


# What makes you proud to be British?

Please select up to 3 options.





English adults (2022 vs. 2013)







**2013:** Base = 883 Online English adults aged 16-75, 6 – 11 December 2013





# On what date is St. George's day celebrated in England?

Across all of GB (England, Scotland and Wales), we surveyed 1036 respondents.

60% chose the correct answer; 23rd April.

This compares to **62%** choosing this date in an Ipsos face-to-face survey of 998 GB adults aged 15 and over, conducted in 2012 (27 January – 5 February).







#### **Technical notes**

- The research was carried out by Ipsos UK.
- Ipsos UK interviewed a representative quota sample of 1,036 adults aged 16-75 in Great Britain. 885 of the interviews were held with respondents residing in England. Interviews took place on the online Omnibus using the Ipsos. Digital platform on 5<sup>th</sup> April 2022.
- The sample obtained is representative of the population with quotas on:
  - Age
  - Gender
  - Region
  - Working Status
  - Social Grade
- The data has been weighted to the known offline population proportions for age, working status and social grade within gender, and for government office region and education, to reflect the adult population of the United Kingdom.
