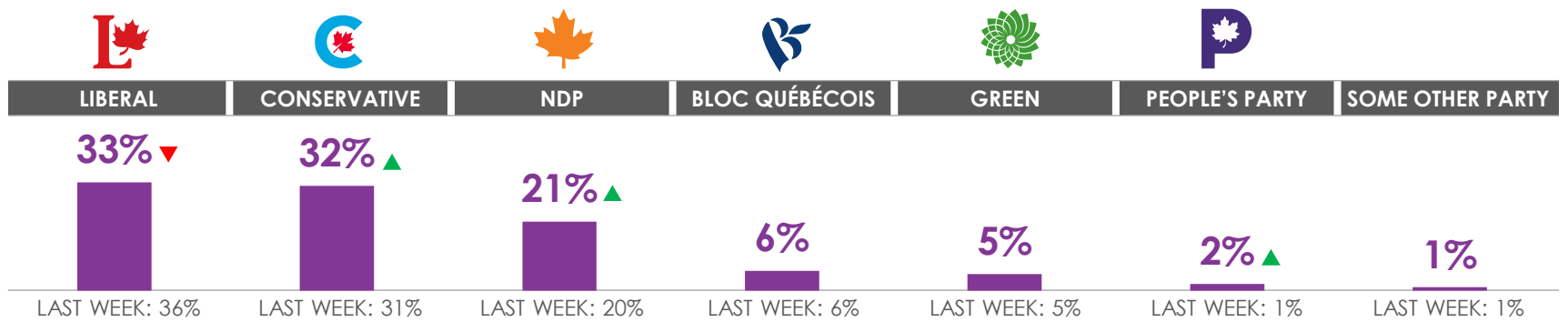

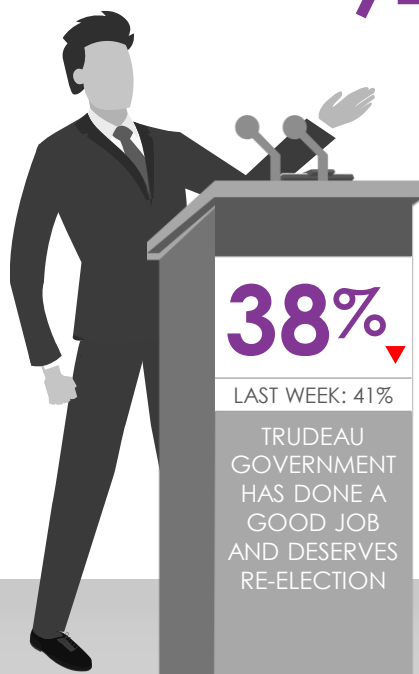


Opinions on Climate Change

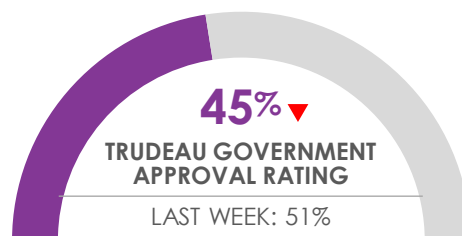
81% agree that the government should do more to support people impacted by extreme weather



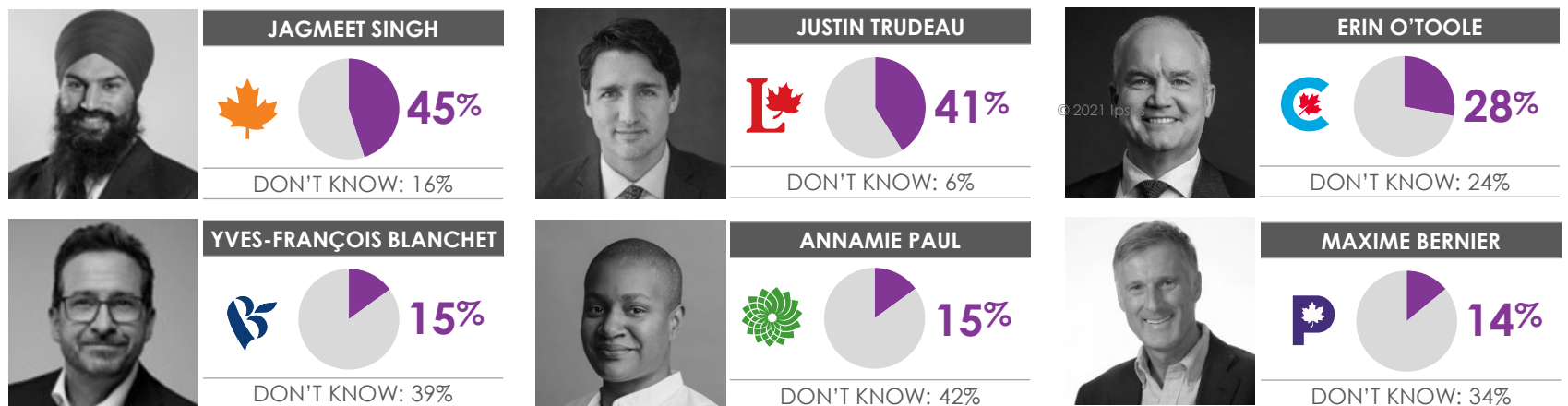
74% agree that they would be more supportive of a carbon tax if they knew the money was going directly to initiatives to combat climate change



DOES THE TRUDEAU GOVERNMENT DESERVE RE-ELECTION?

These are some of the findings of an Ipsos poll conducted between August 20-23, 2021, on behalf of Global News. For this survey, a sample of n = 1,500 Canadians aged 18+ was interviewed online, via the Ipsos I-Say panel and non-panel sources. Respondents earn a nominal incentive for their participation. Quotas and weighting were employed to balance demographics to ensure that the sample's composition reflects that of the adult population according to Census data and to provide results intended to approximate the sample universe. The precision of Ipsos polls which include non-probability sampling is measured using a credibility interval. In this case, the poll is accurate to within ± 3.5 percentage points, 19 times out of 20, had all Canadians been polled. The credibility interval will be wider among subsets of the population. All sample surveys and polls may be subject to other sources of error, including, but not limited to coverage error, and measurement error.
