

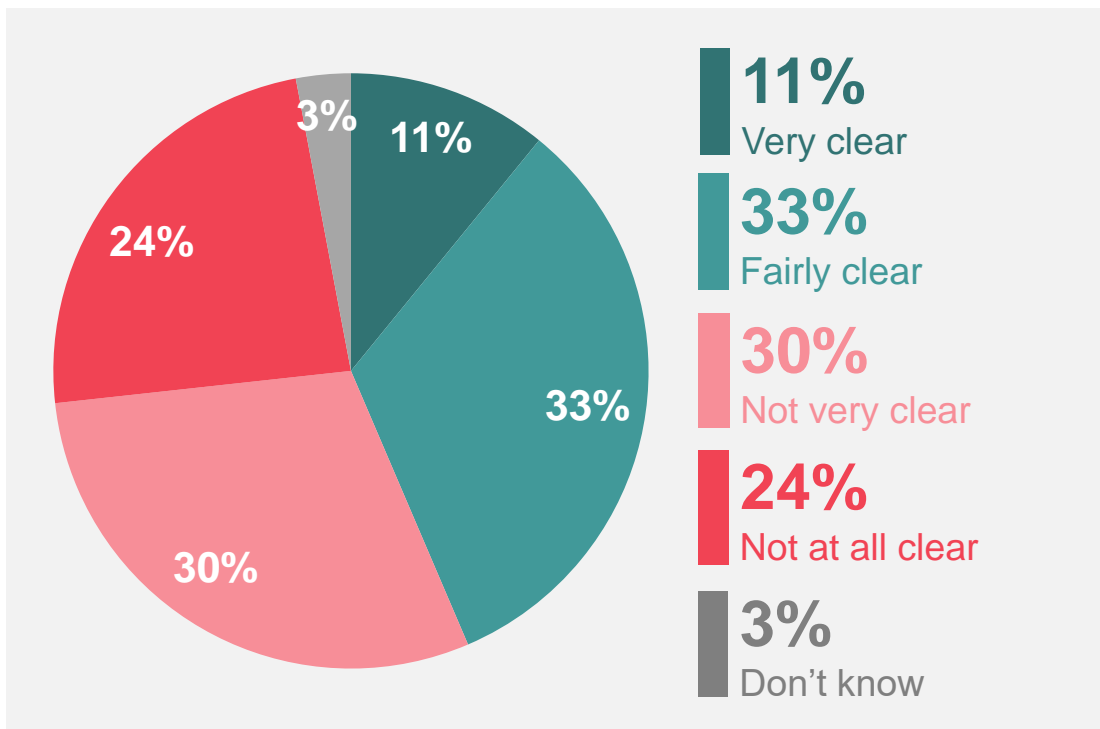

# Clarity of Government's Coronavirus messaging

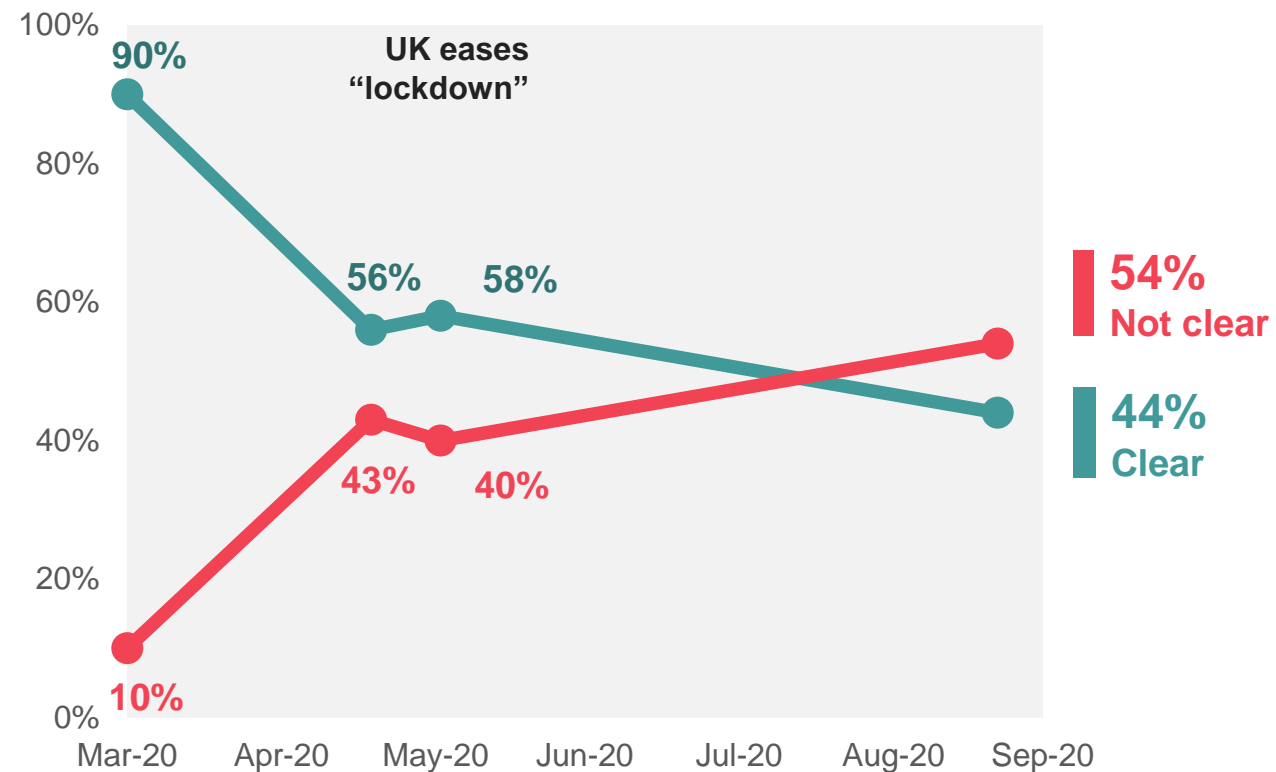
How clear, if at all, have you found the Government's communications about what to do in response to coronavirus?

18 – 20 September 2020



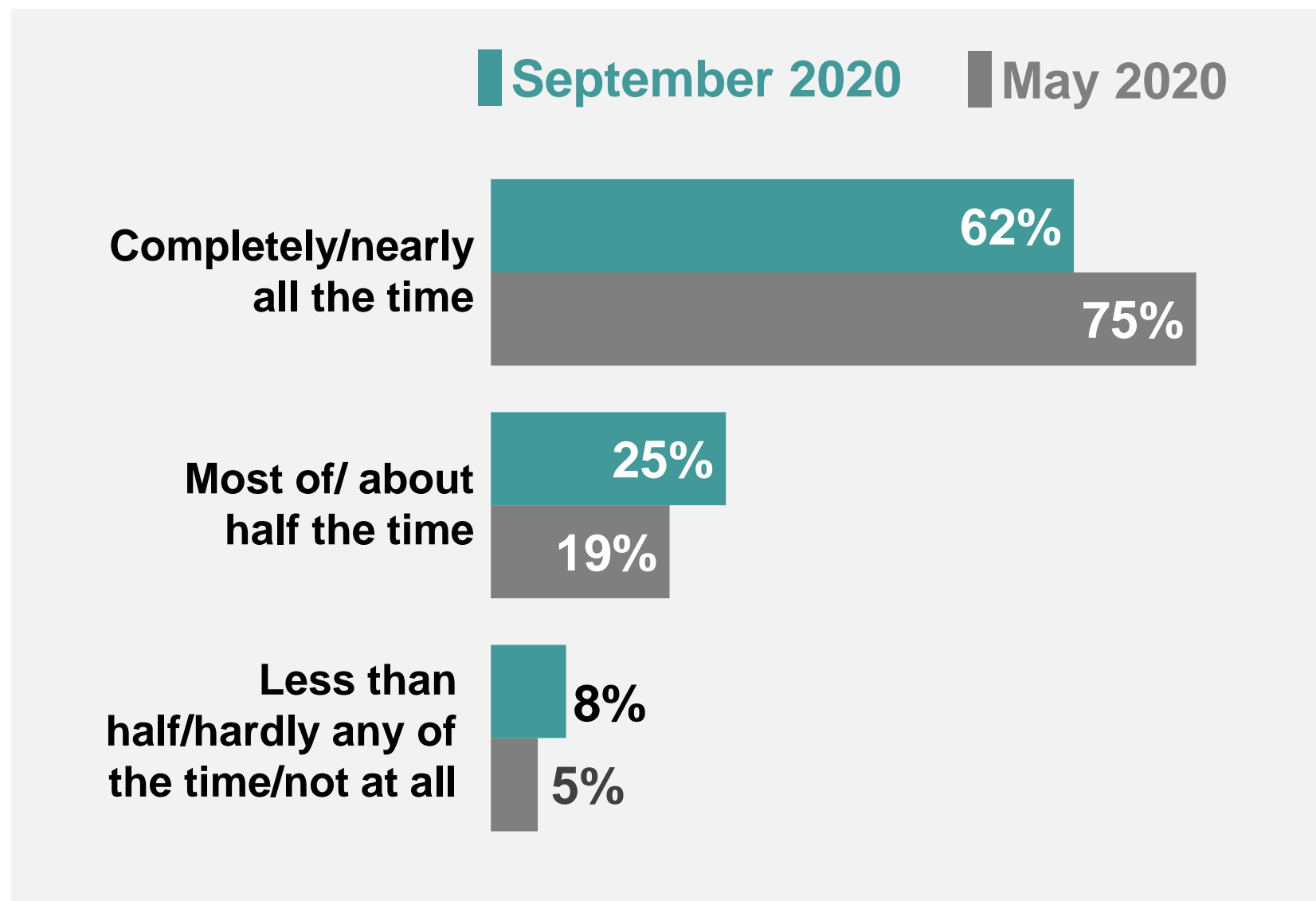

To what extent, if at all, are you personally following the Government's rules on how to respond to the coronavirus?



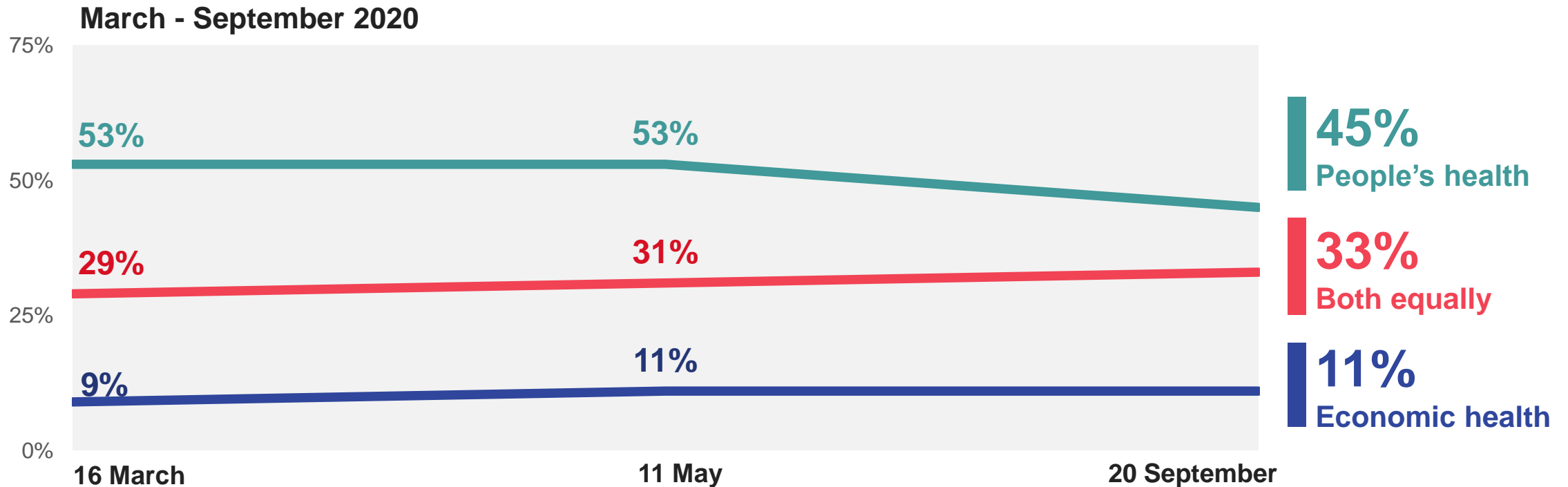

Please read the following pair of statements and then select the one which you agree with more strongly:

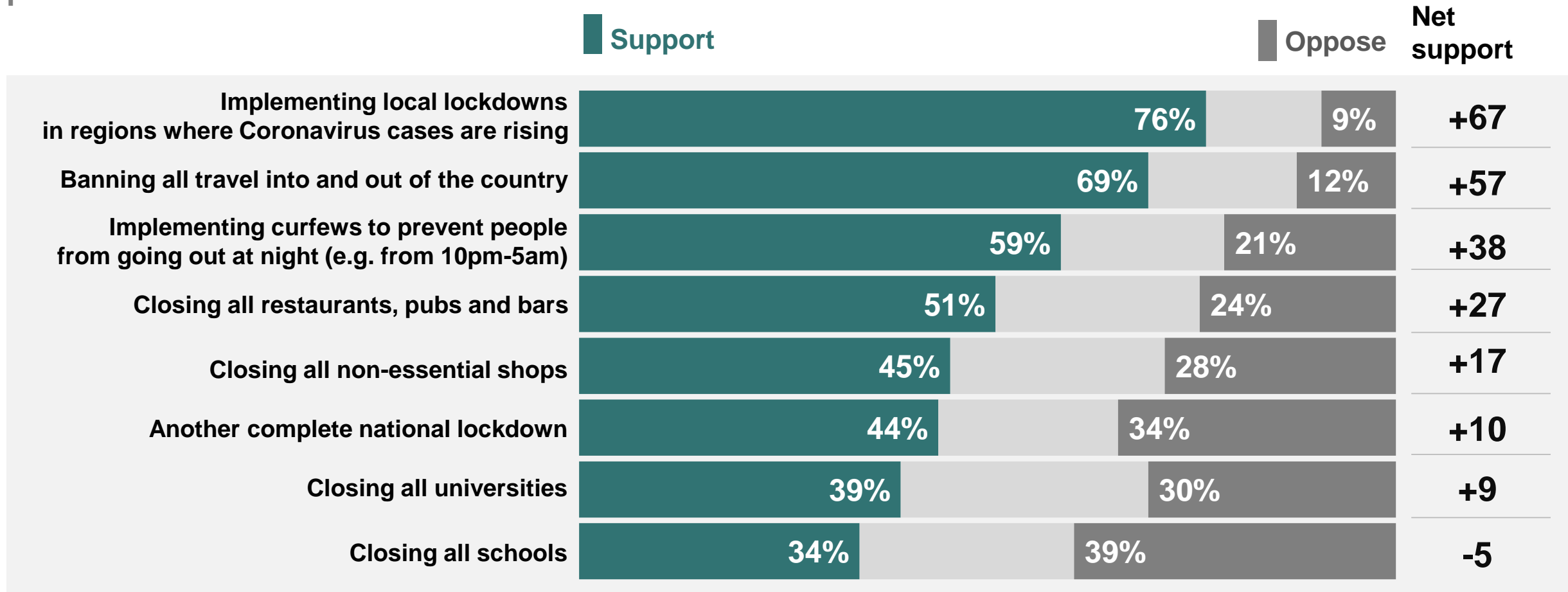
1. The Government should prioritise people's health by having more restrictions on public events, workplaces and travel
