
Overall, do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling his job as President (previously president-elect)?



In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the U.S. today?






Most aware, supportive of Johnson & Johnson vaccine pause


As the percentage of vaccinated Americans continues to rise, a minority maintains they will never get the vaccine


Percentage of Americans who...

Are aware of the temporary pause in distribution of the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine




Believe the FDA and CDC are being responsible by recommending a pause on the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine*






After the COVID-19 vaccine becomes available, when do you plan to get it?




Most Americans agree with guilty verdict in Chauvin trial

As you may know, Derek Chauvin was recently found guilty of the murder of George Floyd. Do you think this is the correct verdict?








Personal view on George Floyd's death relatively unchanged by Chauvin trial verdict
