


Which groups should be the highest priority to be vaccinated?

As you may know, the Government has prioritised the following groups to receive the COVID vaccination in the first stages of the UK's COVID vaccination roll-out:

- Staff working in care homes for older adults
- Frontline health and social care workers e.g. NHS staff
- People aged over 70
- People who are under 70 but clinically extremely vulnerable
