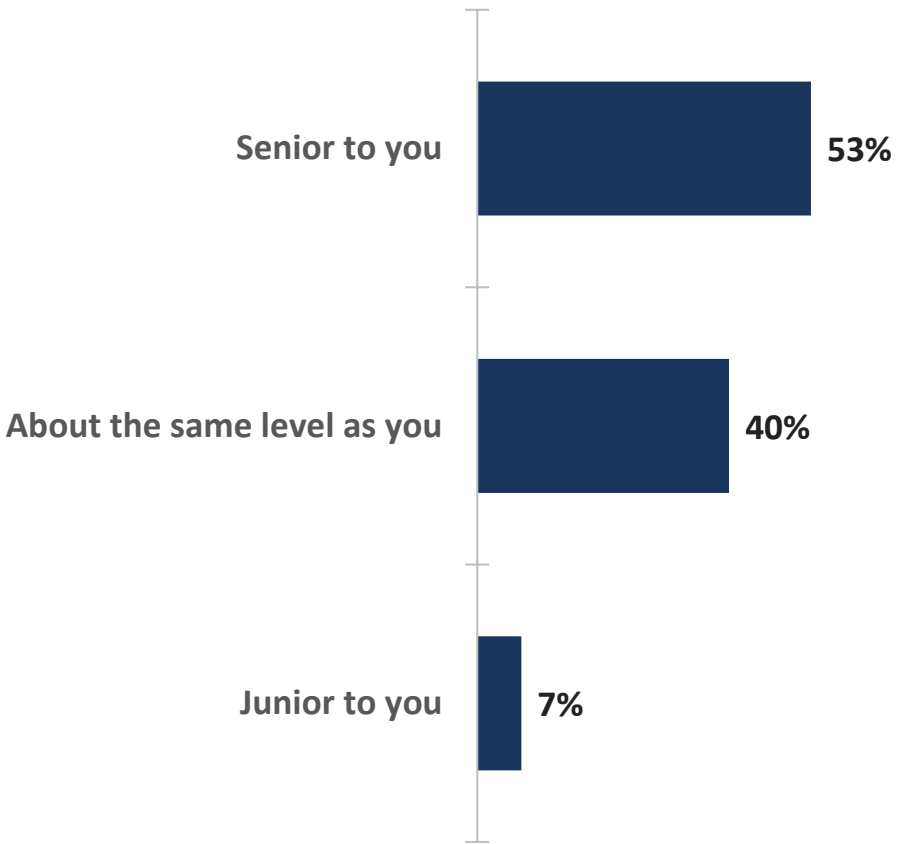
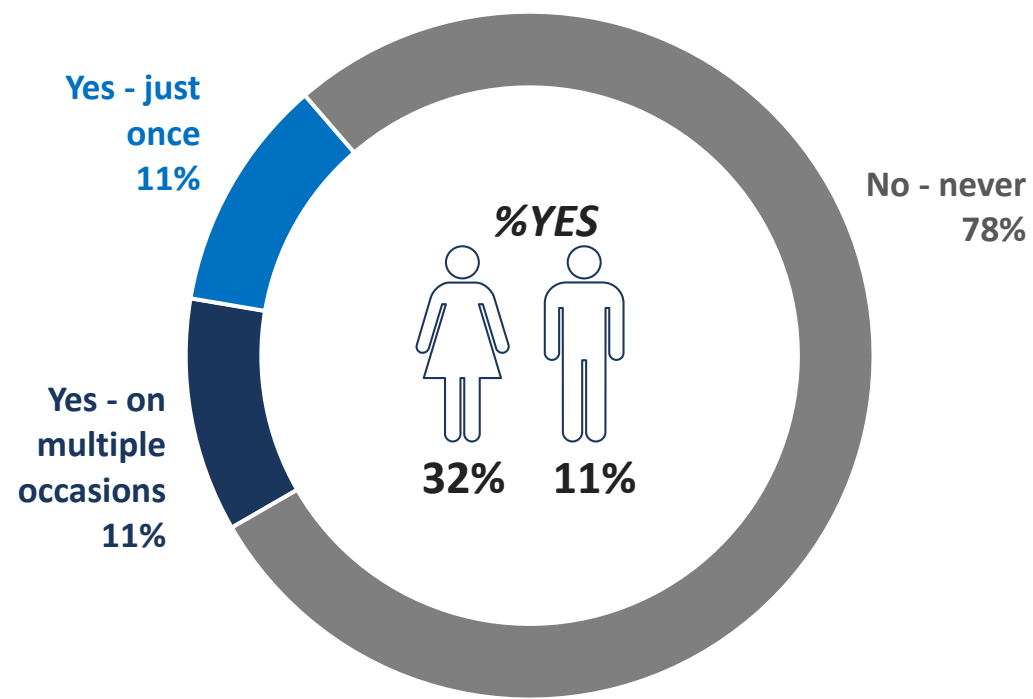

Two in ten (22%) have been sexually harassed in the workplace, with most perpetrators being senior to the survivor

% who experienced workplace sexual harassment

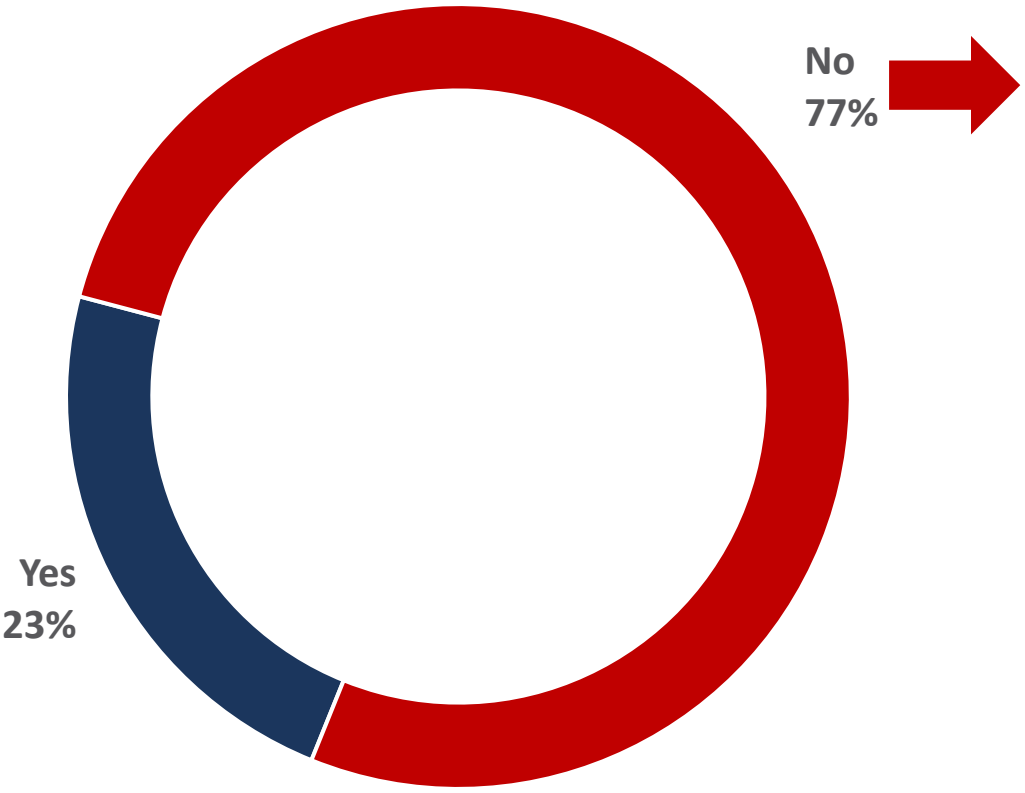

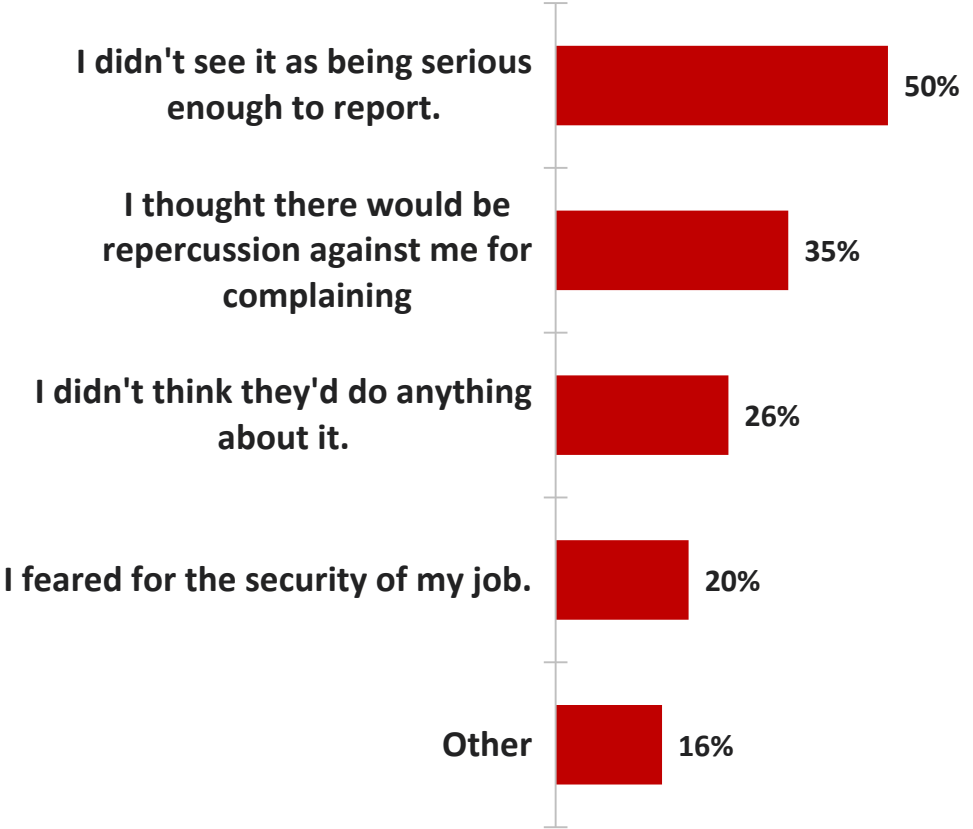
WORKPLACE SEXUAL HARASSMENT

Only one in four (23%) survivors complained to management; those who stayed silent feared repercussions (35%) or for their job security (20%)

WORKPLACE SEXUAL HARASSMENT

Among those who did complain, a slim majority (57%) were satisfied that it was acted on appropriately, while 43% were not satisfied
