


The public say the cost of their bills and the rate of inflation impacts their cost of living the most


Which of the following, if any, would you say have the most impact on you and your family's cost of living?

How confident, if at all, are you that you could explain what economic growth means to somebody else?



Almost half of the public believe events affecting the global economy and the government's economic policies have the biggest impact on the level of Britain's economic growth


Which of the following, if any, would you say have the most impact on the level of economic growth in Britain today?






Two in five believe that increased economic growth would lead to increases in wages and more jobs being available






The public think the average person in Britain is better off financially than those in India and China, but worse off than those in Germany or the Netherlands
