
Over two in five think Europe is **Britain's most** important relationship








The proportion who think Brexit has made daily life worse has risen to nearly half; almost one in five now think it has made daily life better

To what extent has Britain's exit from the EU made your daily life better or worse, or has it made no difference?



To what extent has Britain's exit from the EU made your daily life better or worse, or has it made no difference?



Four in five think it is important for Britain to maintain a close relationship with the EU


Now Britain has left the European Union, how important, if at all, do you think it will be for Britain to maintain a close relationship with the EU?





But just two in five think a close relationship between Britain and the EU is likely – an improvement from 2020


And how likely, if at all, do you think it is that Britain and the EU will have a close relationship now Britain has left?





Improving trade arrangements with the EU is the top priority for Britons


And which two or three of these, if any, do you think should be the top priorities for the Britain's relationship with the European Union?





Many think that Britain's and the EU's interests are partly the same but partly at odds


Thinking about your top priorities for Britain's relationship with the European Union, do you think that on the whole Britain's interests and the European Union's interests are similar or do you think they are at odds?





Britons are split over whether Britain and the EU can work together to achieve satisfactory outcomes on their priorities


And how confident, if at all, are you that Britain and the European Union will work together to achieve an outcome on your top priorities that you find satisfactory?
