# Government measures in relaxing Coronavirus lockdown

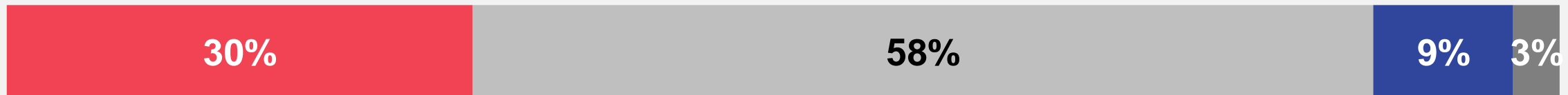

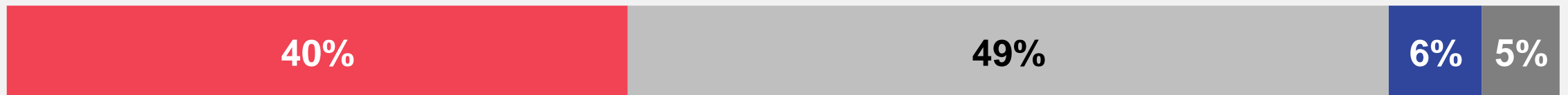

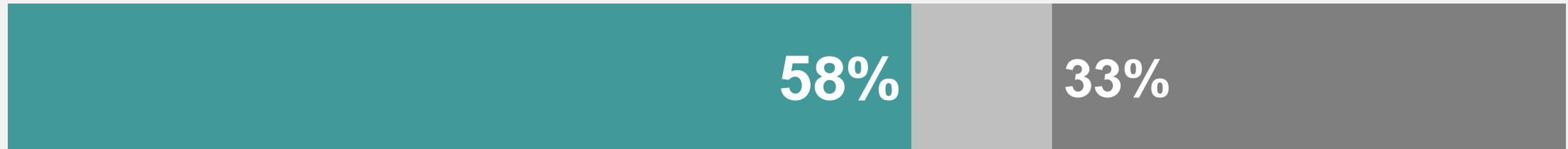
# Will the lockdown in England be lifted as scheduled?
