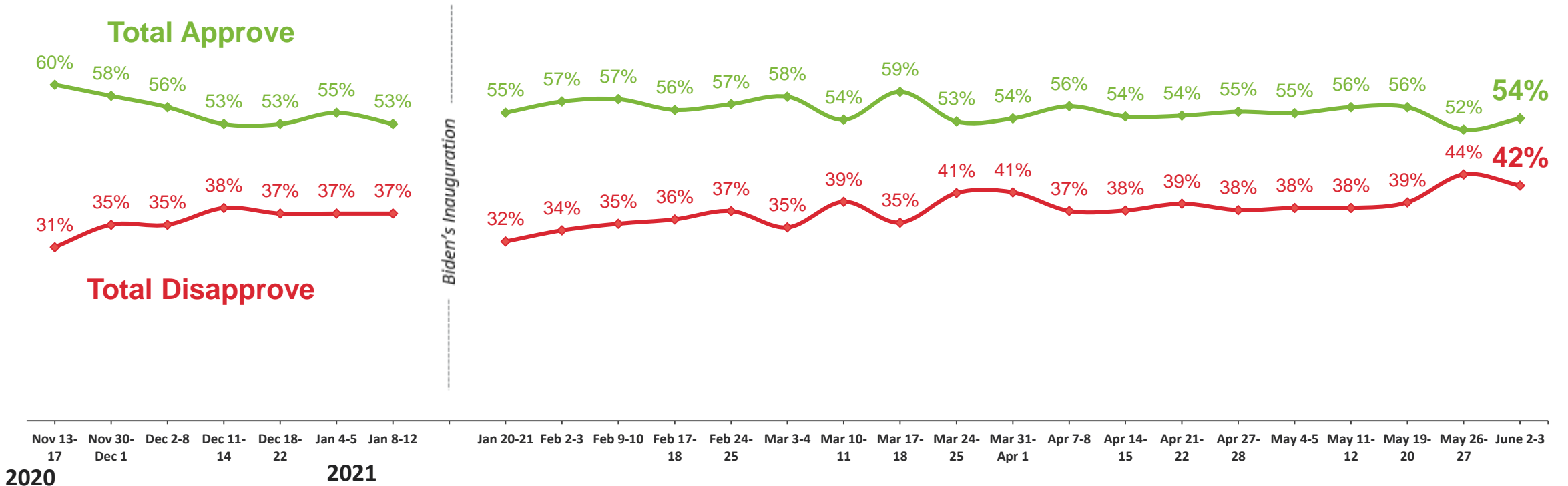

Overall, do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling his job as President (previously president-elect)?



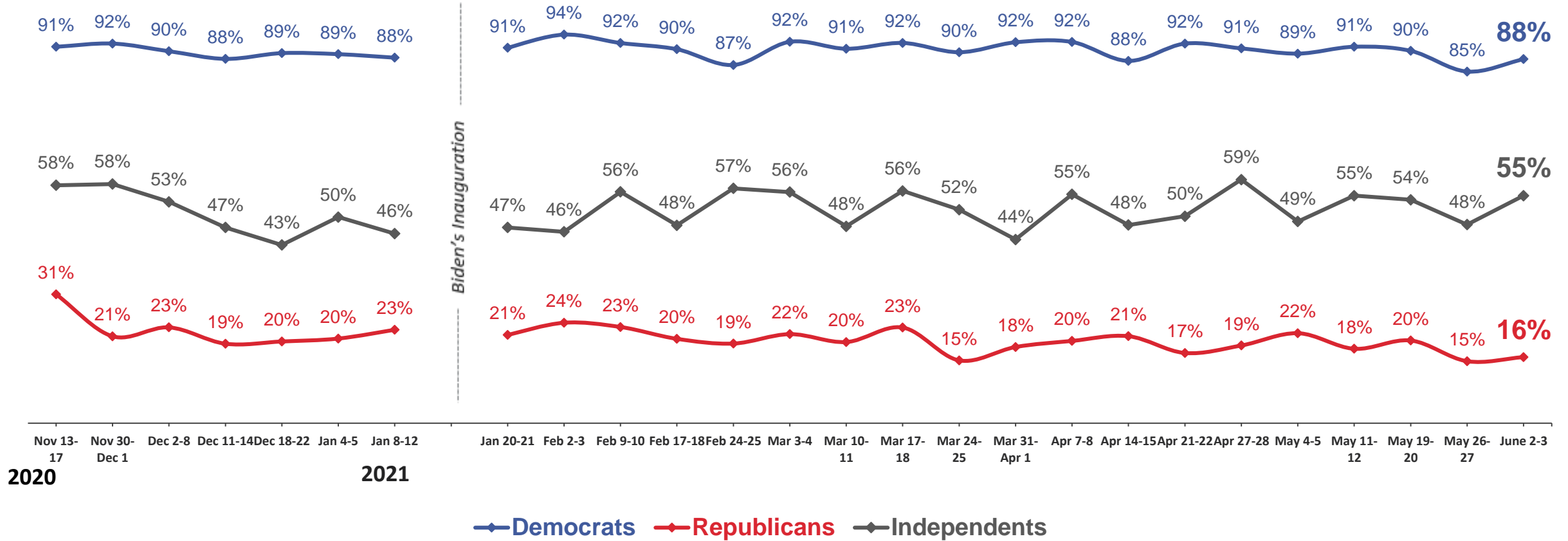

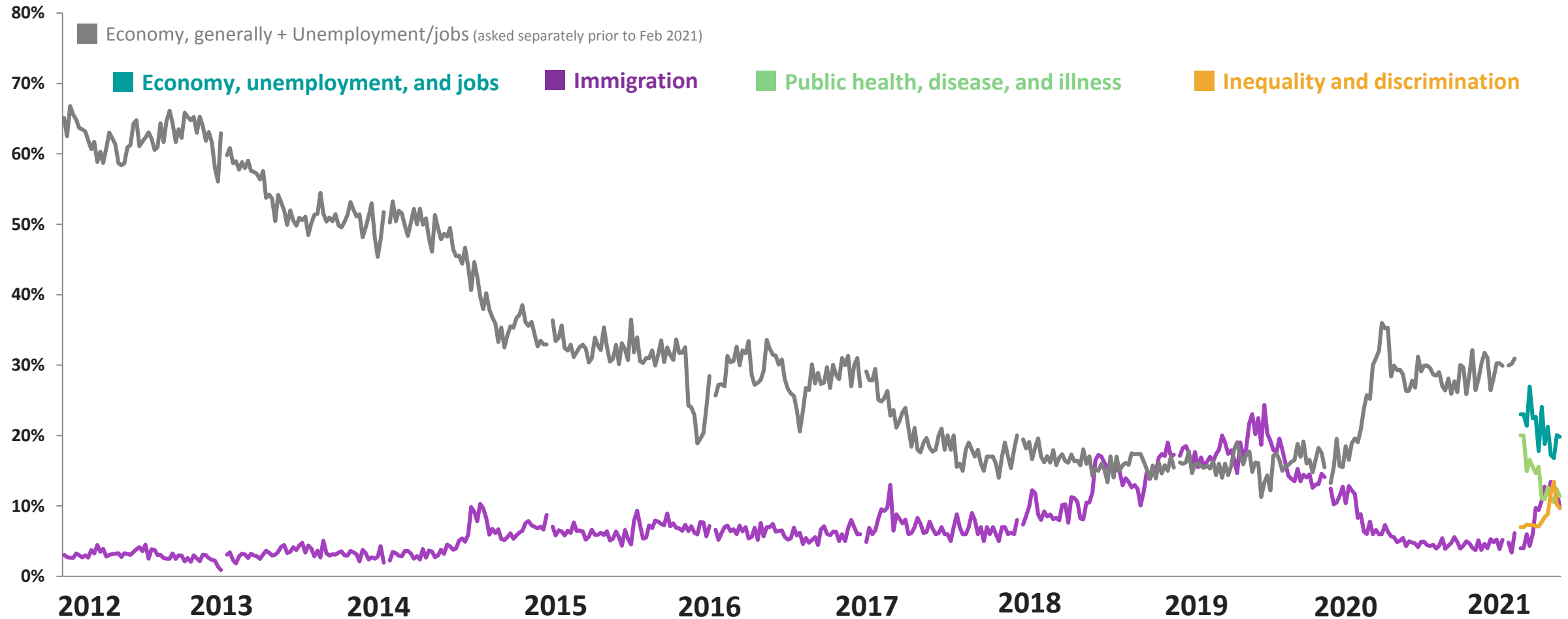

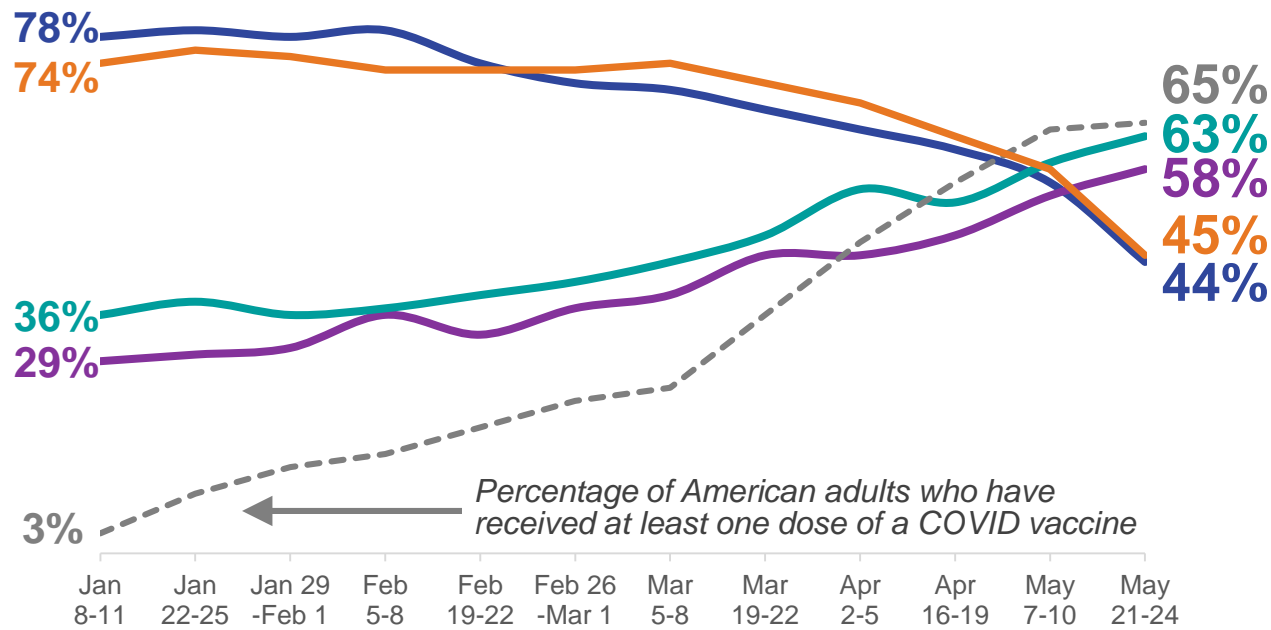

People at an airport



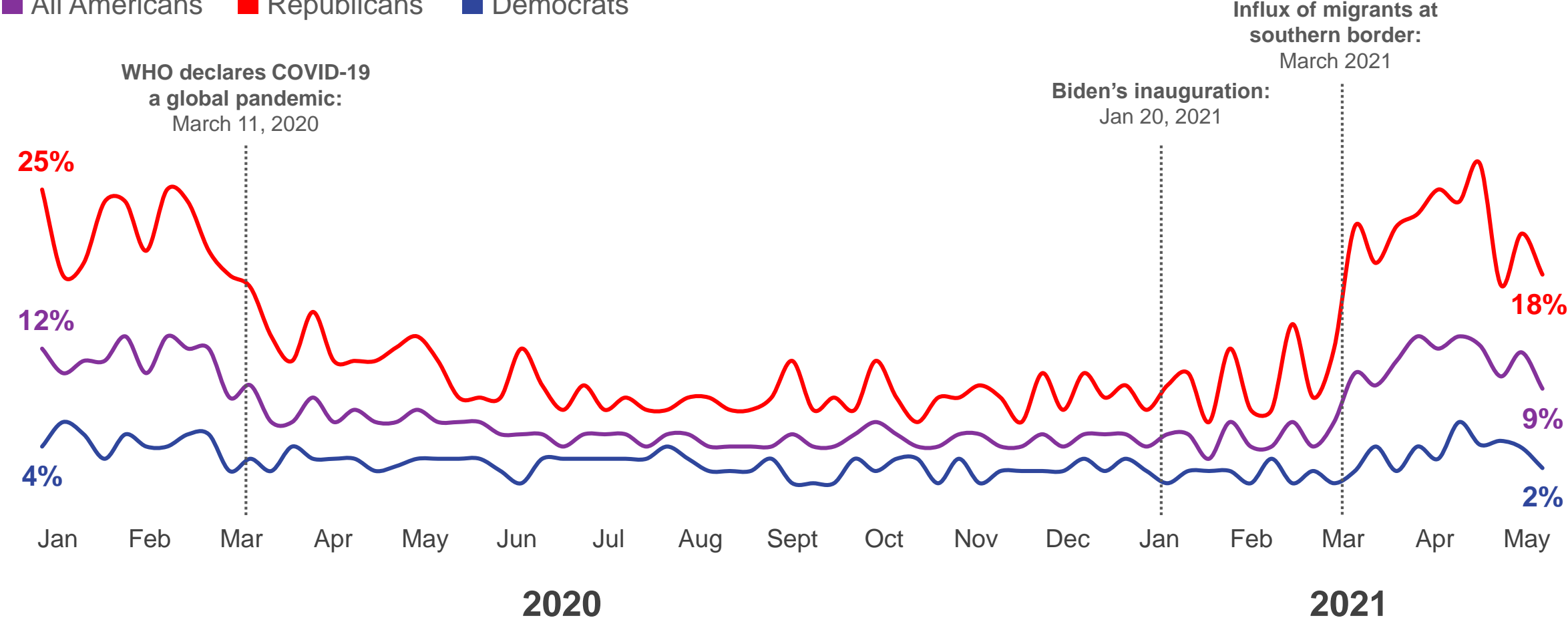

■ All Americans ■ Republicans ■ Democrats



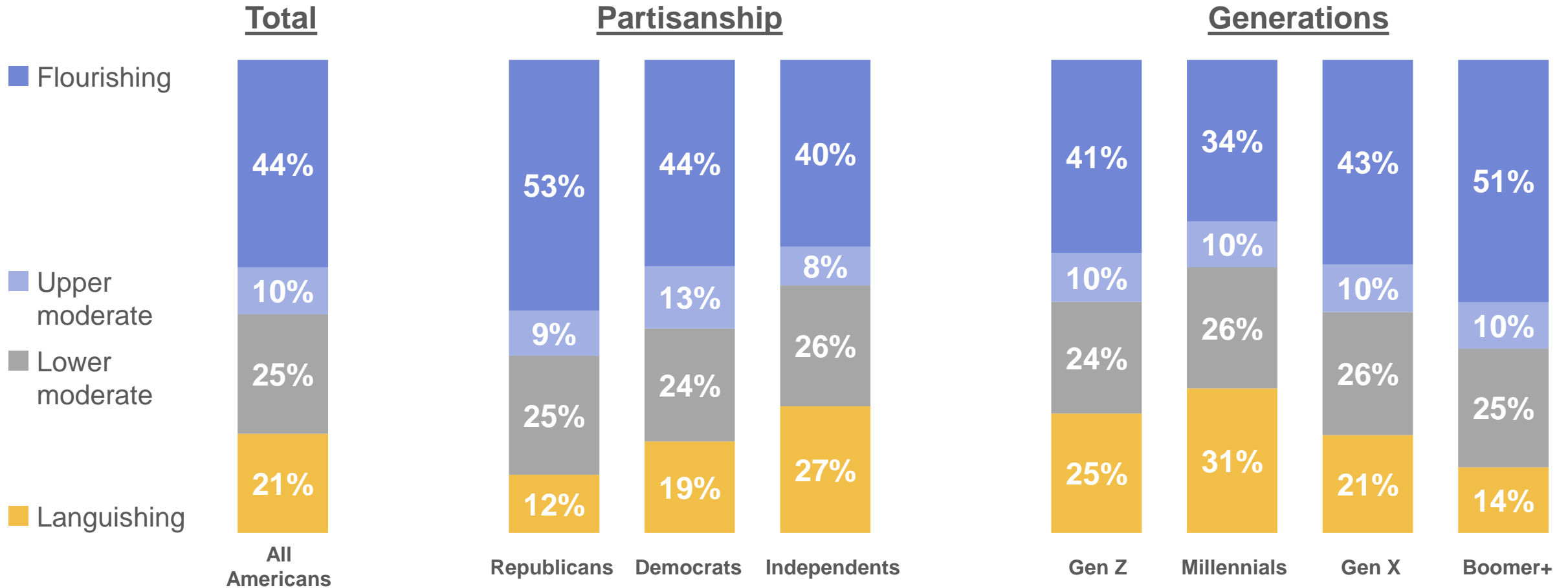

Sense of well-being strongest among Boomers, lowest among Millennials, and stronger among Republicans than Independents and Democrats



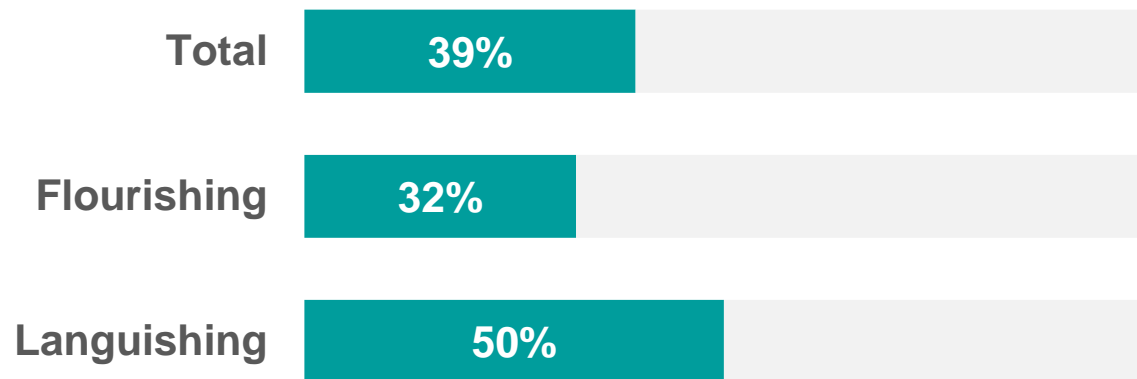

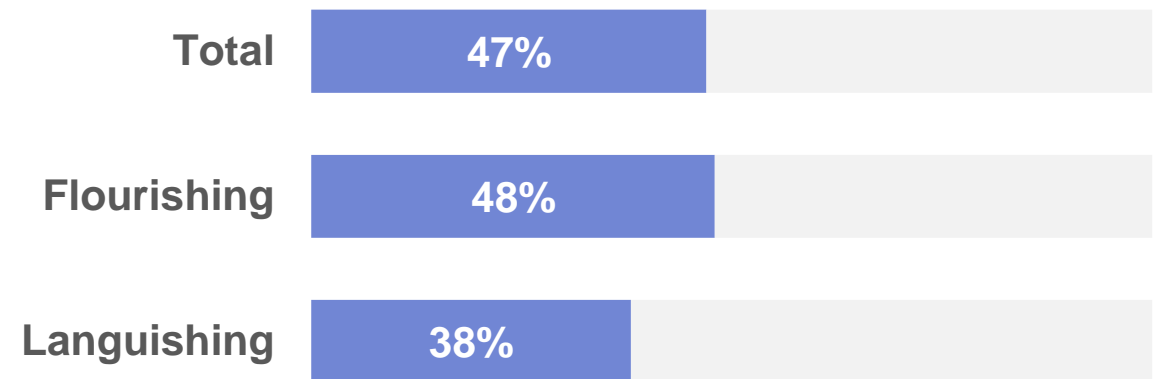
Sense of well-being linked to views on condition of society

Among those flourishing and languishing, percent agree with the following statements:

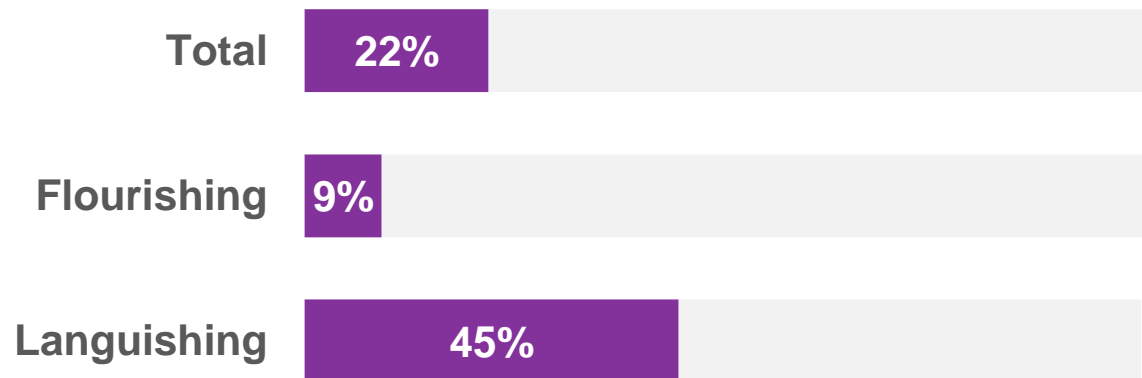
These days, I feel like a stranger in my own country



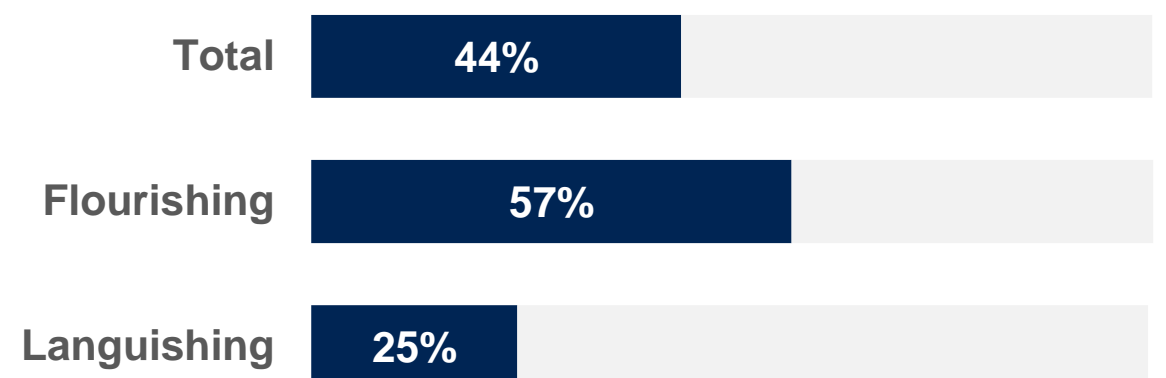
When jobs are scarce, employers should prioritize hiring people of this country over immigrants
