

As you may know there were rail strikes this week and over the weekend. From what you know, or have heard, to what extent, if at all, do you support or oppose these strikes?


Strongly / tend to support Tend to / strongly oppose 22-23 June 2022 35% 36% 20-21 June 2022 35% 35%

Younger Britons and 2019 Labour voters are more supportive of the rail strikes than older cohorts and 2019 Conservative voters


As you may know there were rail strikes this week and over the weekend. From what you know, or have heard, to what extent, if at all, do you support or oppose these strikes?
