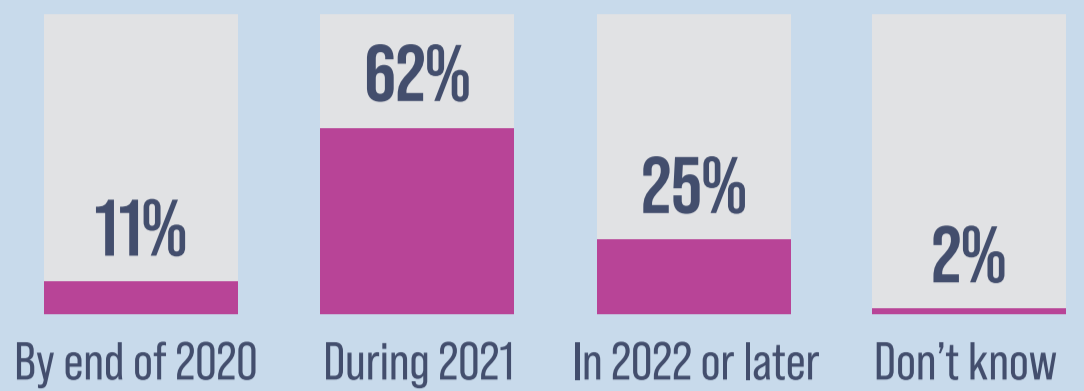

HOPE FOR A COVID-19 VACCINE

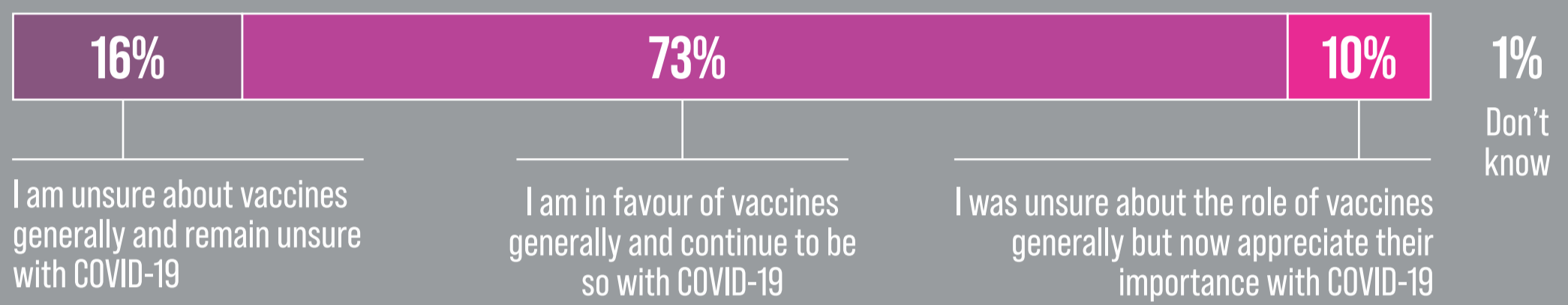

PRIORITISATION OF CERTAIN GROUPS FOR A COVID-19 VACCINE

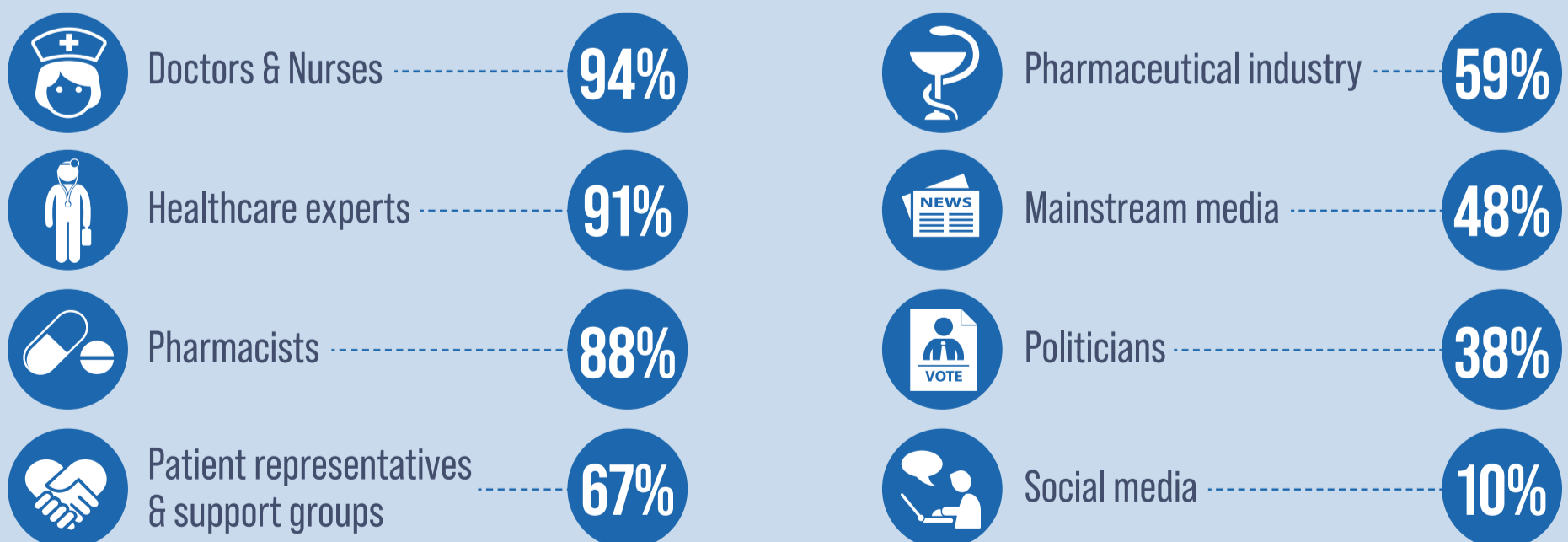

PRIORITY AMONG SUGGESTED GROUPS

- First priority: Healthcare workers
- Second priority: Those with underlying health conditions
- Third priority: Those aged 70 years or more
