


Methodology



Methodology

- These are the findings of the first Ipsos Infrastructure Index conducted via Global @dvisor.
- In total 21,043 interviews (including 501 in New Zealand) were conducted between 25 August and 8 September 2017 among adults aged 18-64 in the US and Canada, and adults aged 16-64 in all other countries.
- The survey was conducted in 28 countries around the world via the Ipsos Online Panel system:
 - Argentina, Australia, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, Chile, China, Colombia, France, Germany, Great Britain, Hungary, India, Italy, Japan, Mexico, New Zealand, Peru, Poland, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, South Korea, Serbia, Spain, Sweden, Turkey and the United States of America (N.B. some questions were not fielded in China, and New Zealand)












Ratings of types of infrastructure



New Zealand: types of infrastructure




























Doing enough?

% strongly/tend to agree






Investment vital




