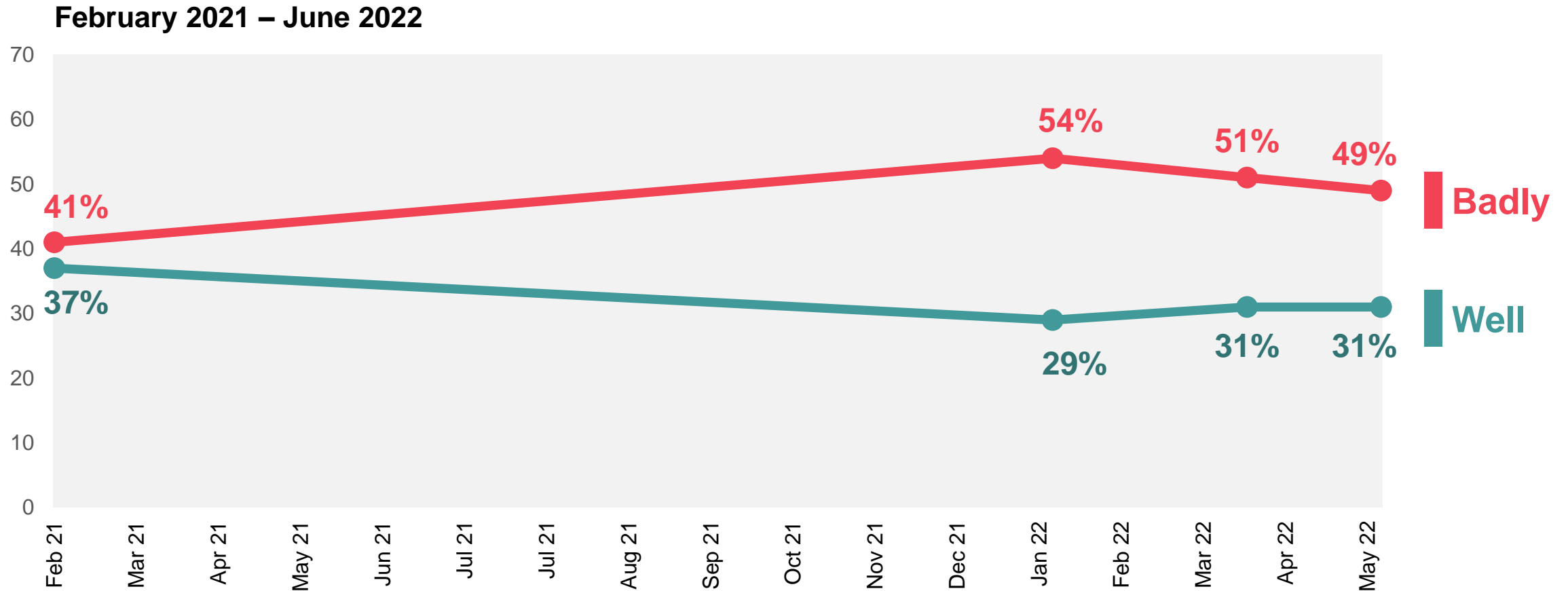

# Half say Boris Johnson has done a bad job as Prime Minister

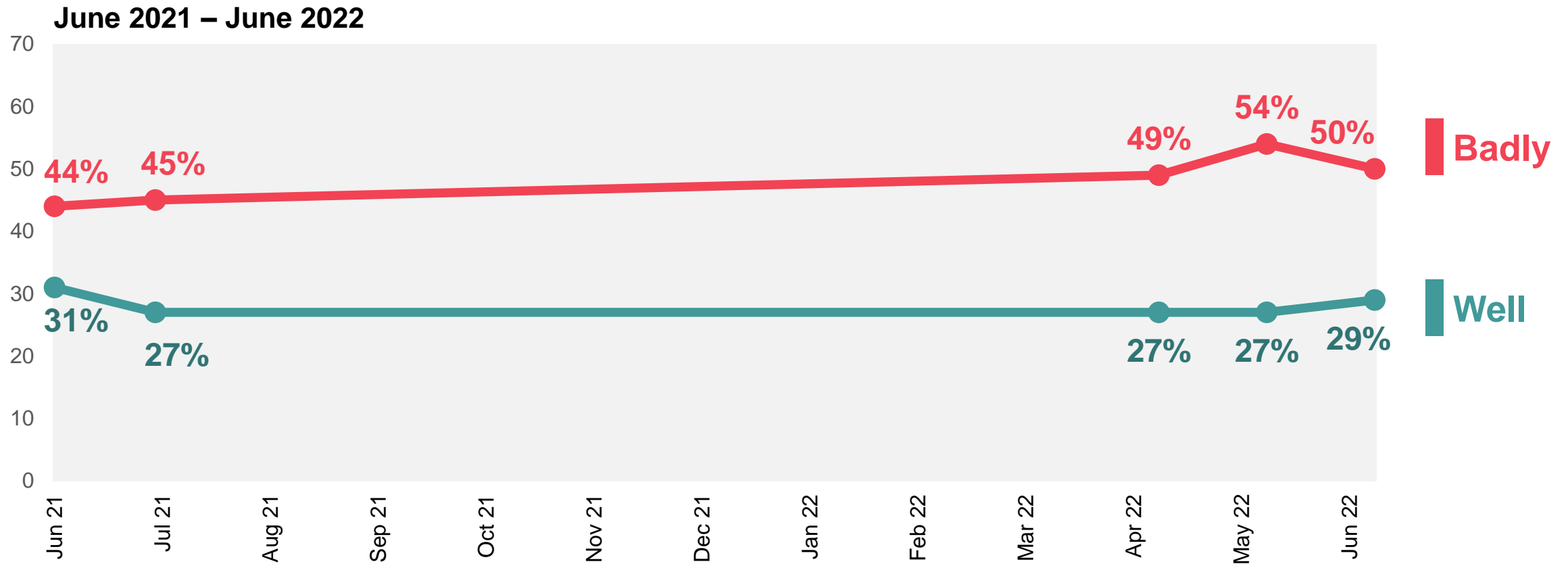
Based on his performance to date, would you say Boris Johnson has done a good job or bad job as Prime Minister, or neither?

# Two in five think the outcome of the vote of confidence was a bad result for the Prime Minister, against a third saying it was good

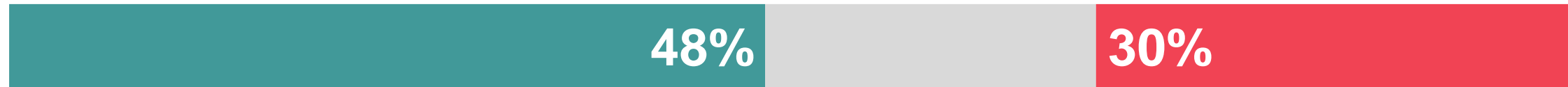

## Among 2019 Conservative voters



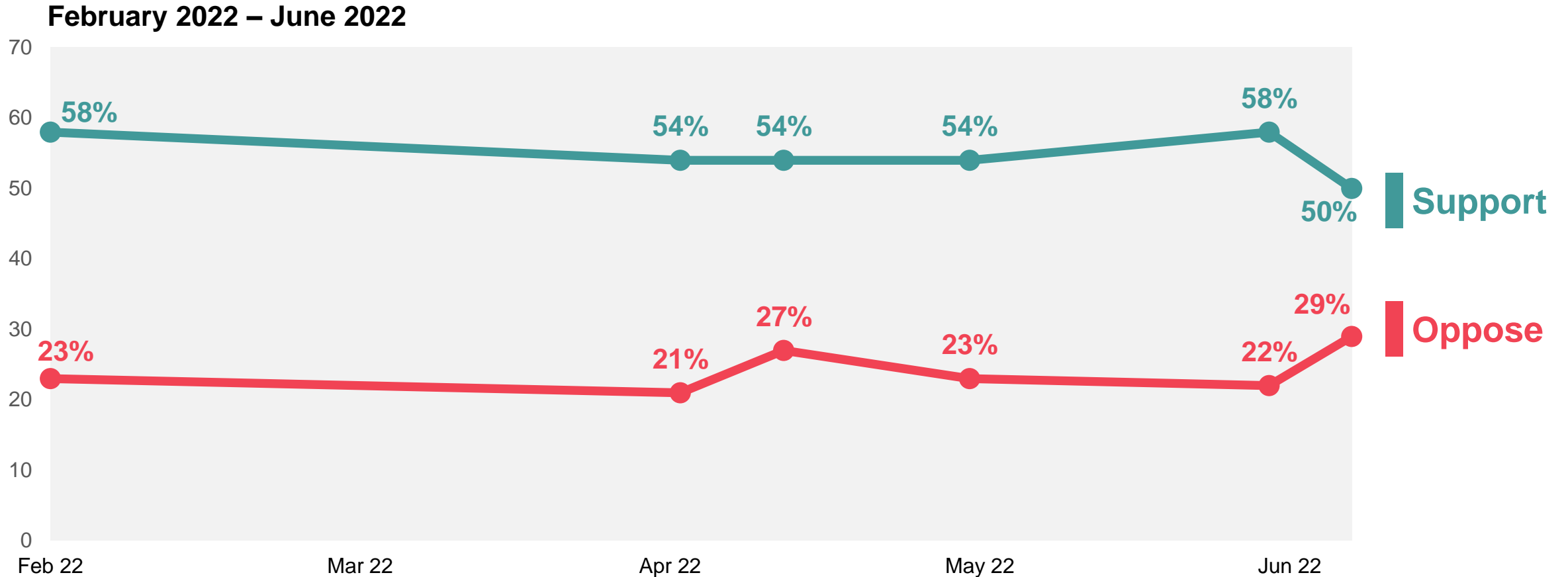

Would you support or oppose Boris Johnson resigning as Prime Minister?



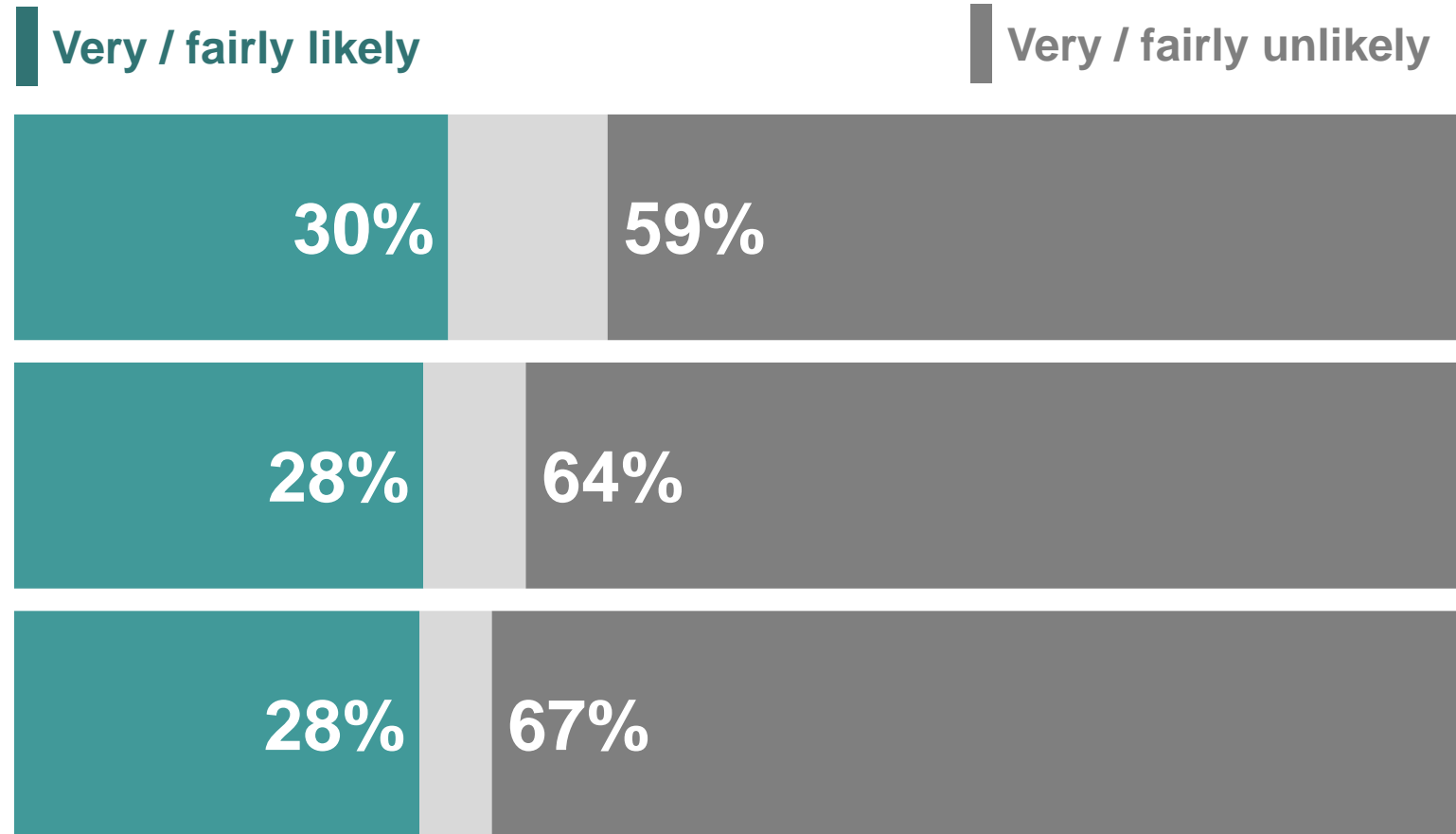

# Around two in three say it is unlikely Boris Johnson will unite the Conservative party behind him or improve public trust in him

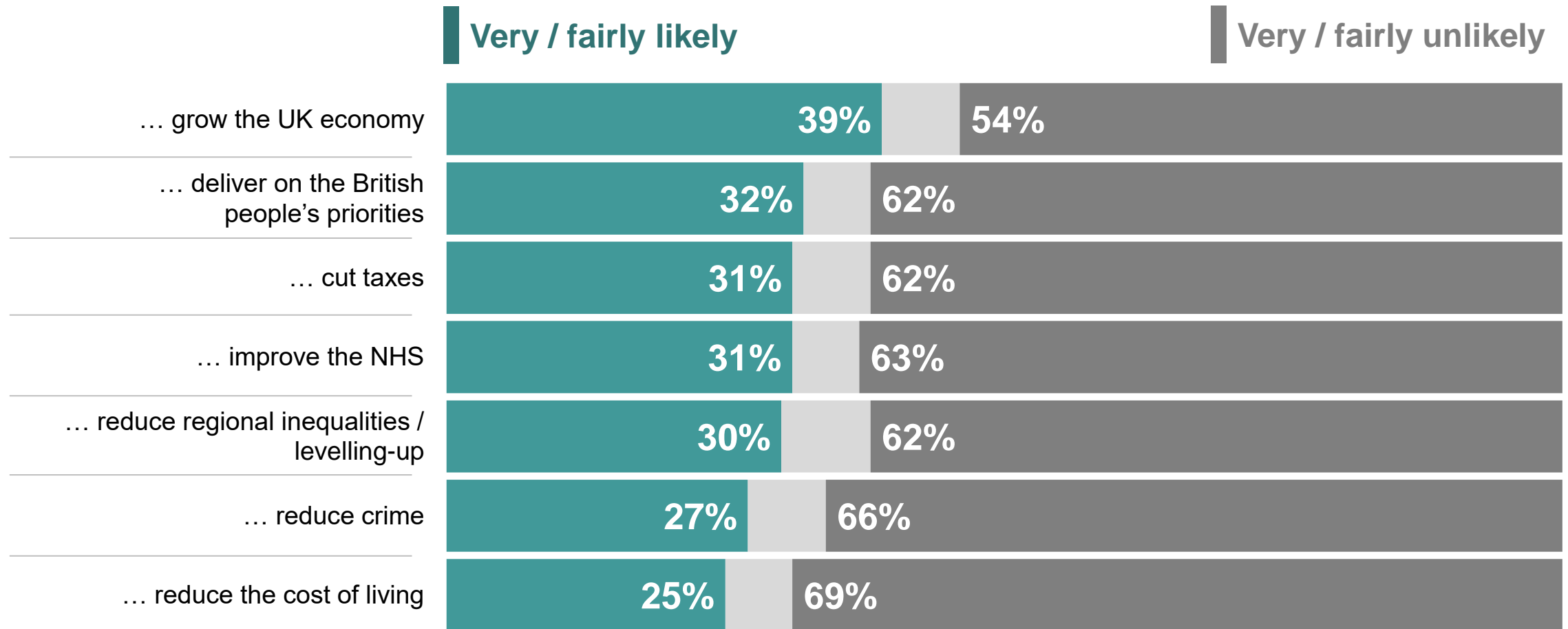
How likely or unlikely do you think it is that Boris Johnson will...?

Very / fairly unlikely

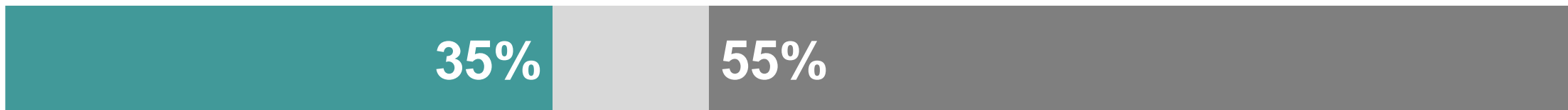

... by the end of the year?



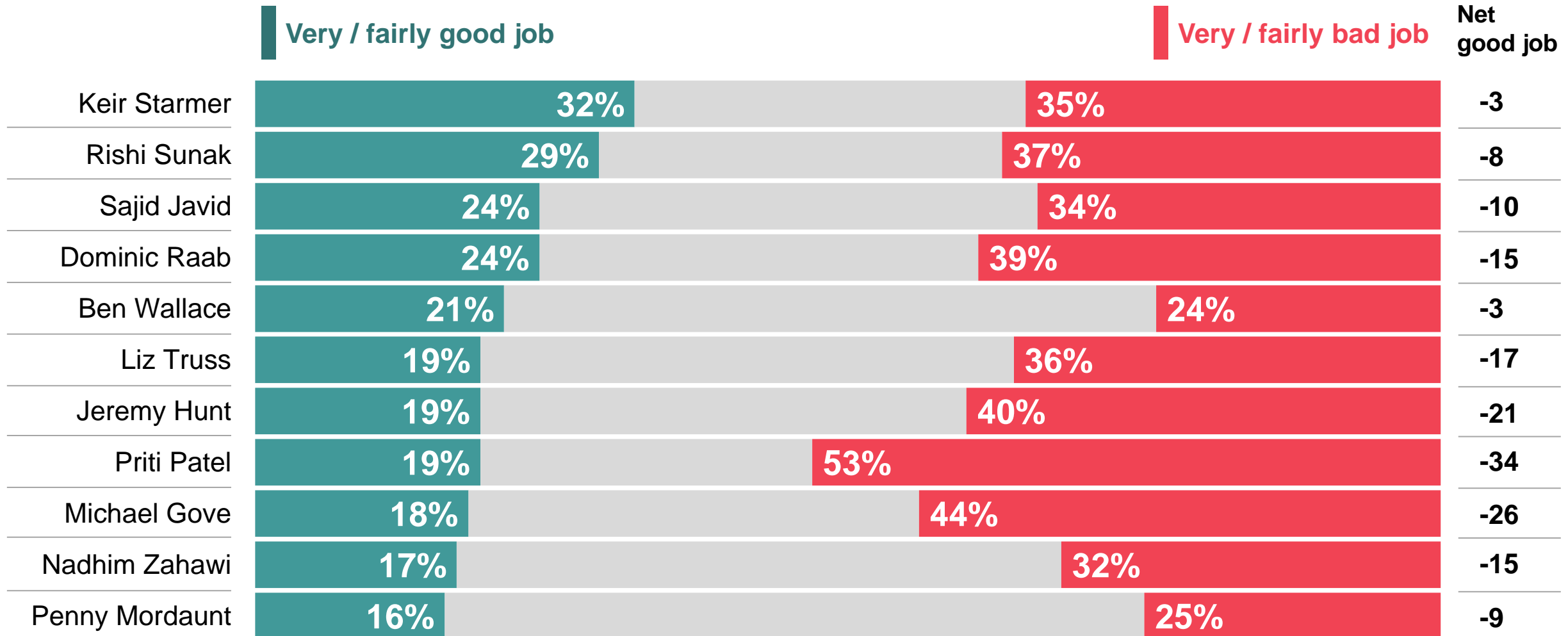

To what extent, if at all, do you think each of the following would do a good job or bad job as Prime Minister? If you do not know who the person is, then please say



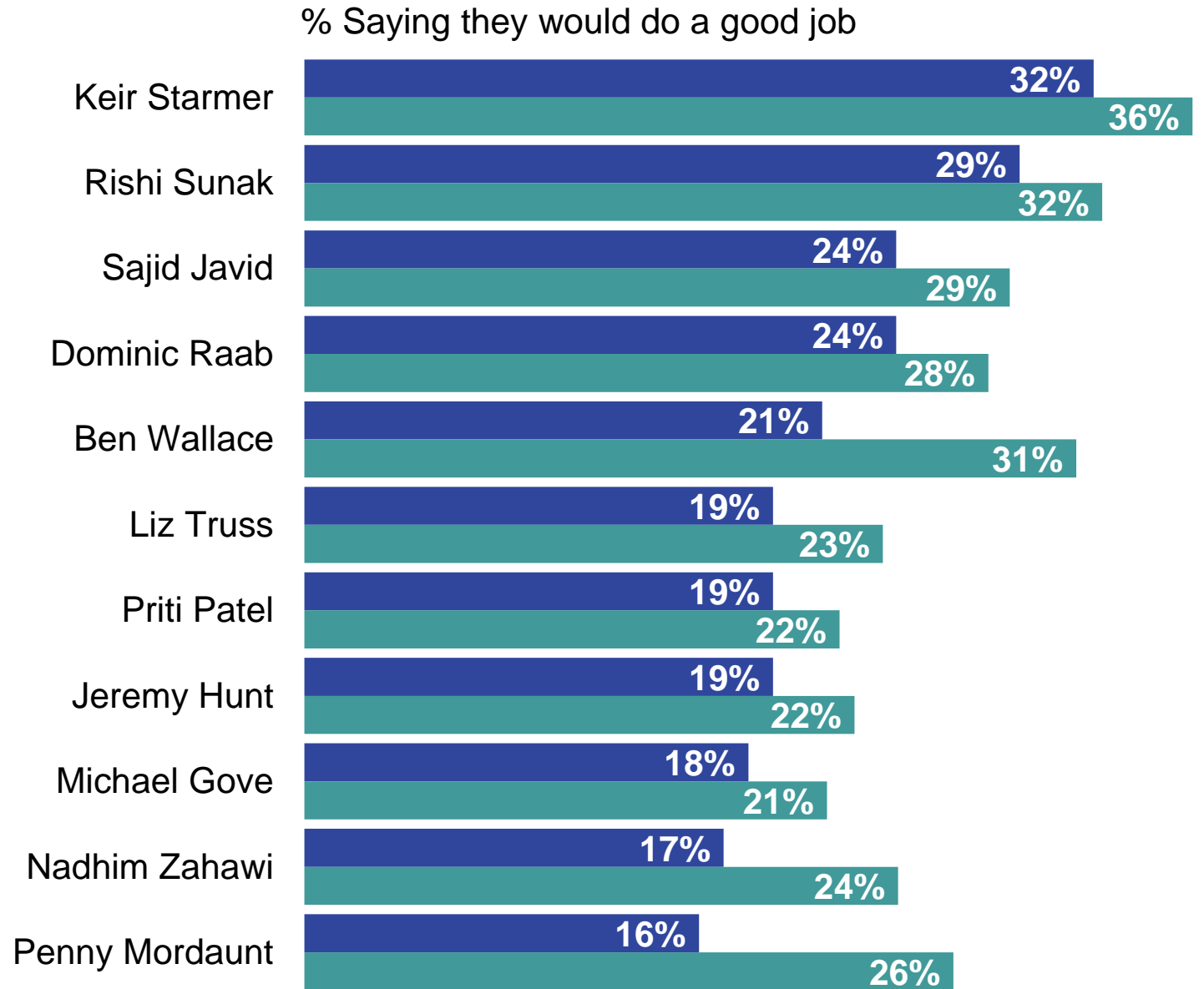
