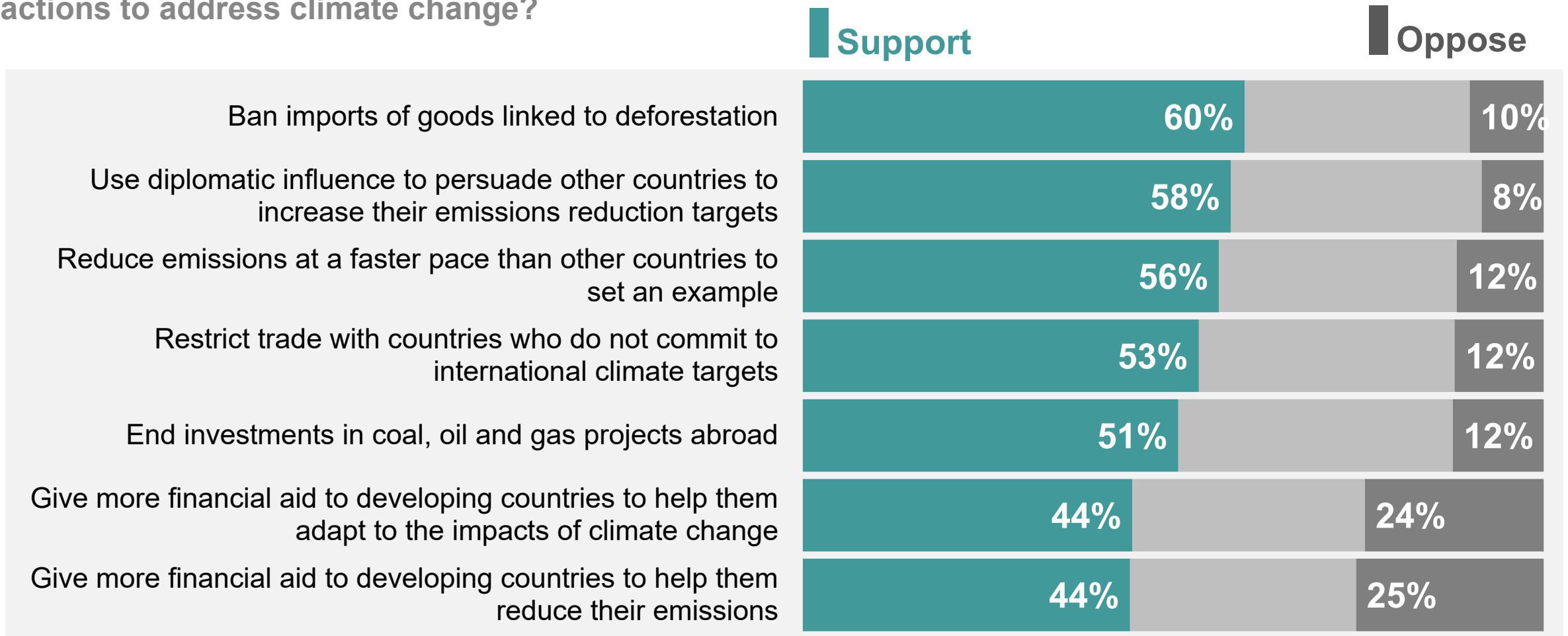

Support for international actions by the UK government to address climate change

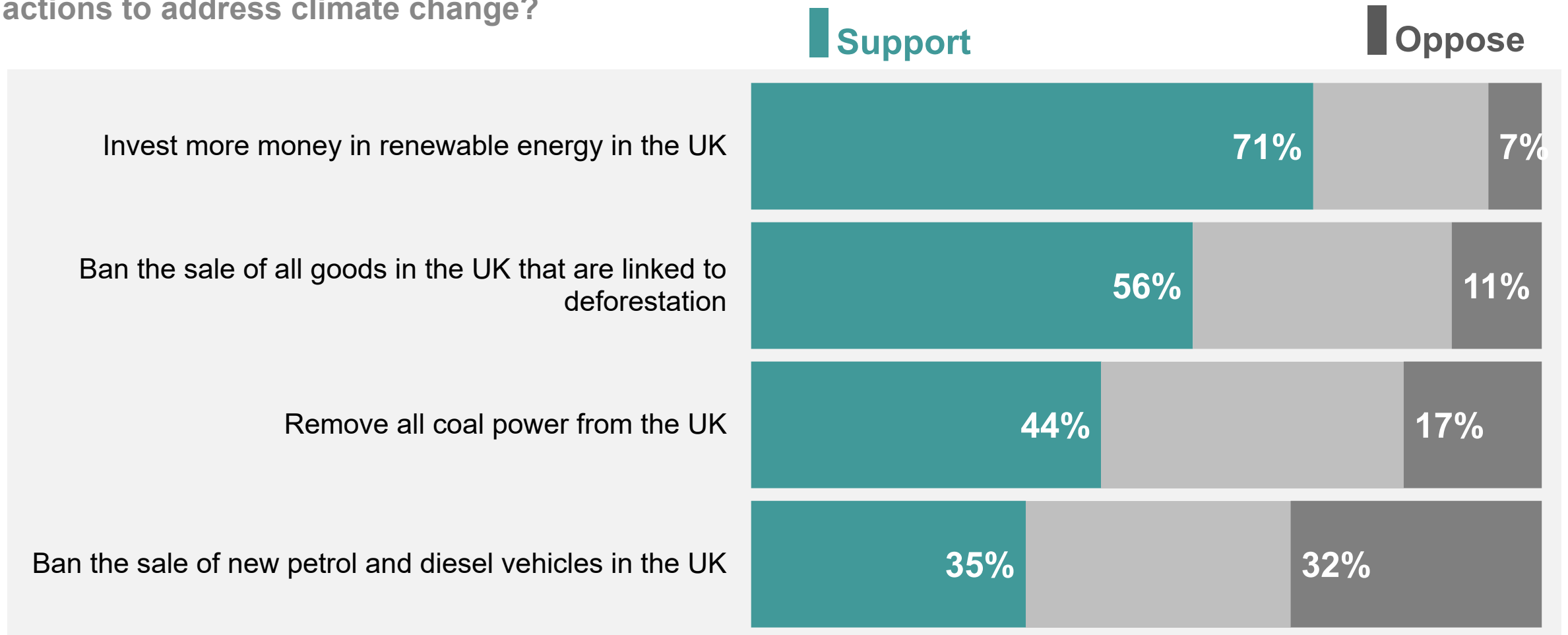
To what extent, if at all, do you support or oppose the UK government taking the following actions to address climate change?
