


#### How divided is British society?

Overall, how divided do you think British society is these days?



Overall, how divided do you think British society is these days?





And do you think British society is more or less divided than it was ten years ago, or is it about the same?






# Impact of the Coronavirus on different groups







#### Confidence in the NHS to deal with the Coronavirus

And how confident, if at all, would you say you are in the ability of the National Health Service to deal with those who are ill as a result of getting the Coronavirus?








#### Concern about the Coronavirus: For yourself






### Concern about the Coronavirus: The country as a whole








### Public concern about the Coronavirus: March - April 2020

To what extent, if at all, would you say you are concerned about the risk Coronavirus poses to each of the following?






#### Government measures in response to Coronavirus
