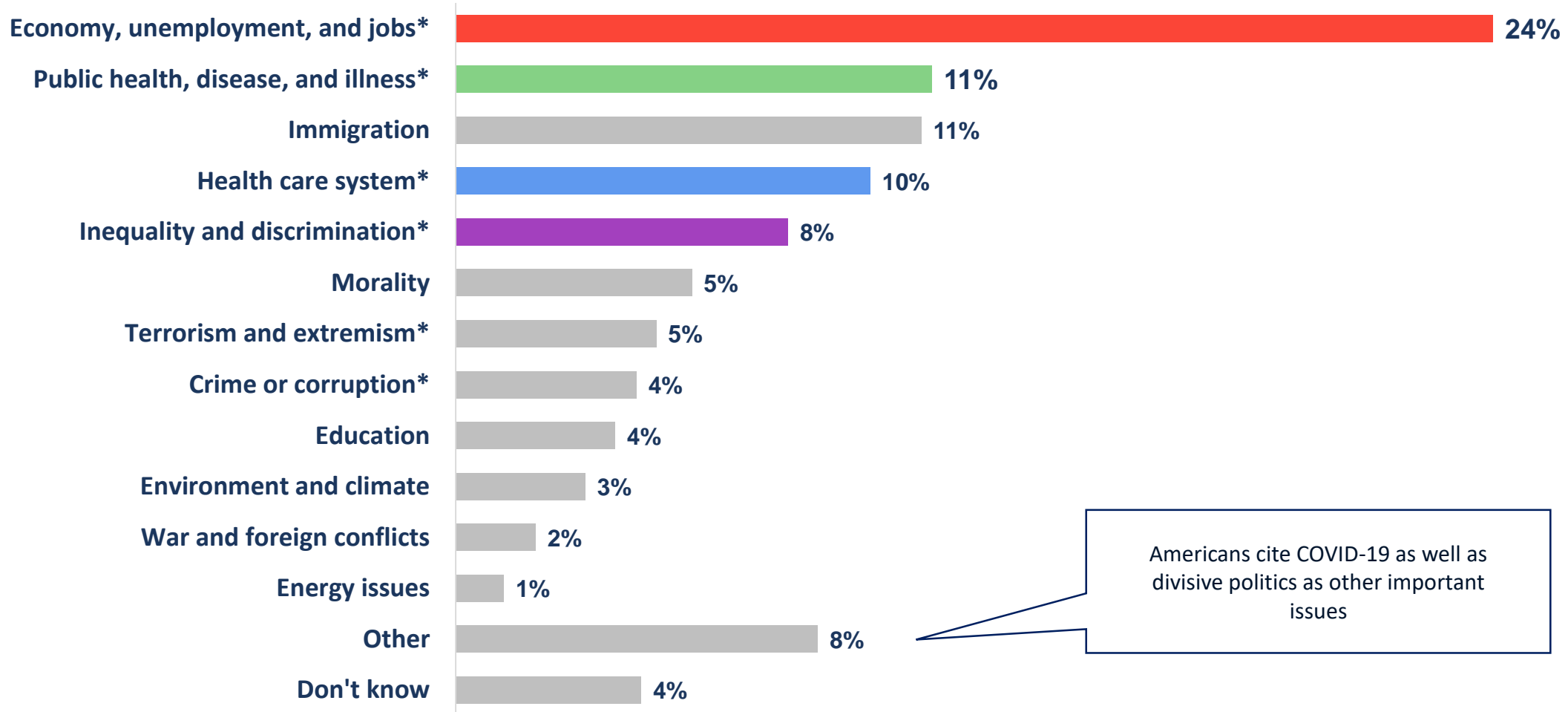

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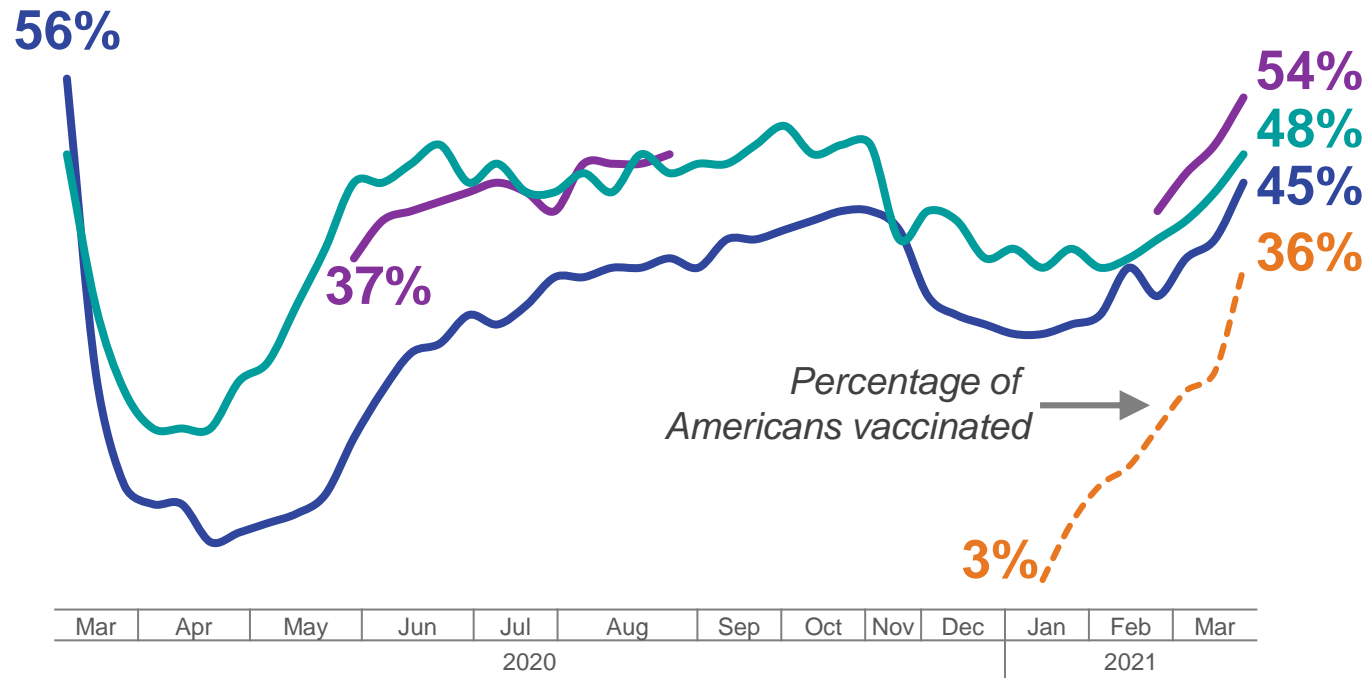

American reemergence speeds up as vaccination rate rises

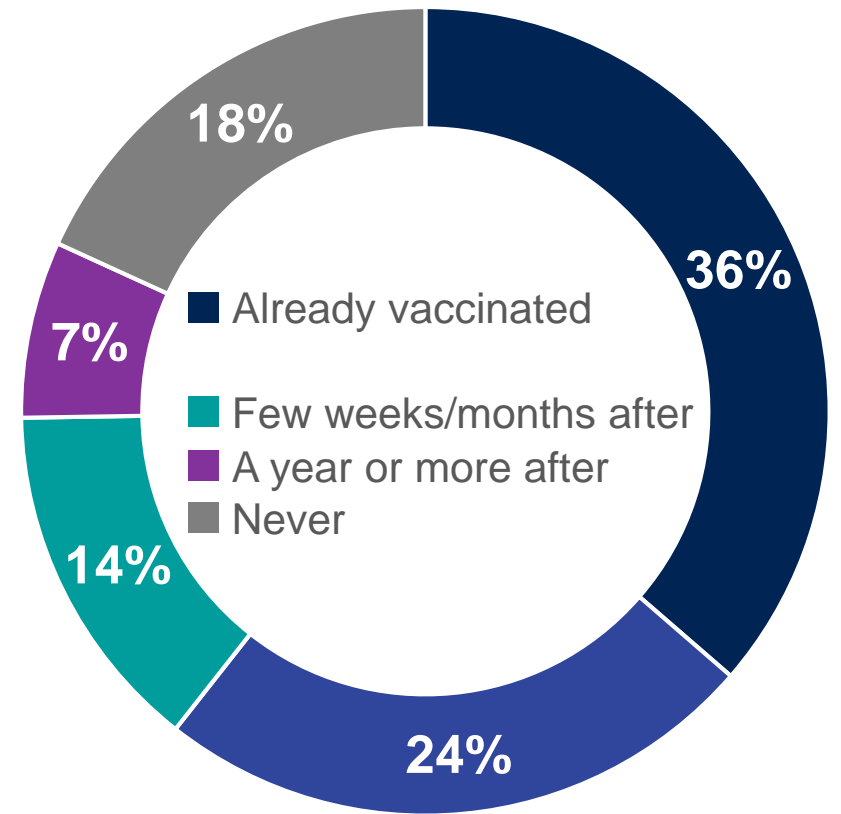
The percentage of Americans going out in public has jumped; more than one in three Americans are now vaccinated

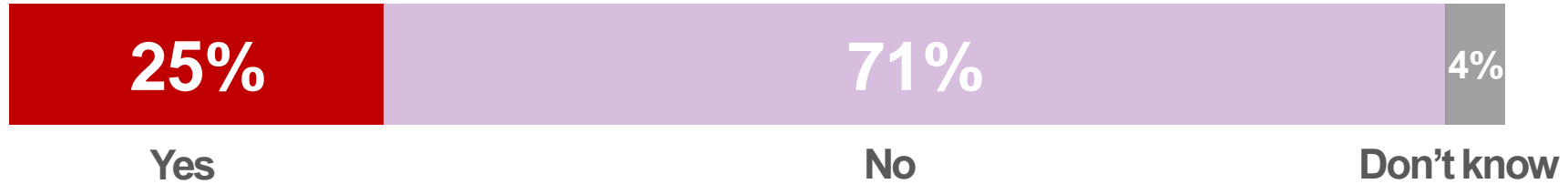
After the COVID-19 vaccine becomes available to you, when, if at all, do you plan to get it?

One in four report witnessing Asian people being blamed for the pandemic

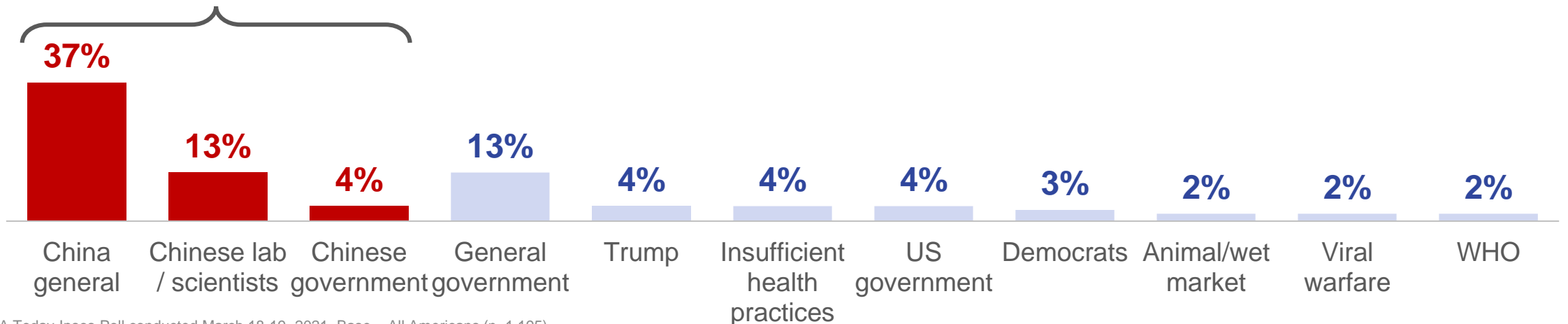
In the past month, have you witnessed someone blaming Asian people for the coronavirus epidemic?

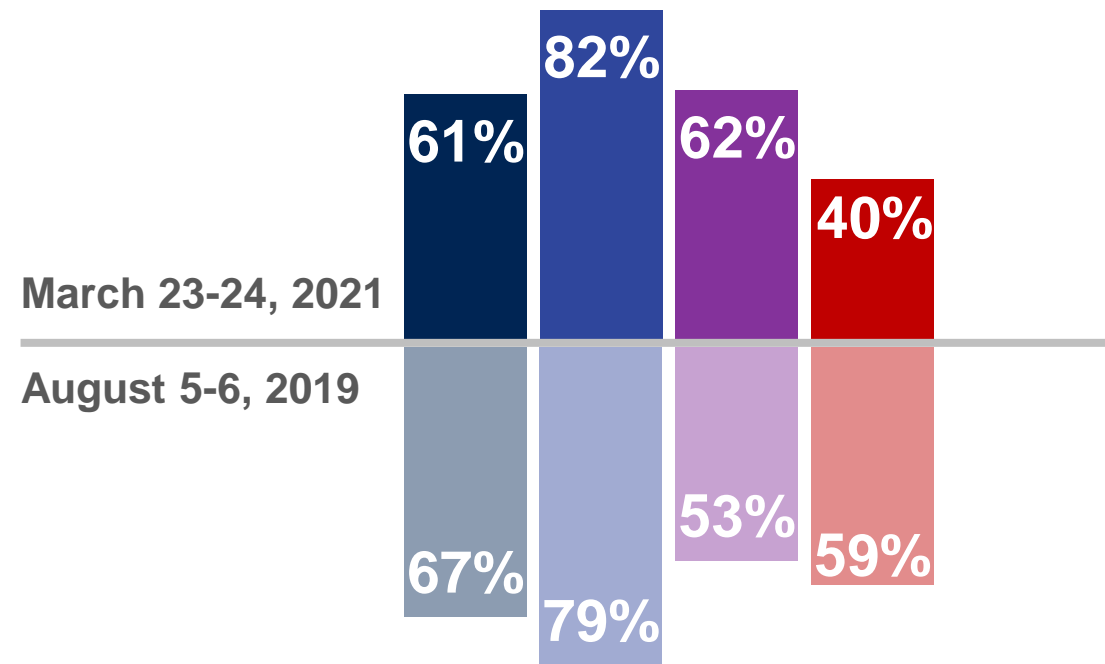
GUN LAWS IN WAKE OF ATLANTA AND BOULDER SHOOTINGS

Percentage of Americans who say that the US Senate should pass the increased background check bills already passed by the US House

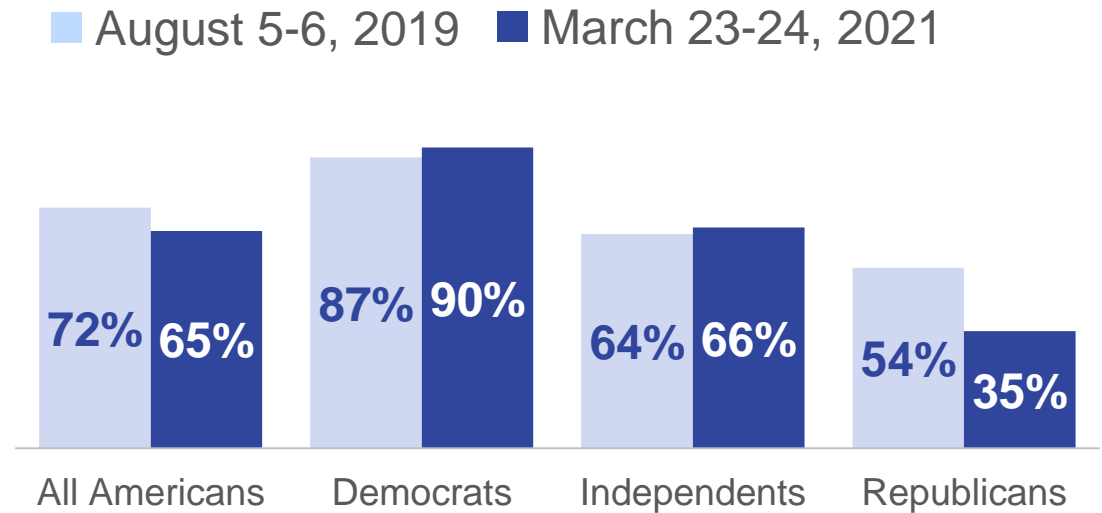

Which of the following statements comes closest to your overall view of gun laws in this country? Do you think gun laws should be...

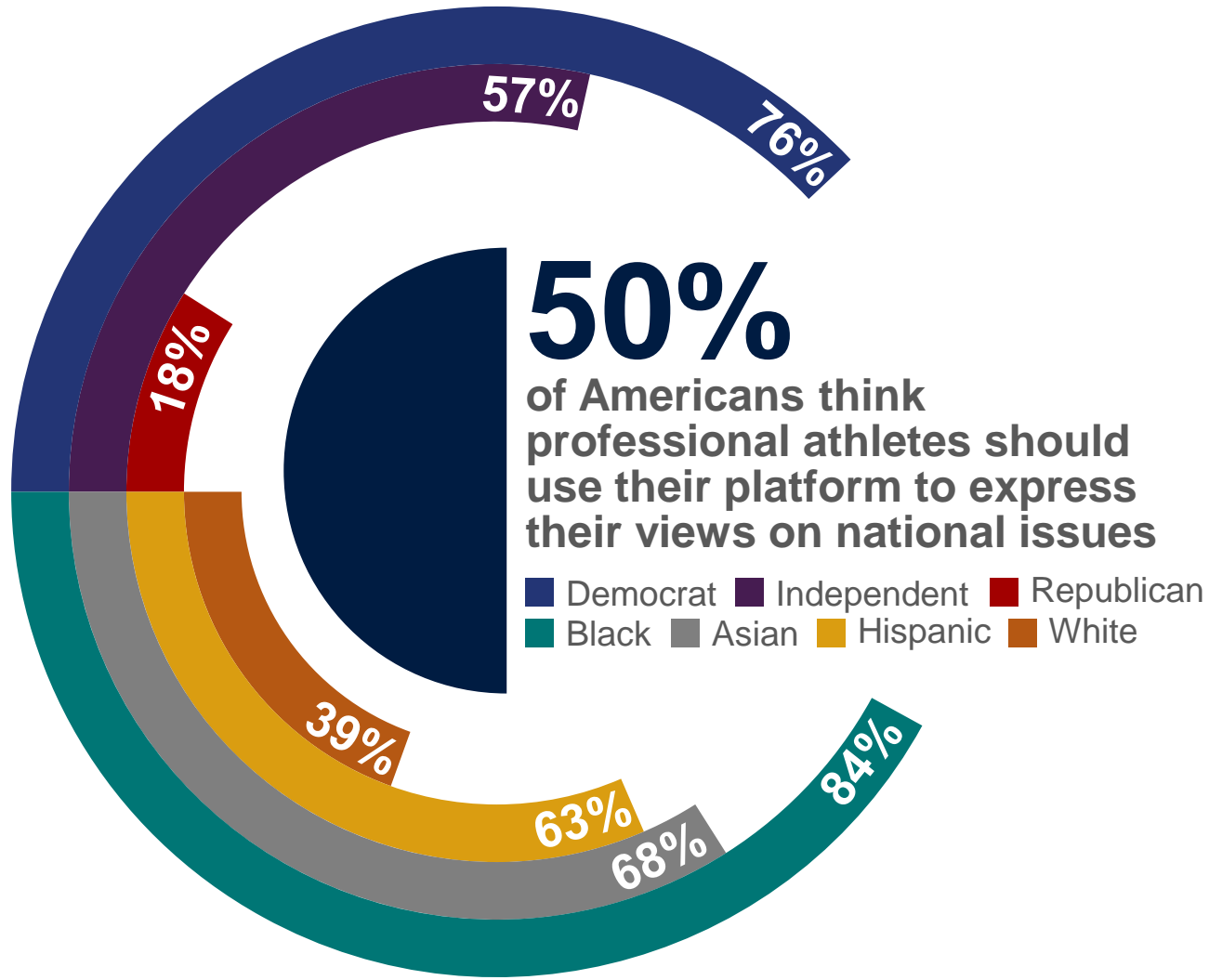

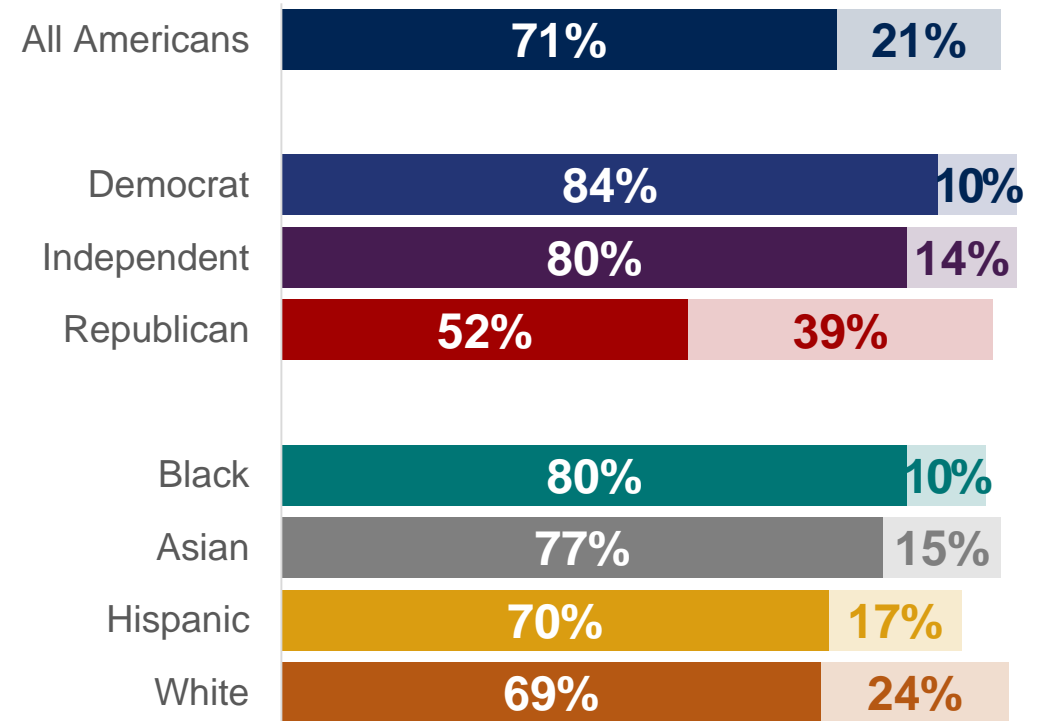
Views split on whether athletes should take stand on issues
