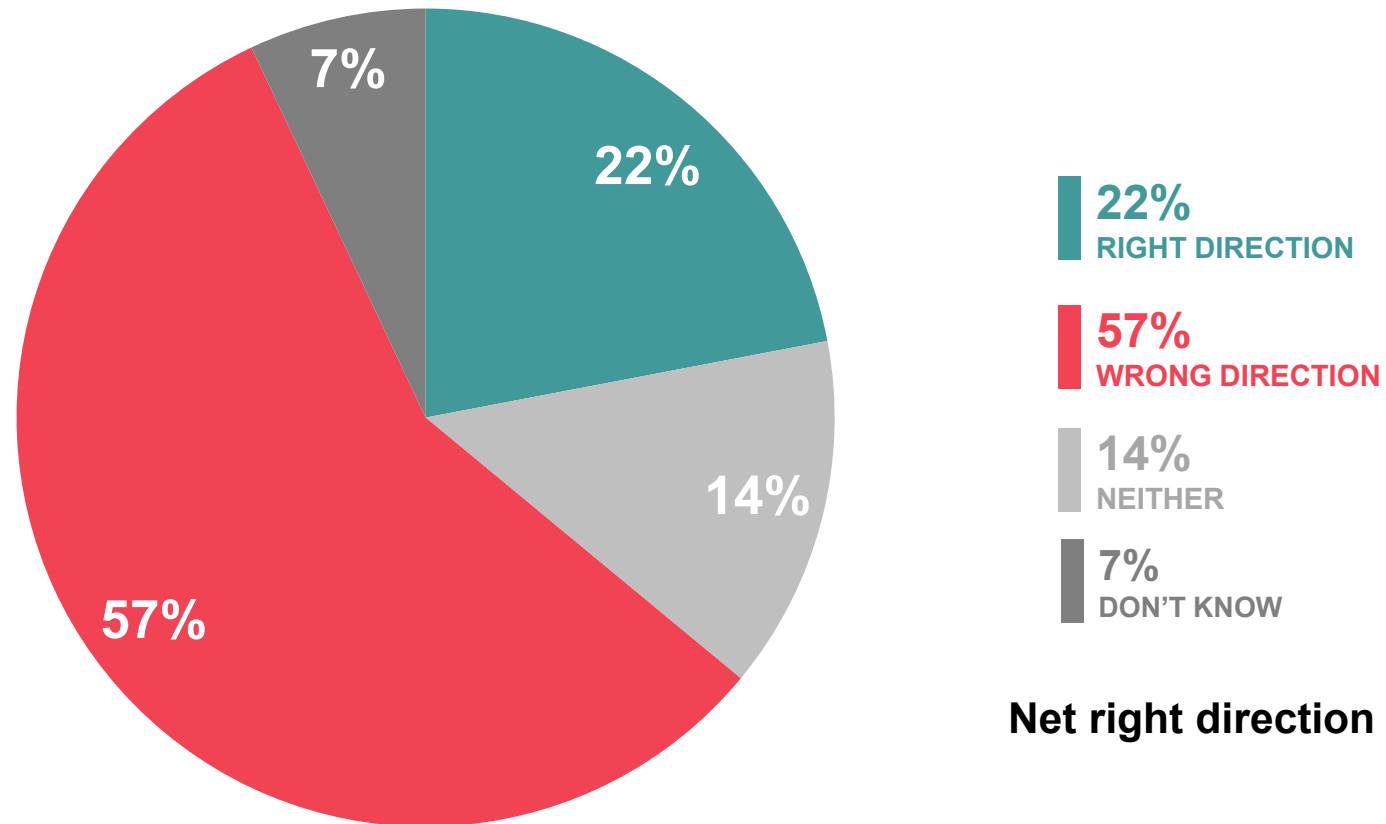

# Direction of the country

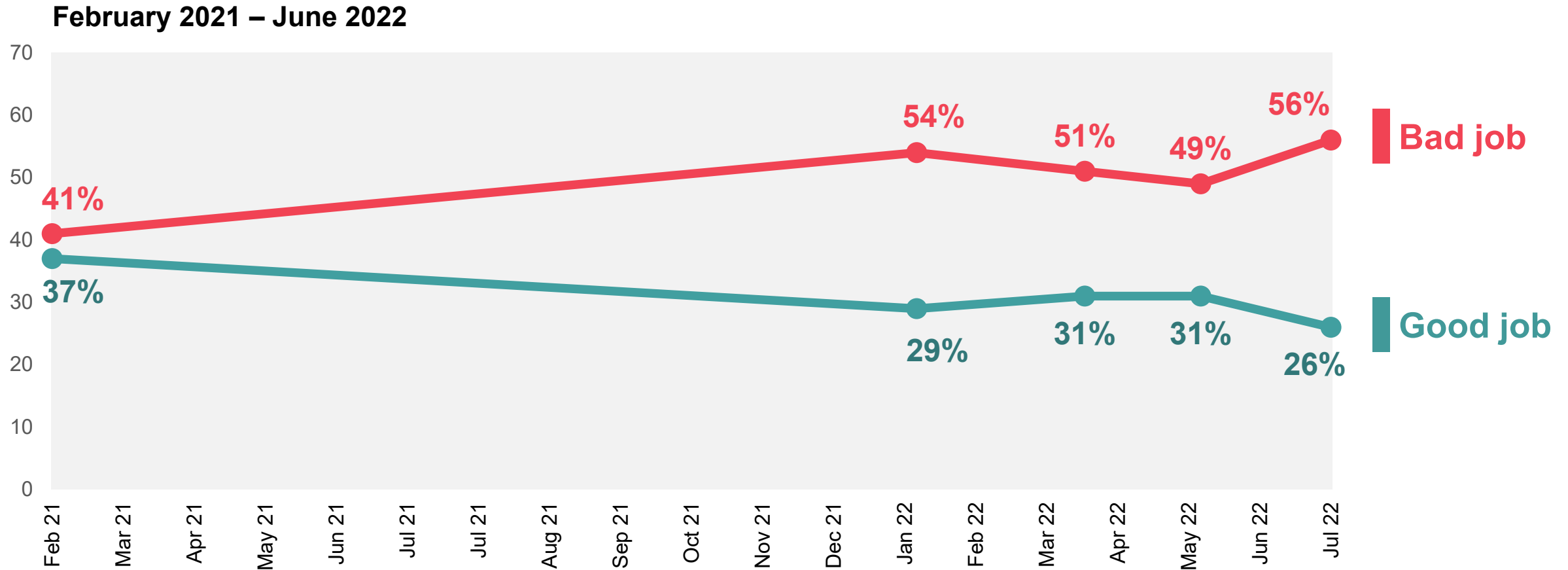
Generally speaking, do you think things in Great Britain are heading in the right direction or wrong direction?

# Over half say Boris Johnson has done a bad job as Prime Minister, up on June 2022

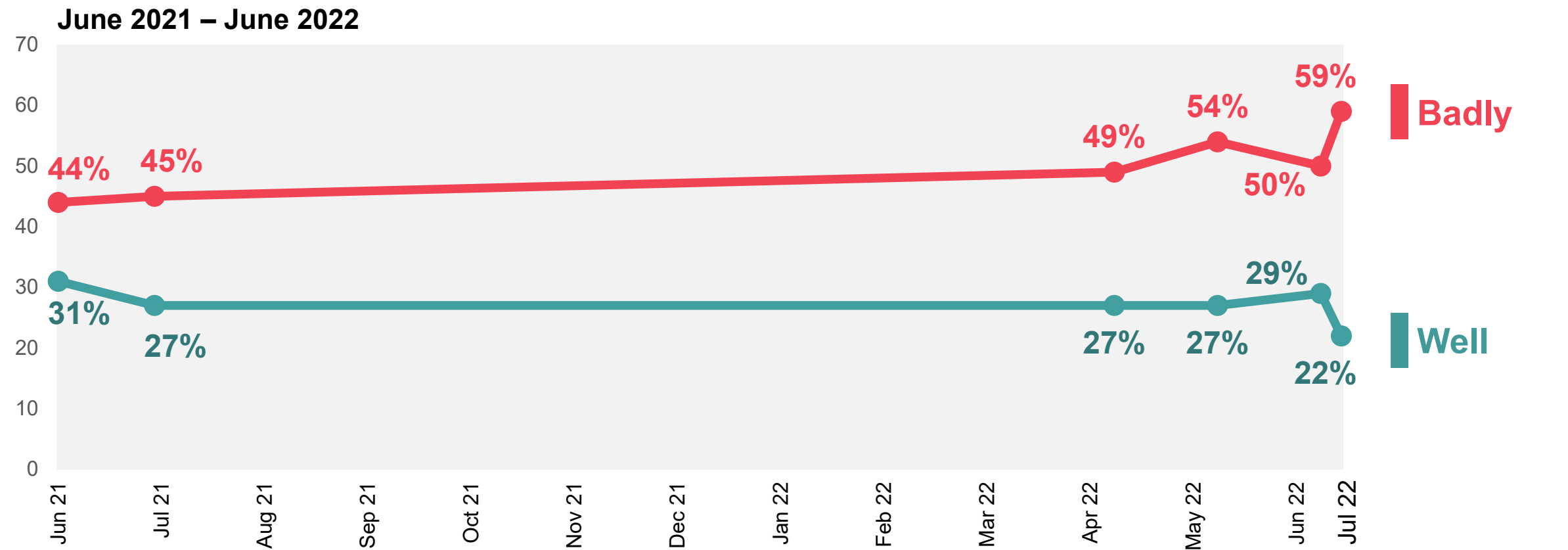
Based on his performance to date, would you say Boris Johnson has done a good job or bad job as Prime Minister, or neither?

Would you say that the current Conservative government, led by Prime Minister Boris Johnson, is doing well or badly at running the country, or do you not have an opinion?

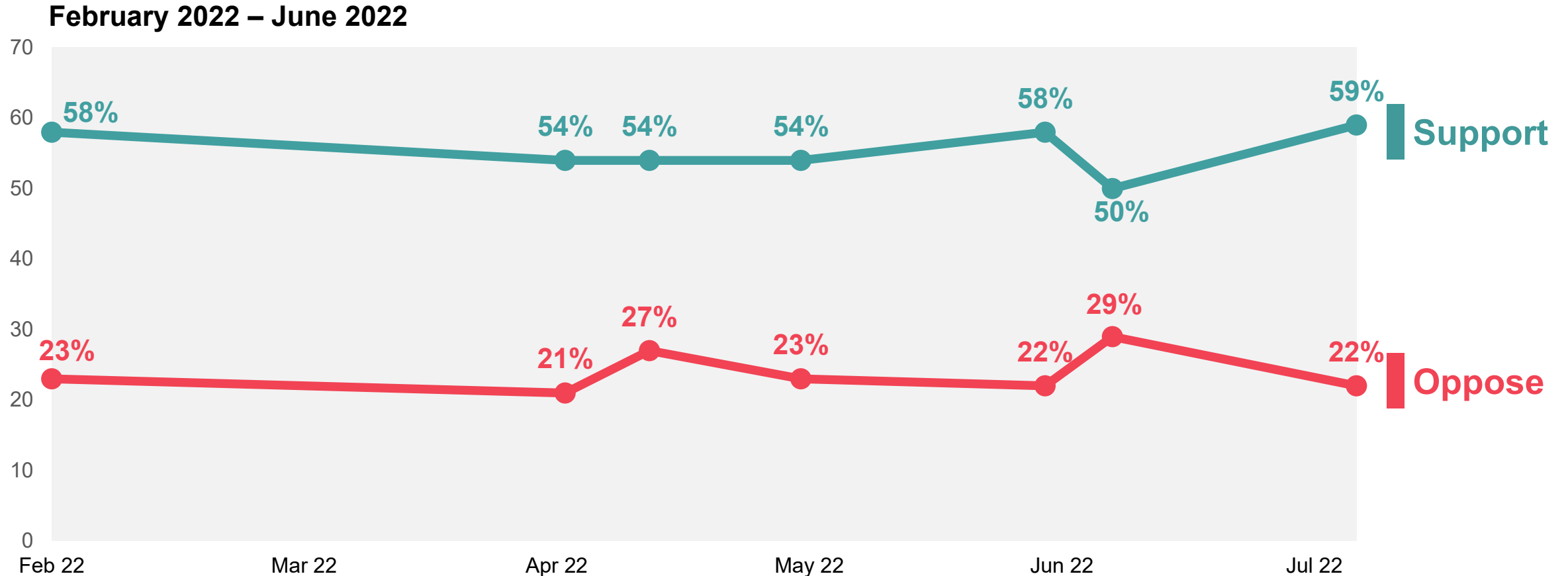

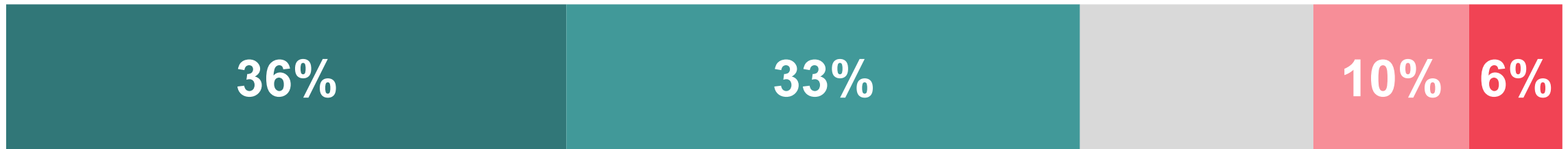

**Strongly / tend to support** **Tend to / strongly oppose**

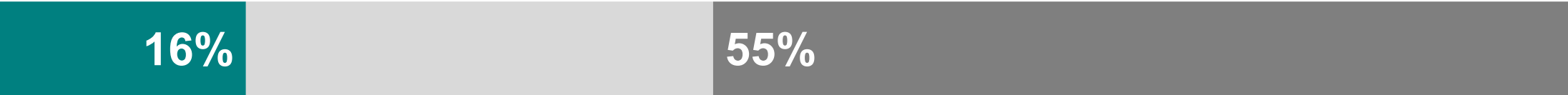

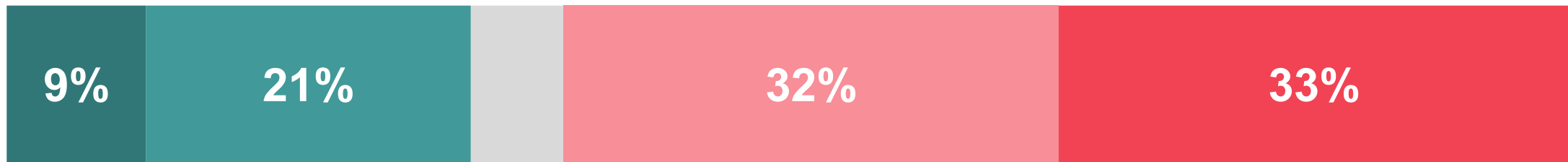


# Two-thirds of the public lack confidence that the Government is running the country properly, competently, and seriously, or with integrity.

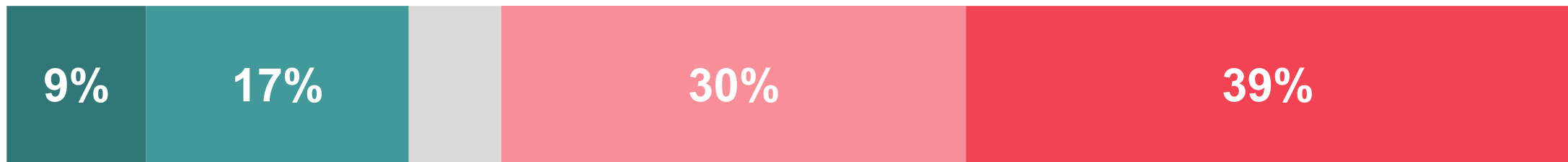
How much confidence, if any, do you have that the UK Government is running the country...?

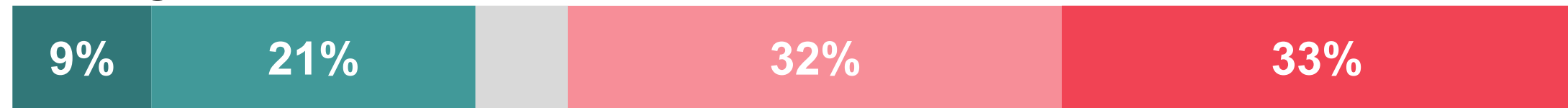


# Two-thirds do not have much confidence that the UK Government is running the country properly, seriously and competently

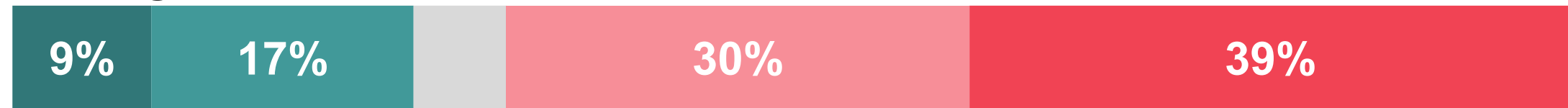
