


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Holyrood Voting Intention: Constituency Vote

How do you intend to use your first (constituency) vote in the 2021 Scottish Parliament election?





This is especially important to keep in mind when calculating party lead figures.

On the basis of the historical record of the polls at recent general elections, there is a 9 in 10 chance that the true value of a party's support lies within 4 points of the estimates provided by this poll, and a 2 in 3 chance that they lie within 2 points. This is especially important to keep in mind when calculating party lead figures.














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Which issues are going to help voters decide which party to vote for?



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






Satisfaction with party leaders: Among own party supporters



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
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Support for Scottish independence: February 2021



If a referendum were held tomorrow about Scotland's constitutional future, how would you vote in response to the following question: <u>Should Scotland be an independent country?</u>









Technical note

Ipsos MORI Scotland interviewed a representative sample of 1,031 adults aged 16+ across Scotland. Interviews were conducted by telephone: 15-21 February 2021. Data are weighted by age, sex, region, social grade, working status, tenure, education and country of birth to match the profile of the population.

Where percentages do not sum to 100 this may be due to computer rounding, the exclusion of "don't know" categories, or multiple answers. An asterisk (*) denotes any value of less than half a per cent.

Questions are asked of the total sample of n=1,031 unless otherwise stated.
