





To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties? Boris Johnson








Keir Starmer: Favourability

To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties? Keir Starmer













To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties? Priti Patel















Favourability towards political parties










The Conservative party: Favourability

To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties? The Conservative party







To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties? The Liberal Democrats








The Green Party: Favourability







Generally speaking, do you think things in Great Britain are heading in the right direction or wrong direction?








Direction of the country: January 2020 – January 2022

Generally speaking, do you think things in Great Britain are heading in the right direction or wrong direction?


Net right direction






Direction of the country: By age group

Net right direction: January 2020 – March 2022










Impact of the UK's decision to leave the European Union










Image of the Boris Johnson: Trend data








Image of the Keir Starmer: Trend data











