









Sharp Decline Over Time in Institutional Trust










We Are Seeing Increased Ideological Tribalization



Hot Cognition: The Bedrock of Tribalism




- > Priming

% who support the repeal of the "1975 Public Affairs Act" when repeal is endorsed by...








America Is Becoming Less White

Ipsos poll conducted August 17-18, 2017 among 1,021 U.S. adults Black people do not have the same opportunities as white people in the U.S.


Due to racial discrimination, programs such as affirmative action are necessary to help create equality

Social policies, such as affirmative action, discriminate unfairly against white people


The mainstream media is more interested in making money than telling the truth




