






Do you support or oppose sanctions against Russia?

Do you support action taken by FIFA + UEFA against Russia?

This week, FIFA and UEFA suspended all Russian football clubs and national teams from all competitions. This means that the Russian men's team cannot play in the 2022 World Cup and Spartak Moscow have been thrown out of the Europa League. The Russian Women's team can also no longer compete in this summer's European Championships. Meanwhile, UEFA have ended their sponsorship agreement with Russian energy firm Gazprom.
