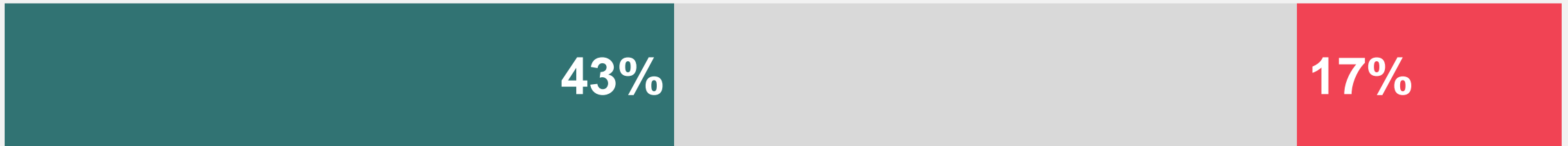

Do you think the following outcomes of the US presidential election would have a positive or negative impact on the UK's relationship with the US, or would they make no difference?

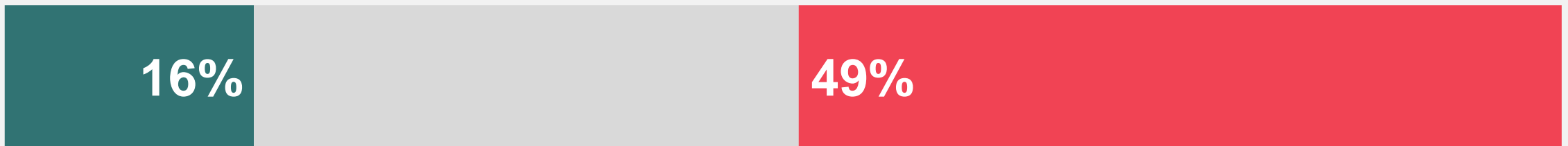

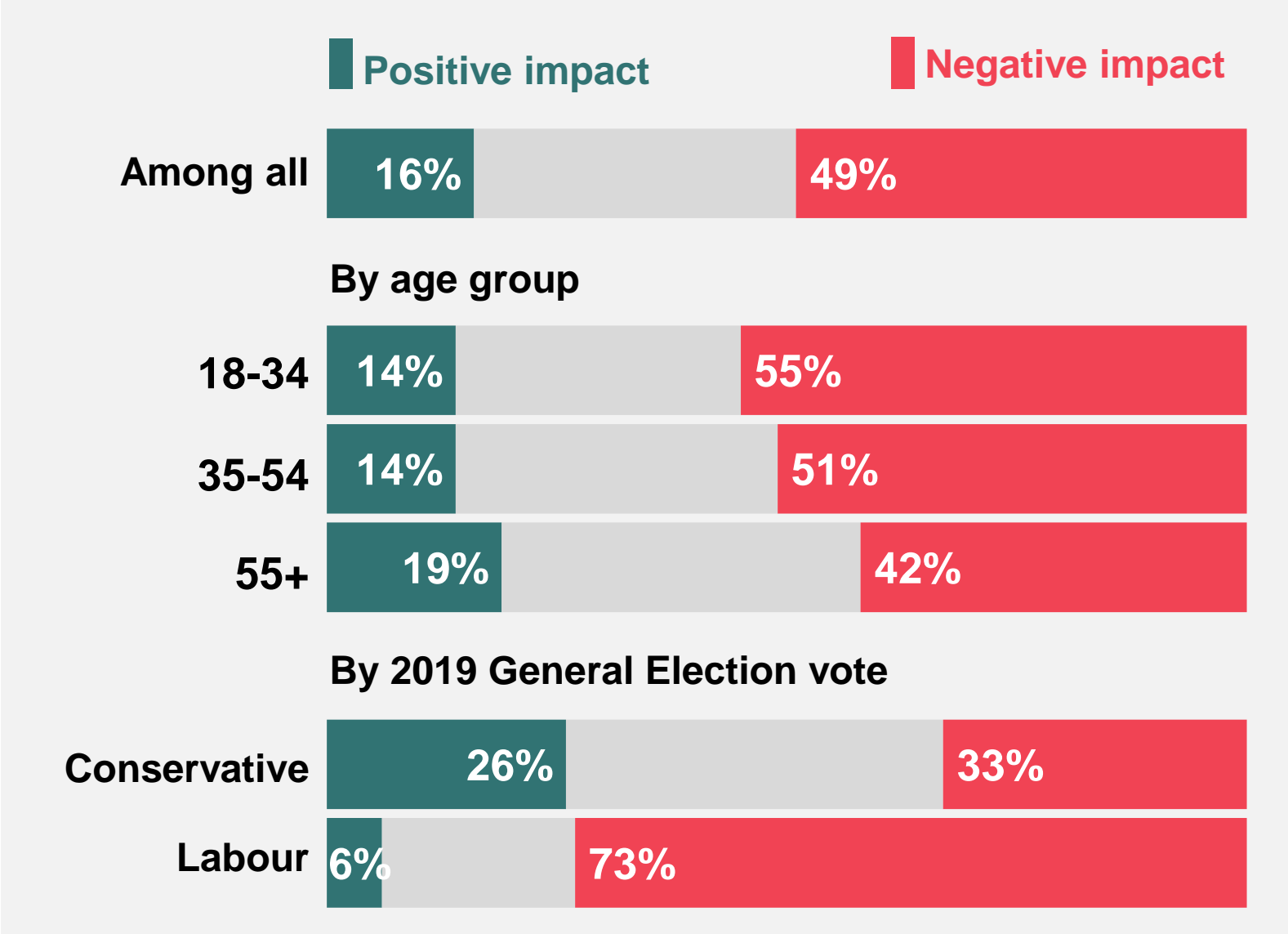

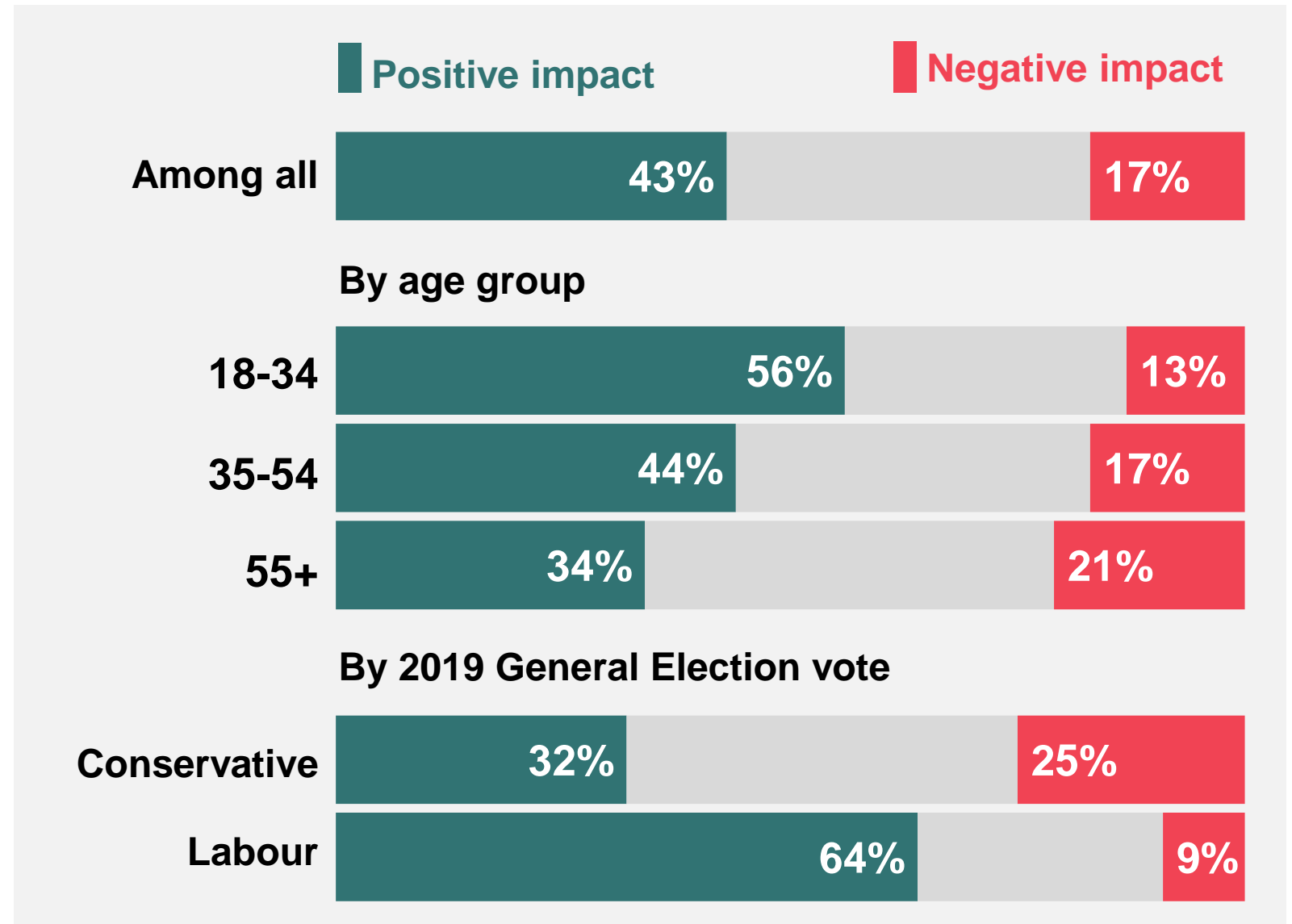

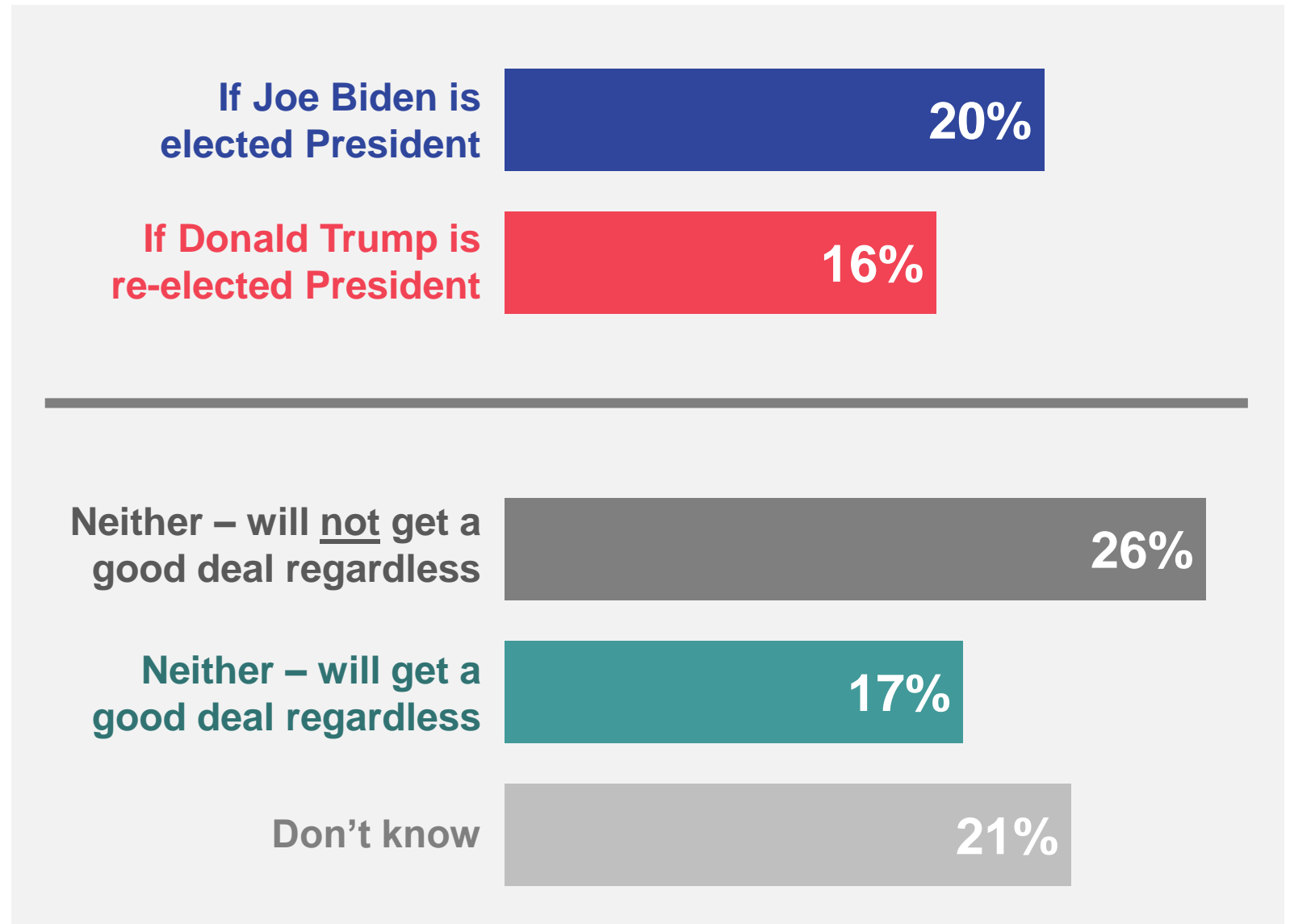

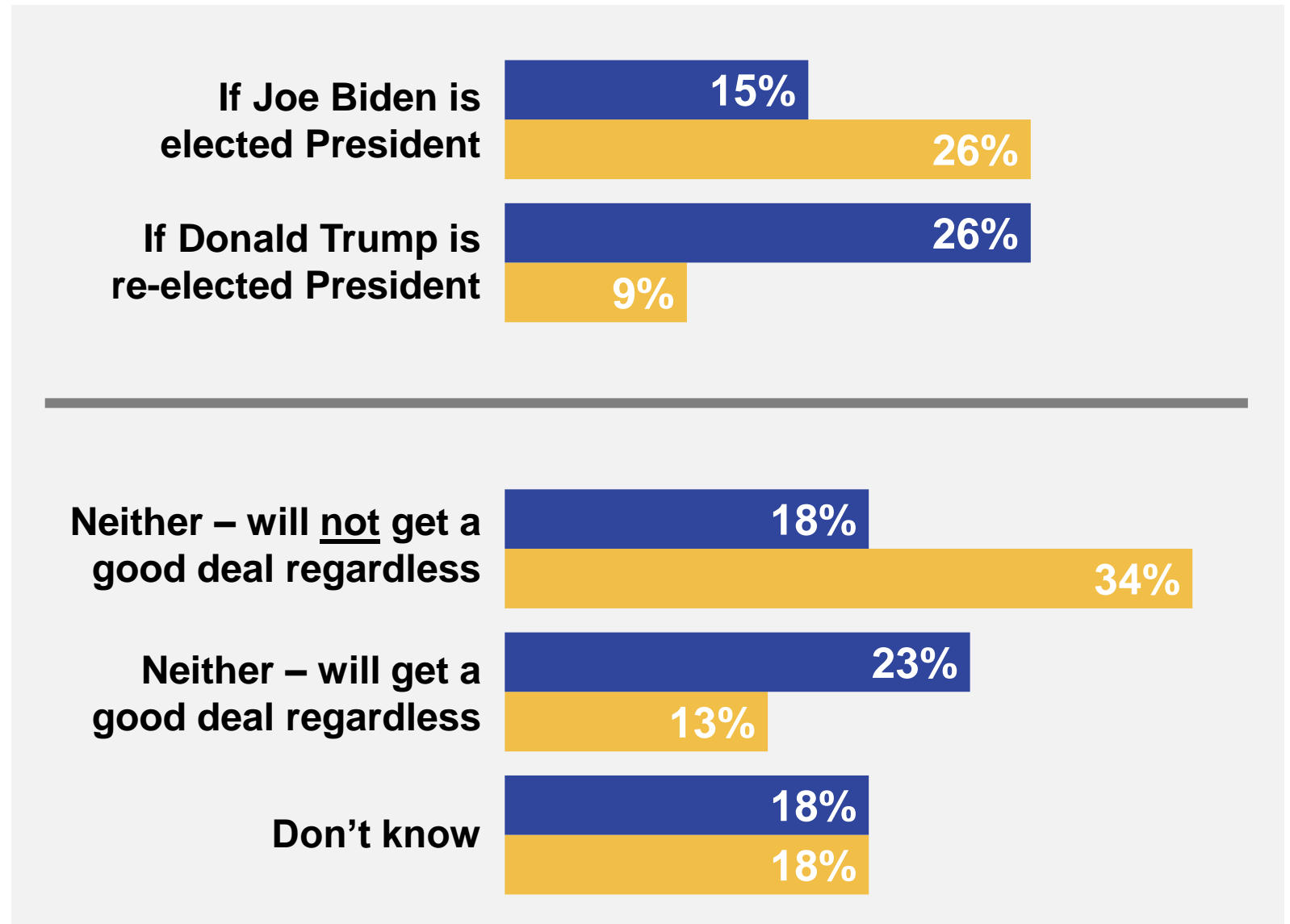

■ Among 2016 Remain voters



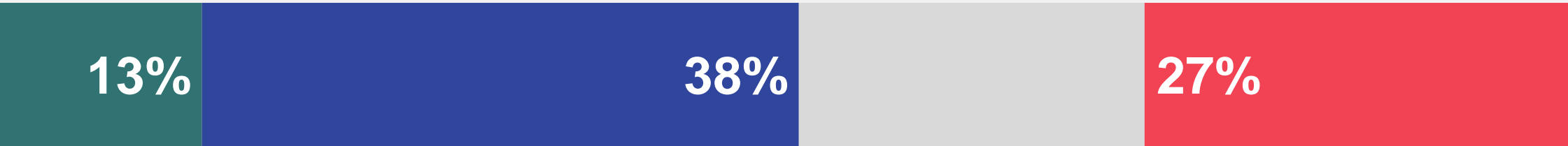

How does the United States use its influence around the world?

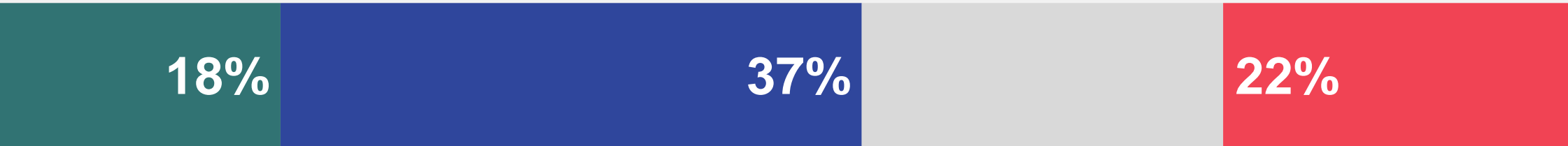
Do you think the United States currently mostly uses its influence for good or for bad around the world?
