Fieldwork: 23 – 27 February 2018

Technical Details

Ipsos MORI interviewed a representative sample of 1,681 adults aged 16-75 across Great Britain and Northern Ireland. Interviews were conducted online on 23-27 February 2018. Data are weighted to match the profile of the population. Questions were answered by all respondents unless otherwise stated.

Where percentages do not sum to 100 this may be due to computer rounding, the exclusion of "don't know" categories, or multiple answers. An asterisk (*) denotes any value of less than half a per cent. Data are based on all adults unless otherwise stated.
