



Voting Intention: May 2022

How do you intend to vote in the General Election? Will you vote...?








Base: 1,013 British adults 18+, 11th – 17th May 2022; Headline Voting Intention: all 9/10 certain to vote, always/usually/it depends vote in General Elections = 639. Margin of error is displayed at +/- 4% All polls are subject to a wide range of potential sources of error. On the basis of the historical record of the polls at recent general elections, there is a 9 in 10 chance that the true value of a party's support lies within 4 points of the estimates provided by this poll, and a 2 in 3 chance that they lie within 2 points. This is especially important to keep in mind when calculating party lead figures.

How would you vote if there were an election tomorrow?





Are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the way.... is running the country / doing his job as Prime Minister /Leader of the Labour Party?






Boris Johnson: Satisfaction

Are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the way Boris Johnson is doing his job as prime minister?








Boris Johnson: Satisfaction among Conservative supporters

Are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the way Boris Johnson is doing his job as prime minister?





How satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the way ... is doing his/her job as prime minister?





Number of months after assuming government







Number of months after becoming opposition leader




Keir Starmer: Satisfaction amongst Labour supporters







Ed Davey: Satisfaction










Economic Optimism Index

Do you think that the general economic condition of the country will improve, stay the same or get worse over the next 12 months?





Are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the way the Government is handling the Russian invasion of Ukraine?

















Should Keir Starmer resign, which one of the following Labour politicians, if any, would make you most likely to vote for the Labour Party if they were leader?







Party trust on key issues: May 2022




