

And if the UK Government did recommend that people wear a facemask while in public to try and slow the spread of the Coronavirus, how likely or unlikely would you follow this advice?



How likely or unlikely do you think it is that you will wear a facemask while in public in the near future (i.e. when buying food, exercising or working)?








