To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties? Keir Starmer











To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties? Priti Patel














## Net favourability: Boris Johnson vs Keir Starmer























Generally speaking, do you think things in Great Britain are heading in the right direction or wrong direction?















## Impact of the UK's decision to leave the European Union







Which of the following character traits, if any, do you think are <u>most</u> important in deciding what makes a good Prime Minister?








