


Direction of the country

Generally speaking, do you think things in Great Britain are heading in the right direction or wrong direction?






Over half say Boris Johnson has done a bad job as Prime Minister, up on June 2022

Based on his performance to date, would you say Boris Johnson has done a good job or bad job as Prime Minister, or neither?








Three in five say Johnson's government is doing badly at running the country, the highest for a year

Would you say that the current Conservative government, led by Prime Minister Boris Johnson, is doing well or badly at running the country, or do you not have an opinion?






Six in ten would support Boris Johnson resigning as Prime Minister, up from June 2022






Six in ten 2019 Conservative voters think Sajid Javid was right to resign

Two-thirds do not have much confidence that the UK Government is running the country properly, seriously and competently


