

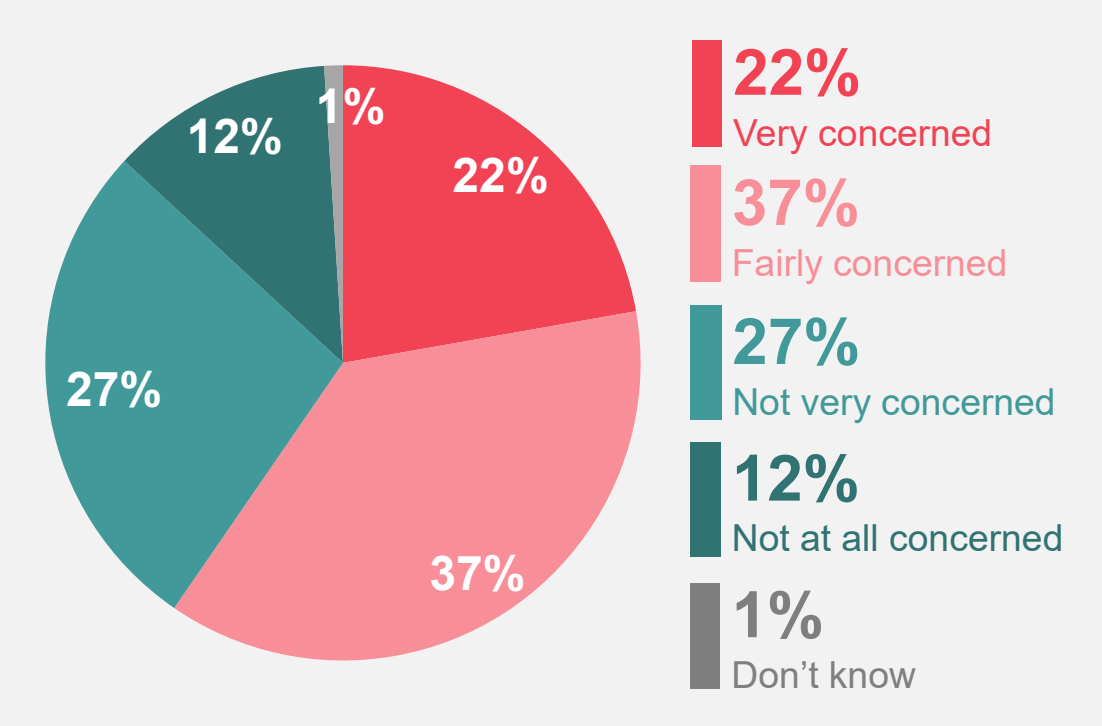

# Concern about the Coronavirus: For yourself

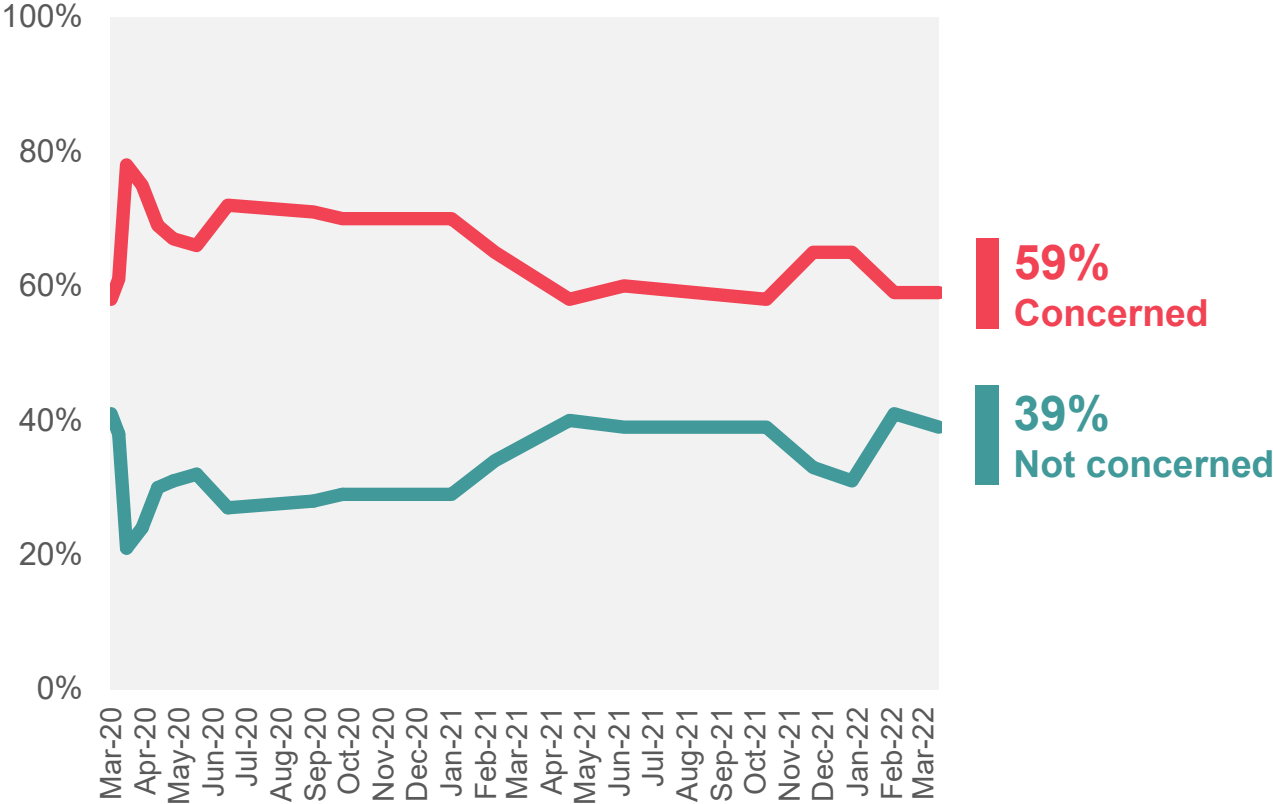
To what extent, if at all, would you say you are concerned about the risk Coronavirus poses to each of the following? Yourself

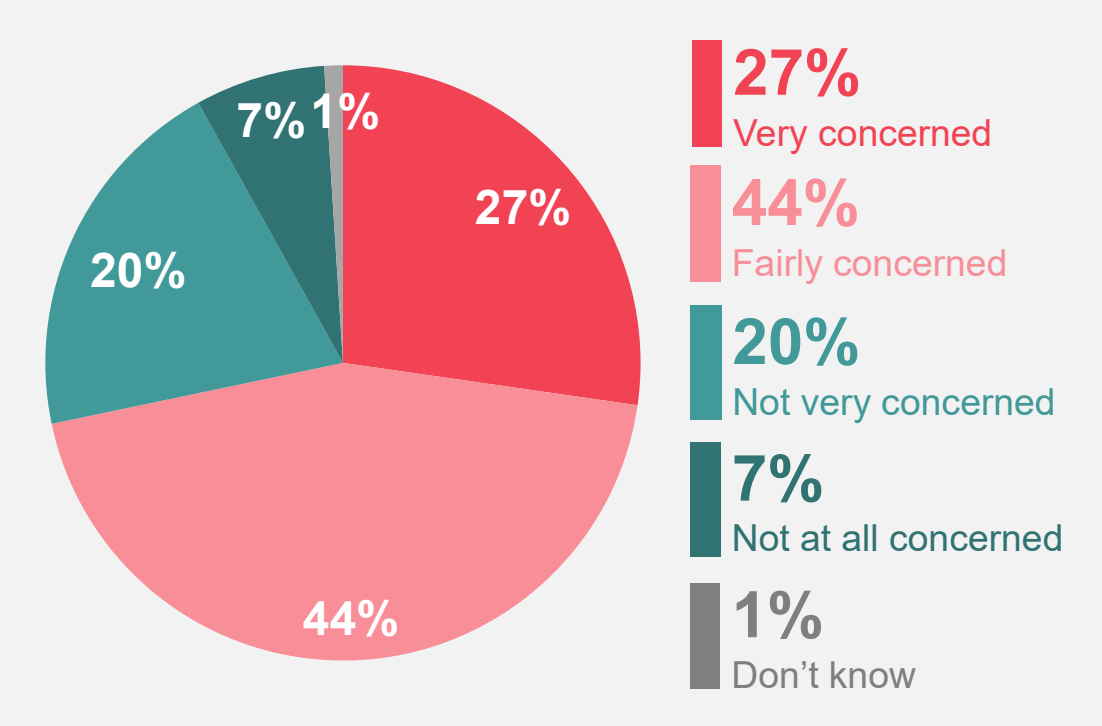

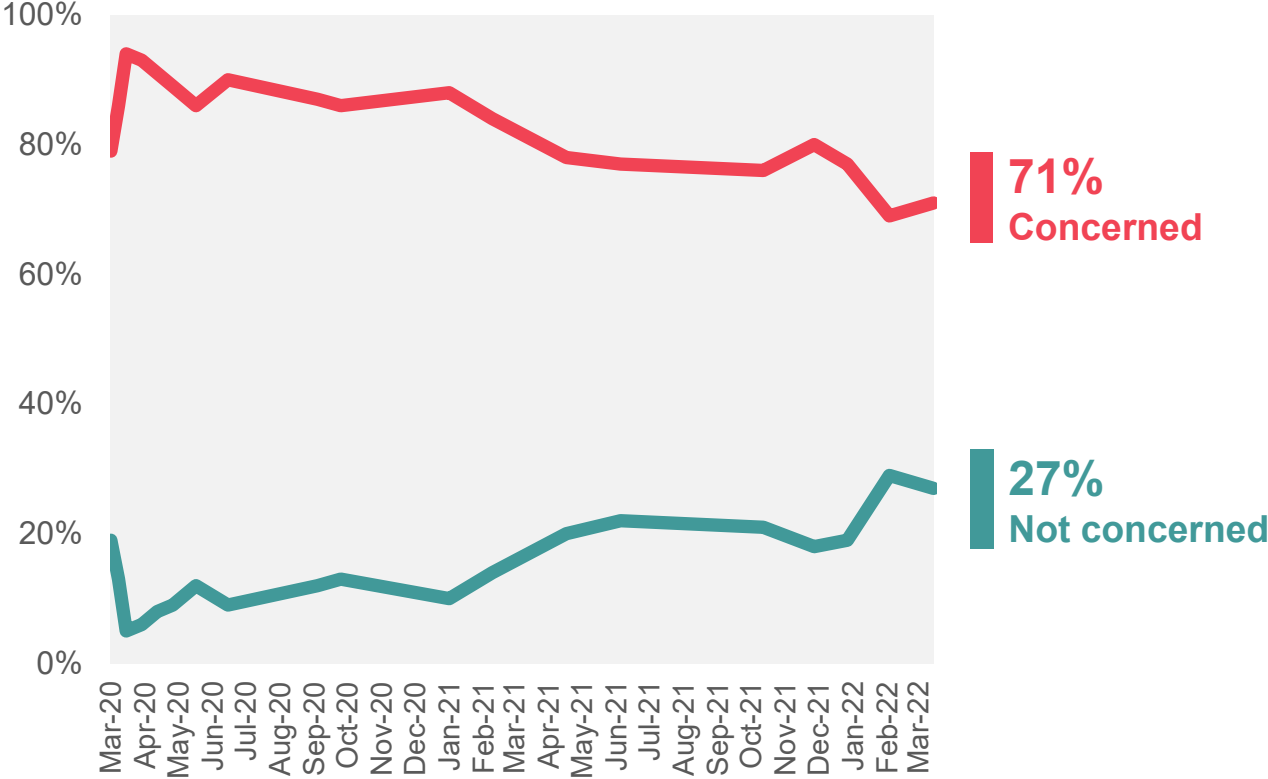
To what extent, if at all, would you say you are concerned about the risk Coronavirus poses to each of the following? The country as a whole

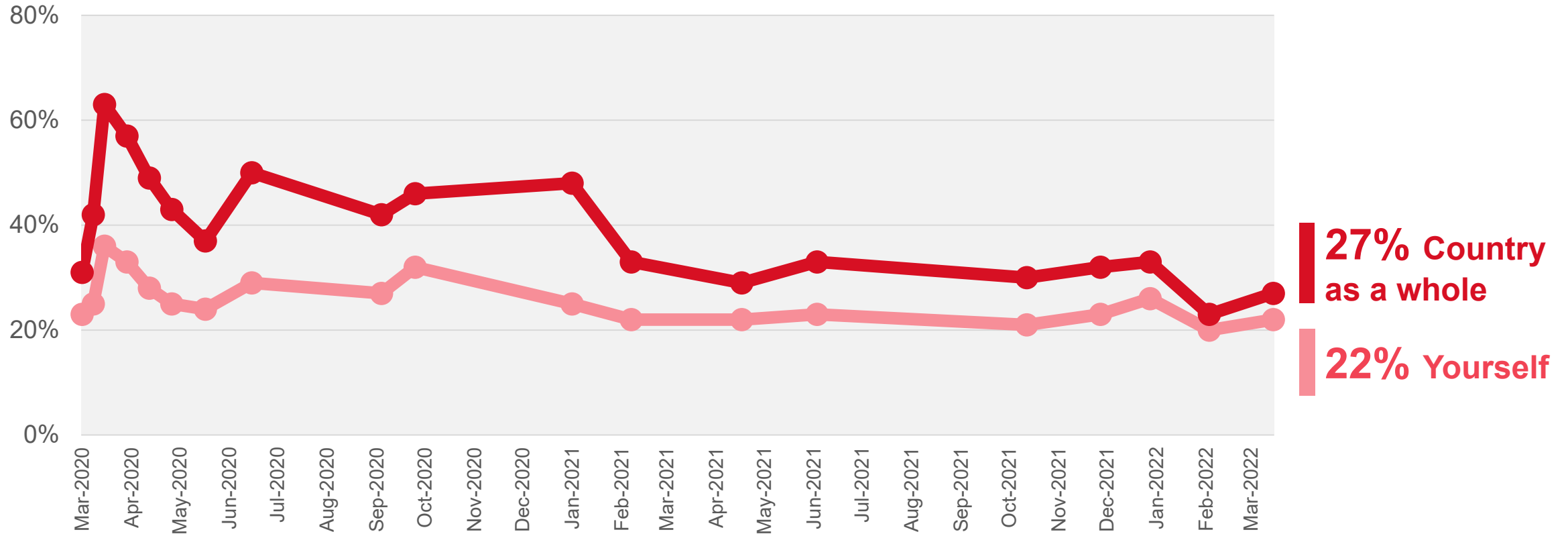

# Do you support stopping the provision of free COVID-19 tests?

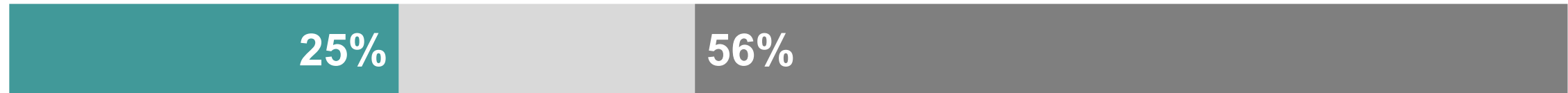
As you may know, the UK Government has also announced that from the 1st April COVID tests, including lateral flow tests and PCRs, will no longer be provided free for most people in England (although some symptomatic people who are elderly or vulnerable will still be able to receive them for free). In Scotland, the Scottish Government has also announced COVID tests for most people will no longer be free by the end of April, and in Wales free tests will end in June.

To what extent, if at all, do you support or oppose this decision to no longer provide free COVID tests for most people?\*

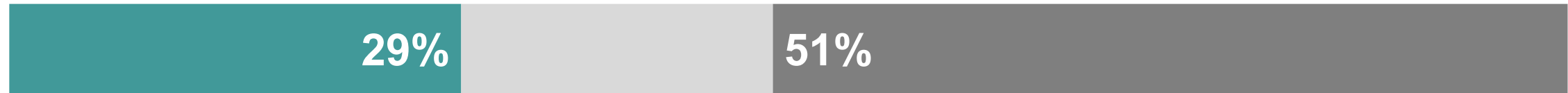

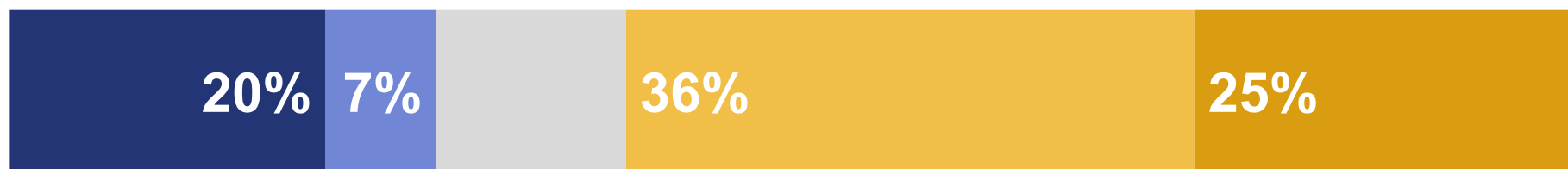

When COVID tests are no longer available for free, which, if any, of the following are you most likely to do if you have symptoms of COVID?

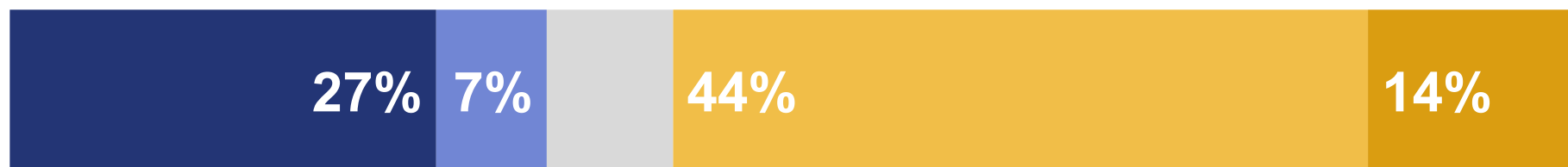


**If I have symptoms of COVID and I feel well...**
