


Voting Intention: 2019 General Election Prediction Poll

How do you intend to vote in the General Election? Will you vote...?






Base: 2,213 British adults 18+, 9-11 December 2019; Headline Voting Intention: all 9/10 certain to vote, always/usually/it depends vote in General Elections, registered to vote and answers reallocated to ensure parties standing in constituency = 1,846. Margin of error is displayed at +/- 4% All polls are subject to a wide range of potential sources of error. On the basis of the historical record of the polls at recent general elections, there is a 9 in 10 chance that the true value of a party's support lies within 4 points of the estimates provided by this poll, and a 2 in 3 chance that they lie within 2 points. This is especially important to keep in mind when calculating party lead figures.

How do you intend to vote in the General Election? Will you vote...?



How do you intend to vote in the General Election? Will you vote...?





Have you definitely decided to vote for one party or is there a chance you may change your mind before you vote?



Have you definitely decided to vote for one party or is there a chance you may change your mind before you vote?






Who might you vote for instead?

If you do change your mind about voting for this party, which party would you vote for instead?


Among all who might change their mind




Among Conservative supporters who might change their mind






Importance of the General Election

Important Not important






Importance of the General Election








Who would make the most capable Prime Minister?
