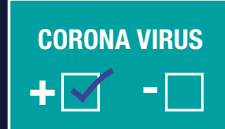

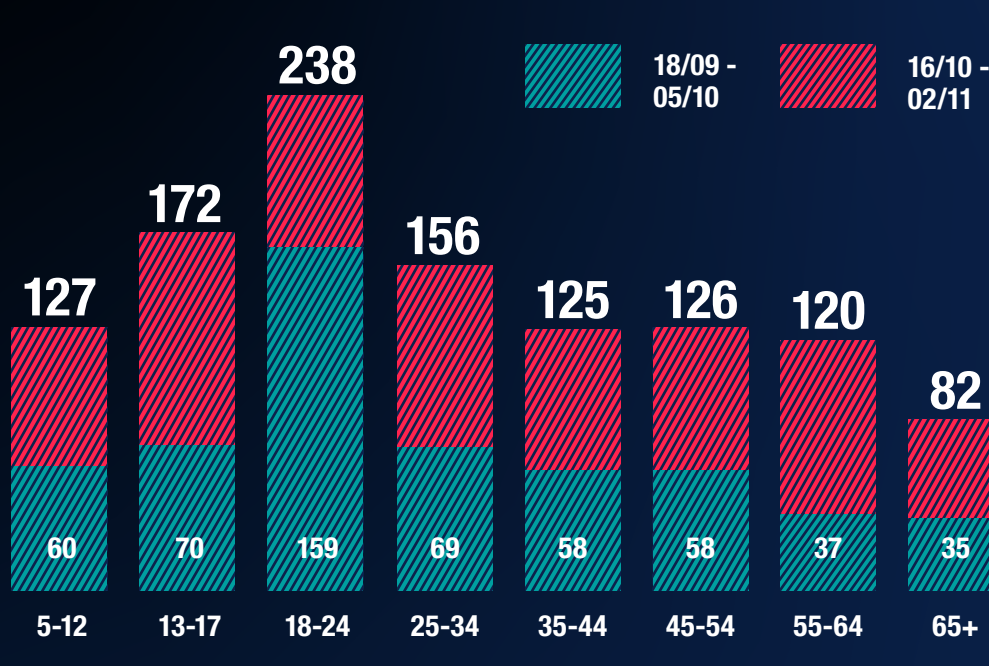

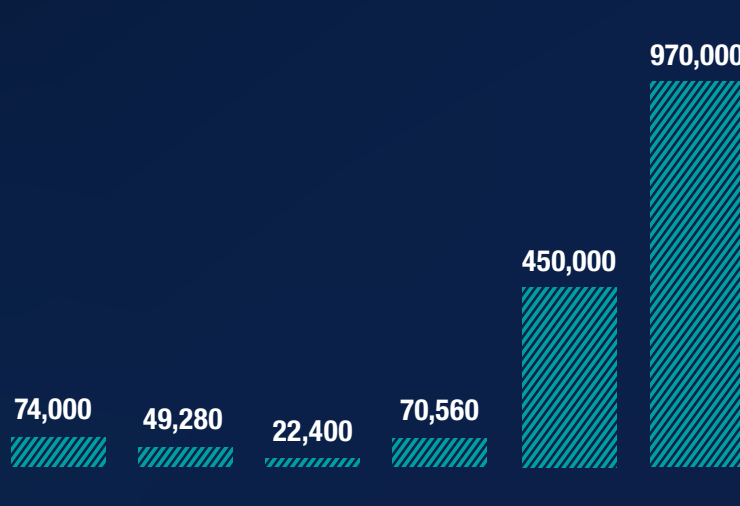
Positive tests by age group in England by 10,000 people

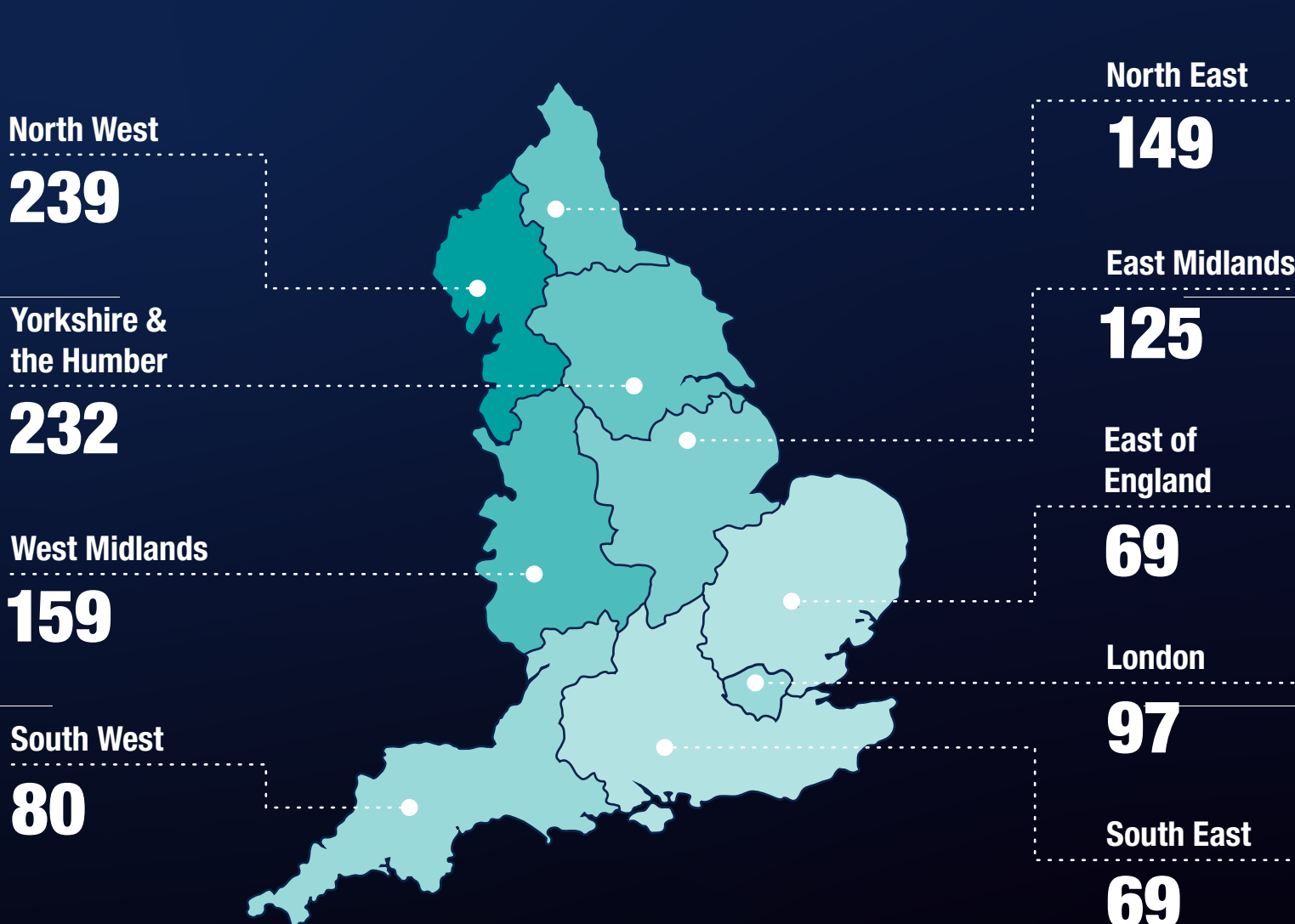
Number of people affected by time period **

Estimated number of people infected with COVID-19 virus on any one day in England

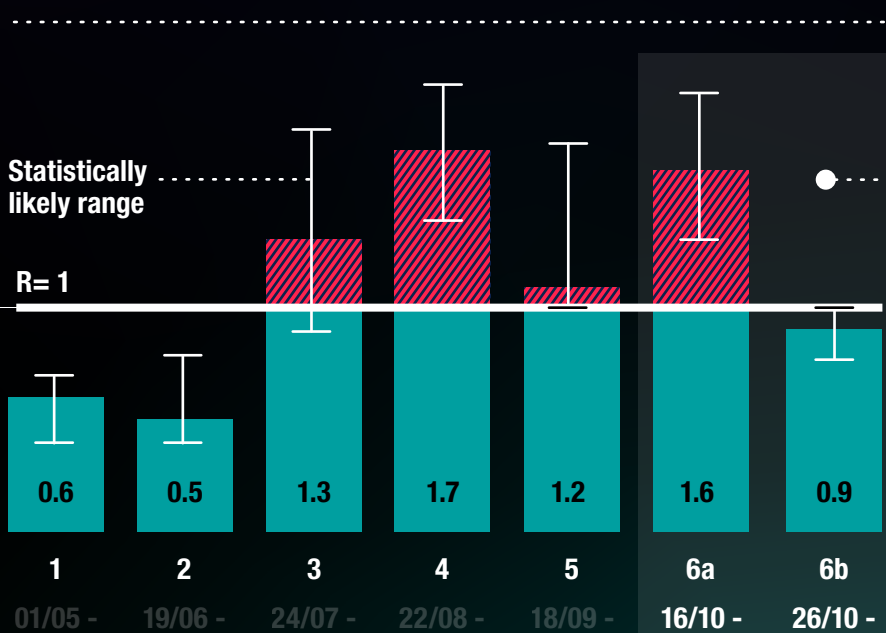

Round 6 R number

Due to a change in the trajectory of the virus between the first and second halves of Round 6 the R number is given for each half rather than for the overall round

* Prevalence estimates are adjusted for the test and weighted to be representative of the population of England
