


Seven in ten think there is a national housing crisis, just under half think there is a local one

Q1. To what extent do you agree or disagree with each of the following statements...?










'There is a housing crisis in my local area'










There has been a small increase in the proportion recognising a national housing crisis

'There is a housing crisis in Britain'






There has been a sharp increase in the sense of local crisis

'There is a housing crisis in my local area'






National crisis felt as strongly among owner-occupier as renters

'There is a housing crisis in Britain'










'There is enough affordable housing available to buy or rent in my local area'






Most people continue to disagree that housing gets a lot of political attention

'The political parties pay a lot of attention to housing problems'






A majority continue to consider increasing housing supply as a precondition of solving problems

'Unless we build a lot more homes in Britain, we will never solve the country's housing problems'







Most think young people will struggle to get the right kind of housing

'Even if today's young people work hard and get good jobs, they will have a hard time getting the right kind of housing'








Most renters remain gloomy about their prospects for buying

'I don't believe I will ever be able to afford to buy a home' (Renters only)







Six in ten people think that getting on the property ladder is important

'Getting on the property ladder is one of the most important ways of getting on in life'








Having risen during 2019-20, opposition to local home building has cooled. A plurality say they support more building


Q3. To what extent would you support or oppose more homes being built in your local area?






Levels of support are lower, relatively speaking, among owneroccupiers and Conservative voters

Q3. To what extent would you support or oppose more homes being built in your local area?








Support is relatively low and opposition high in the North East and South East of England, and in Wales

Q4. Here are some of the possible options for building new homes. Again, in principle, to what extent would you support or oppose new homes being built in your local area if...


