

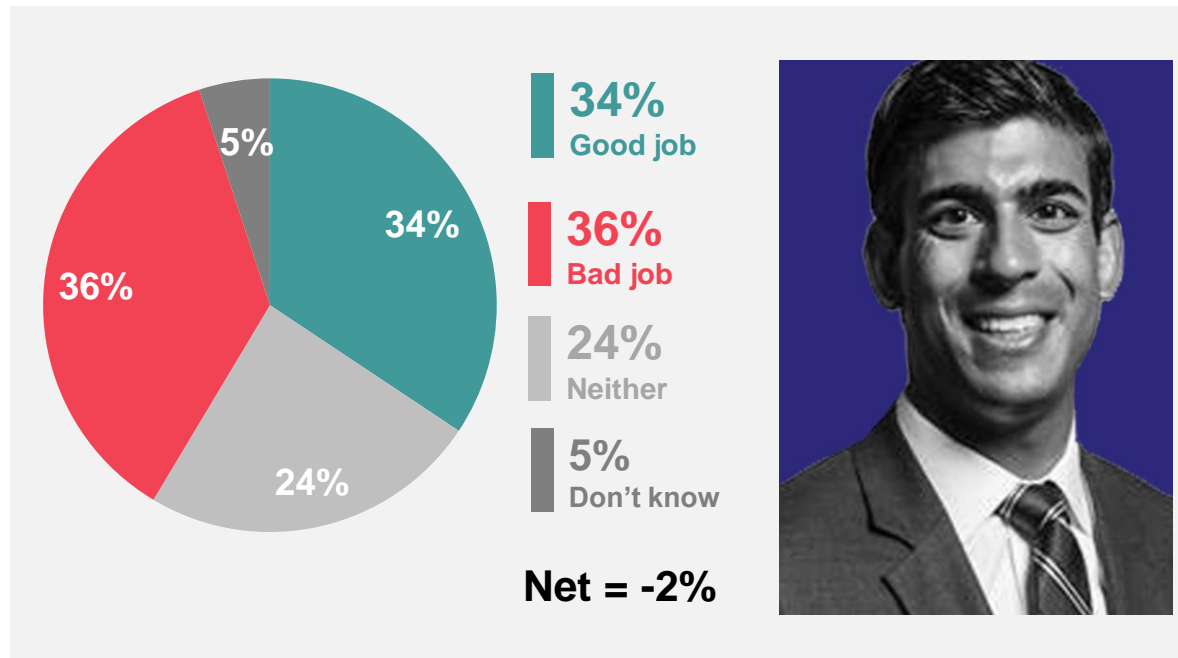

# The public are split over whether Rishi Sunak is doing a good or bad job

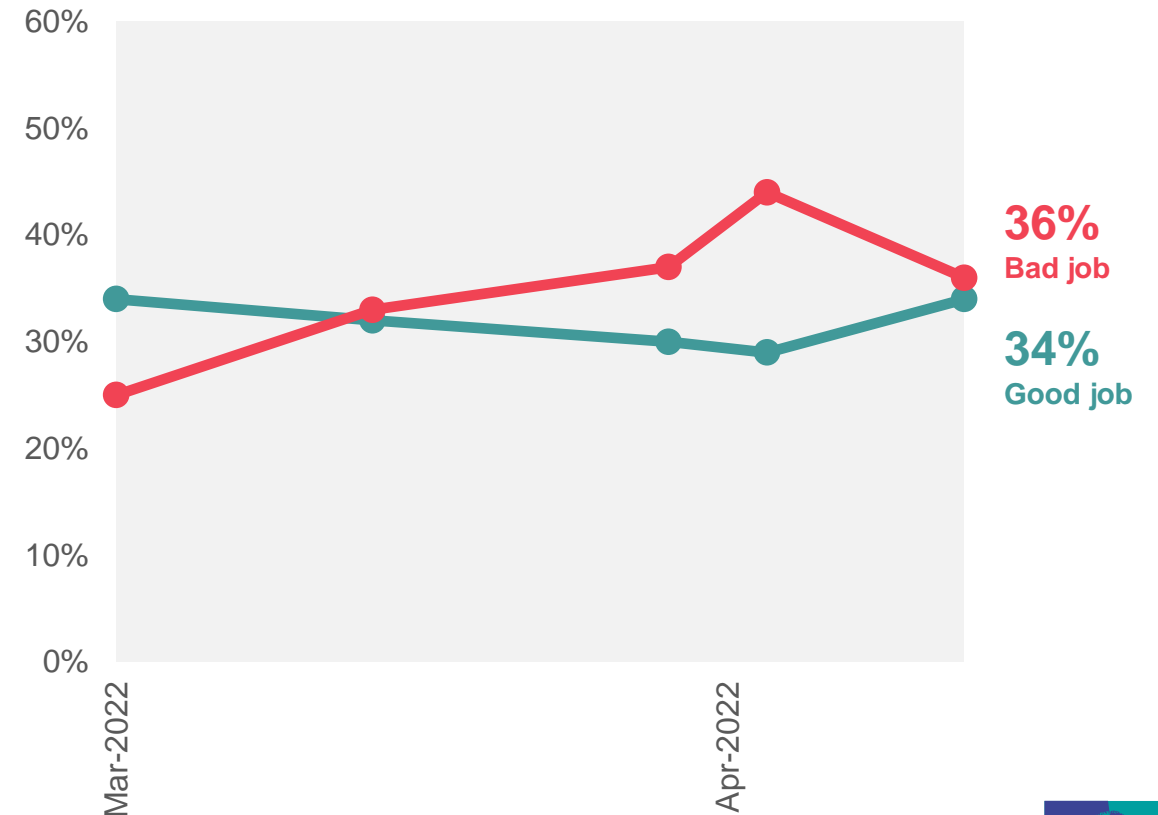
To what extent, if at all, do you think Rishi Sunak has been doing a good job or a bad job, in his role as Chancellor of the Exchequer?

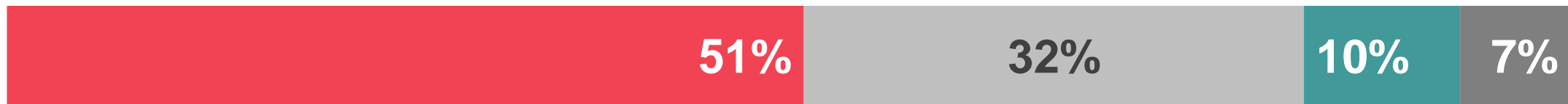


# Half say they feel less positive towards Rishi Sunak compared to a year ago, including over two in five Conservative voters

## Among 2019 Conservative voters



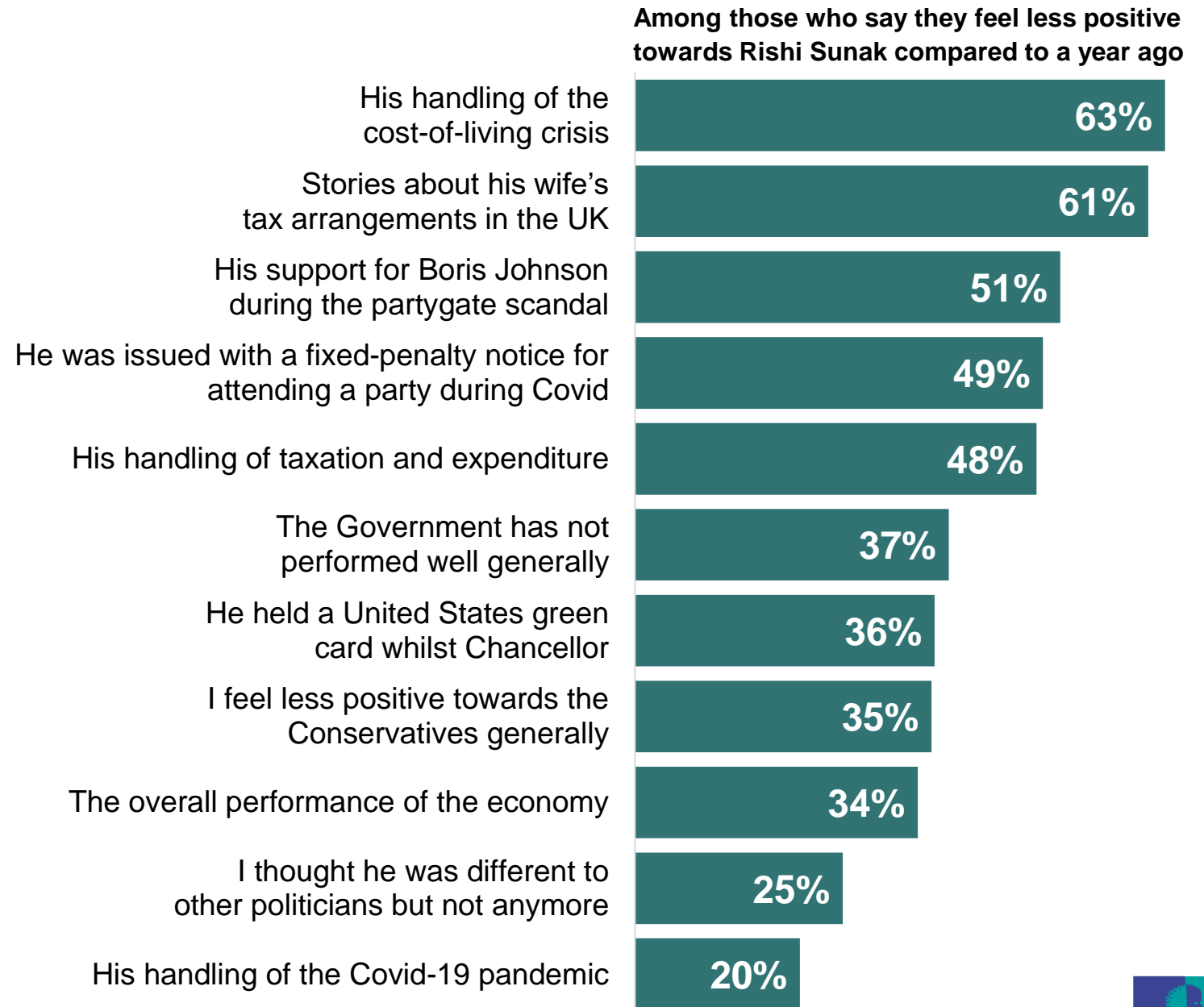
## Among 2019 Labour voters
