

Methodology

- These are the findings of the first Ipsos Infrastructure Index conducted via Global @dvisor.
- In total 21,043 interviews were conducted between 25 August and 8 September 2017 among adults aged 18-64 in the US and Canada, and adults aged 16-64 in all other countries.
- The survey was conducted in 28 countries around the world via the Ipsos Online Panel system:
 - Argentina, Australia, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, Chile, China, Colombia, France, Germany, Great Britain (1,004), Hungary, India, Italy, Japan, Mexico, New Zealand, Peru, Poland, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, South Korea, Serbia, Spain, Sweden, Turkey and the United States of America (N.B. some questions were not fielded in China, and New Zealand)
- The 2016 survey used the same methodology but was conducted in 26 countries between 26 August and 9 September 2016 (New Zealand and Serbia were added in in 2017). This means that the global trend does not involve a like-for-like comparison.



Overall, how satisfied or dissatisfied are you with [COUNTRY'S] national infrastructure?























































Q. Which of these types of transport have you used to make a journey in the past six months?





Q. Thinking about the journeys you have made by road in the past six months, have they been on...





Car/van as driver






Satisfaction – overground rail

Overground train/railway






Satisfaction – underground rail

Underground train/metro




