Methodology

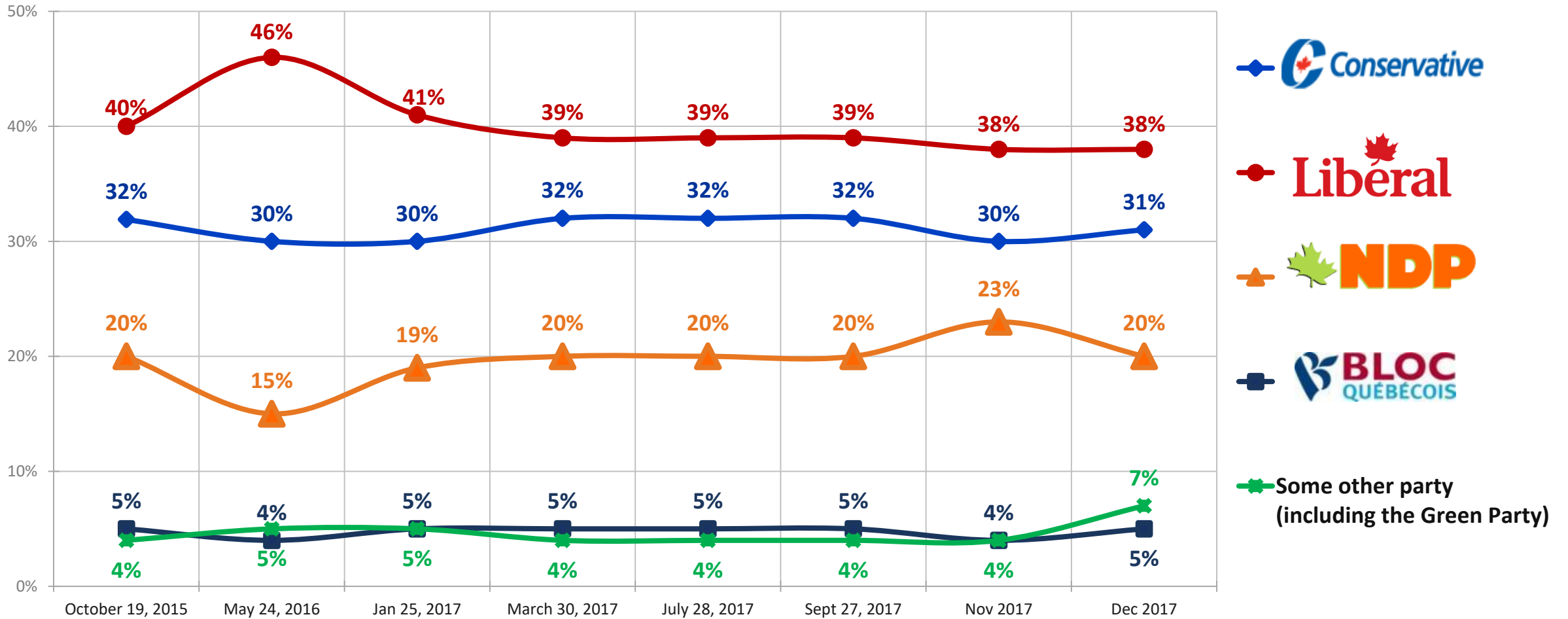
- These are the findings of an Ipsos poll conducted from December 10 to December 14, 2017, exclusively for Global News.
- A sample of n= 2,098 Canadians aged 18+ was sampled via the Ipsos I-Say panel and non-panel sources.
- Quotas and weighting were employed to ensure that the sample reflects that of the Canadian population by region, age and gender according to Canadian census information.
- The precision of Ipsos online polls is measured using a credibility interval. In this case, the results of the poll are considered accurate to within +/- 2.4 percentage points, 19 times out of 20, of what the results would be had all Canadian adults been polled.
- Credibility intervals are wider among subsets of the population.

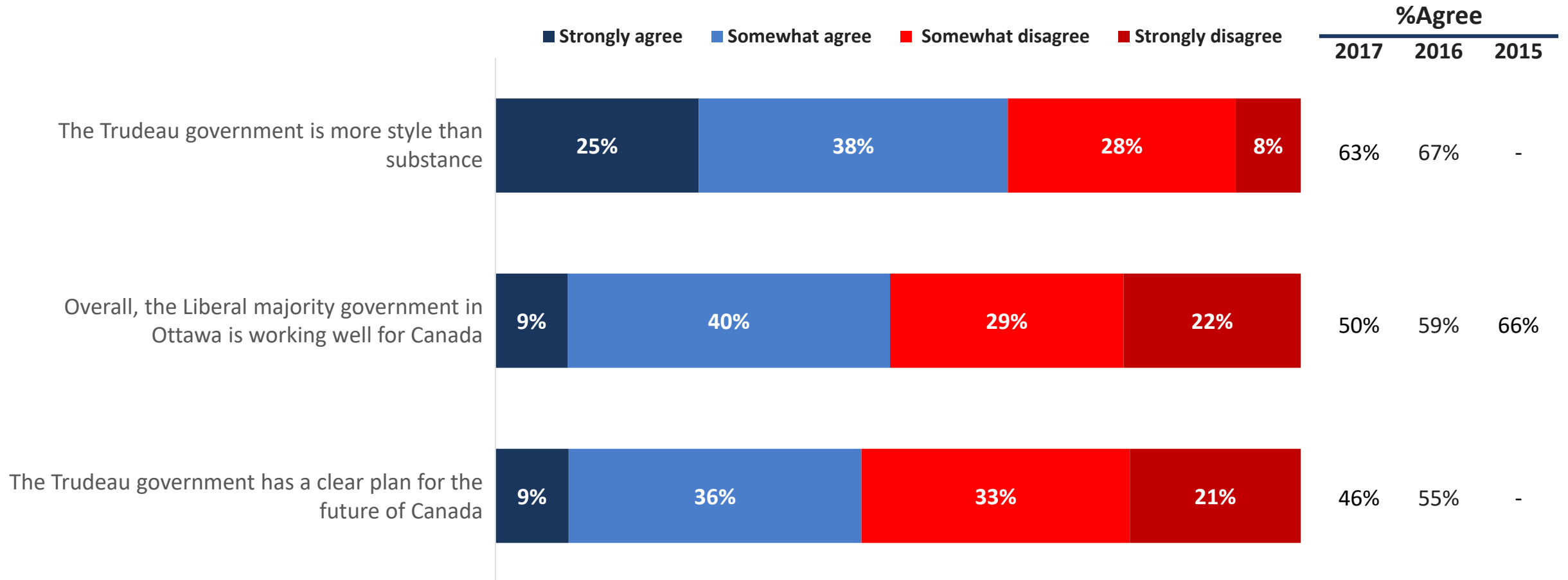
FEDERAL VOTING INTENTIONS

Liberal Lead Holds Steady



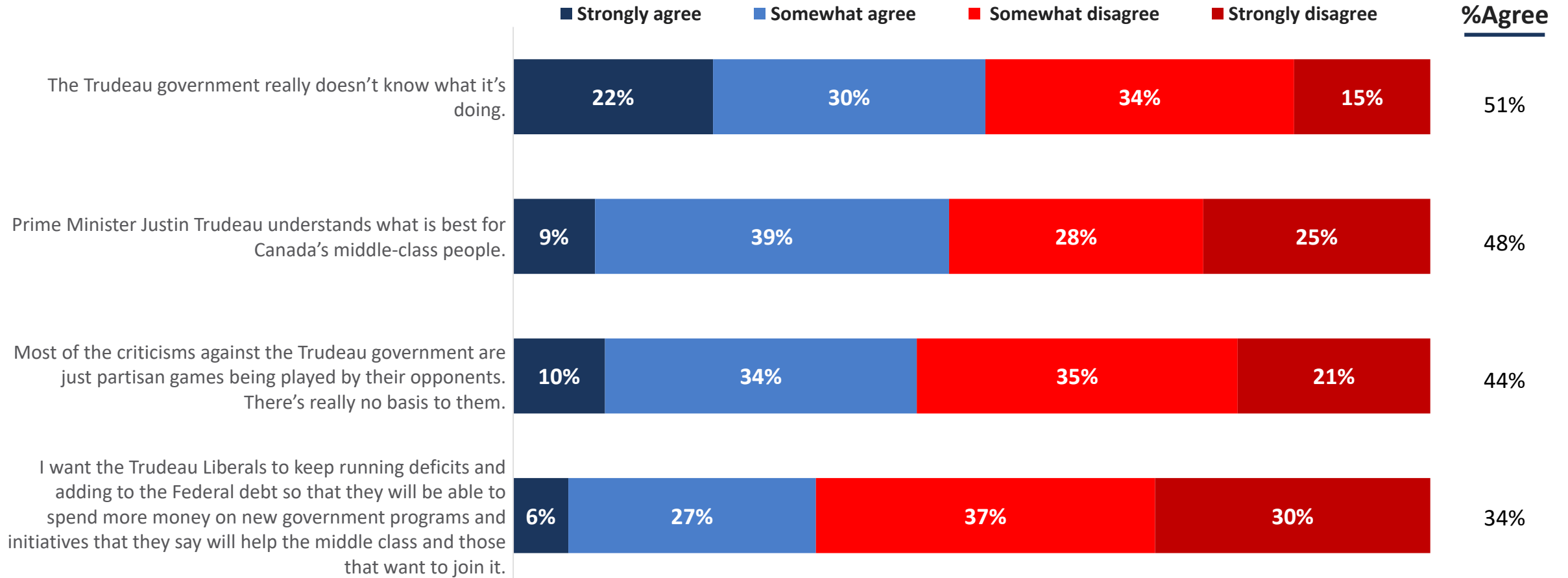
REFLECTIONS ON FEDERAL LIBERALS

Fewer believe Liberal government working well (50%, down 9 points since 2016) and that Trudeau has plan for future (46%, down 9)



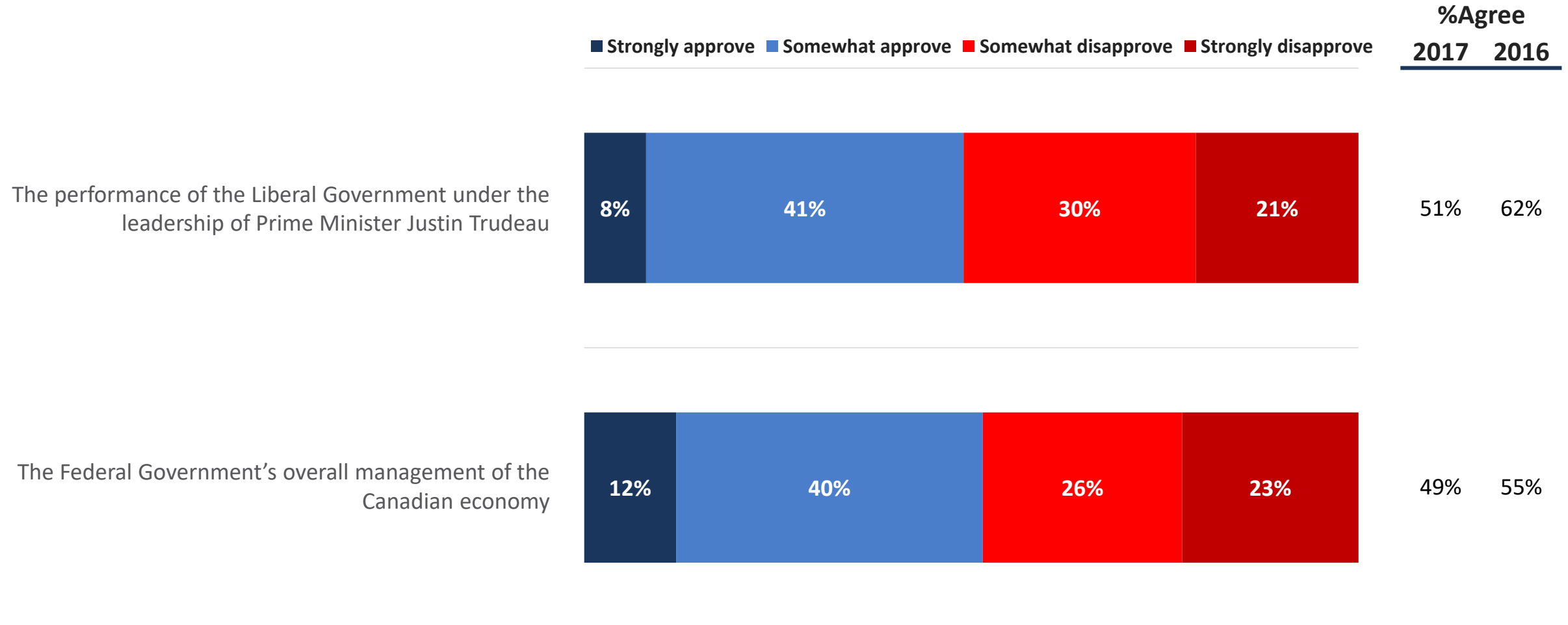
REFLECTIONS ON FEDERAL LIBERALS

Just 34% want Trudeau Liberals to run deficits to help middle class; half (51%) believe government doesn't know what it's doing



FEDERAL APPROVAL RATINGS

Overall approval ratings soften in last twelve months (down 9 points), but still relatively strong



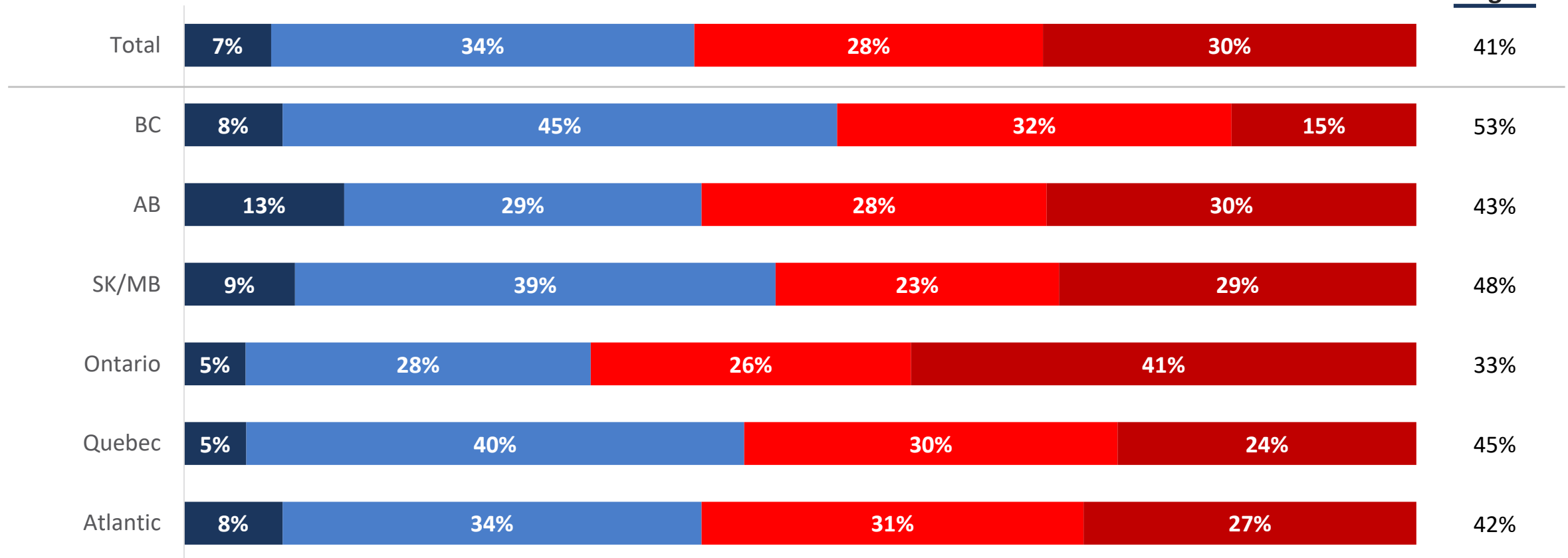
PROVINCIAL APPROVAL RATINGS

Provincial government approval ratings are highest in BC (53%), and lowest in Ontario (33%)

The performance of your provincial government under your premier

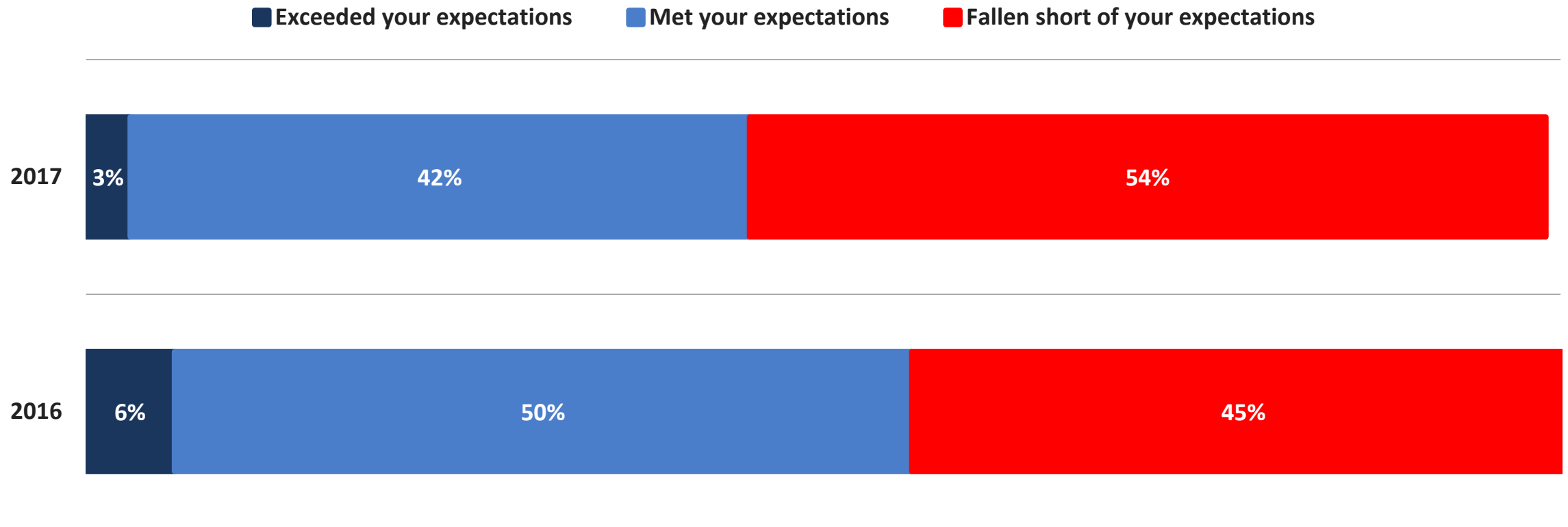
■ Strongly approve ■ Somewhat approve ■ Somewhat disapprove ■ Strongly disapprove

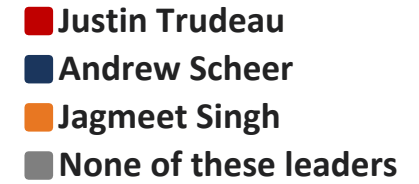
EXPECTATIONS OF LIBERAL GOVERNMENT
