





To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties? Boris Johnson







To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties? Keir Starmer













To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties? Priti Patel












































## Direction of the country: January 2020 – January 2022

Generally speaking, do you think things in Great Britain are heading in the right direction or wrong direction?








### Direction of the country: By age group








## Impact of the UK's decision to leave the European Union


Overall, do you think the UK's decision to leave the European Union has had a positive or negative impact on the country, or has it made no difference?








## Image of the Boris Johnson: Trend data






