

Overall, do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling his job as President (previously president-elect)?











How likely, if at all, are you to stop or do less of the following activities, specifically because of concerns about contracting the Delta coronavirus variant? - Likely Summary







Partisan reactions to Biden's performance in Afghanistan begin to form


Percent who feel the Biden administration did a good job or bad job in Afghanistan
