




Population around the world do not feel all optimistic about driverless cars




Self-driving cars will make driving more relaxing- % Agree






Self-driving cars will make driving safer- % Agree






Self-driving cars will make driving faster- % Agree











Consumers trust manufacturers and the government more to regulate self driving cars





% who would own a self-driving car as their main form of use




Q5. Which of the following would you choose if you wanted to use a self-driving car? – Owning my own
