


The Labour party continue to be slightly more trusted to manage Britain's taxes and public spending compared to the Conservatives

To what extent, if at all, do you trust each of the following political parties to manage Britain's taxes and public spending?








Two in five trust the Labour party to reduce their cost of living, compared to only a quarter trusting the Conservatives

... at tackling the cost of living crisis in Britain?


