


Half of Britons think Boris Johnson and Keir Starmer have been treated fairly by journalists and their own party's MPs

To what extent, if at all, do you think each of the following has generally treated ... fairly or unfairly during his time as Prime Minister/leader of the Labour party?








Half of 2019 Conservative voters say Boris Johnson has been treated unfairly by journalists, two in five say the same of his treatment by Conservative MPs



To what extent, if at all, would you trust each of the following to manage the cost-of-living crisis if they were Prime Minister? Would you trust them...?


