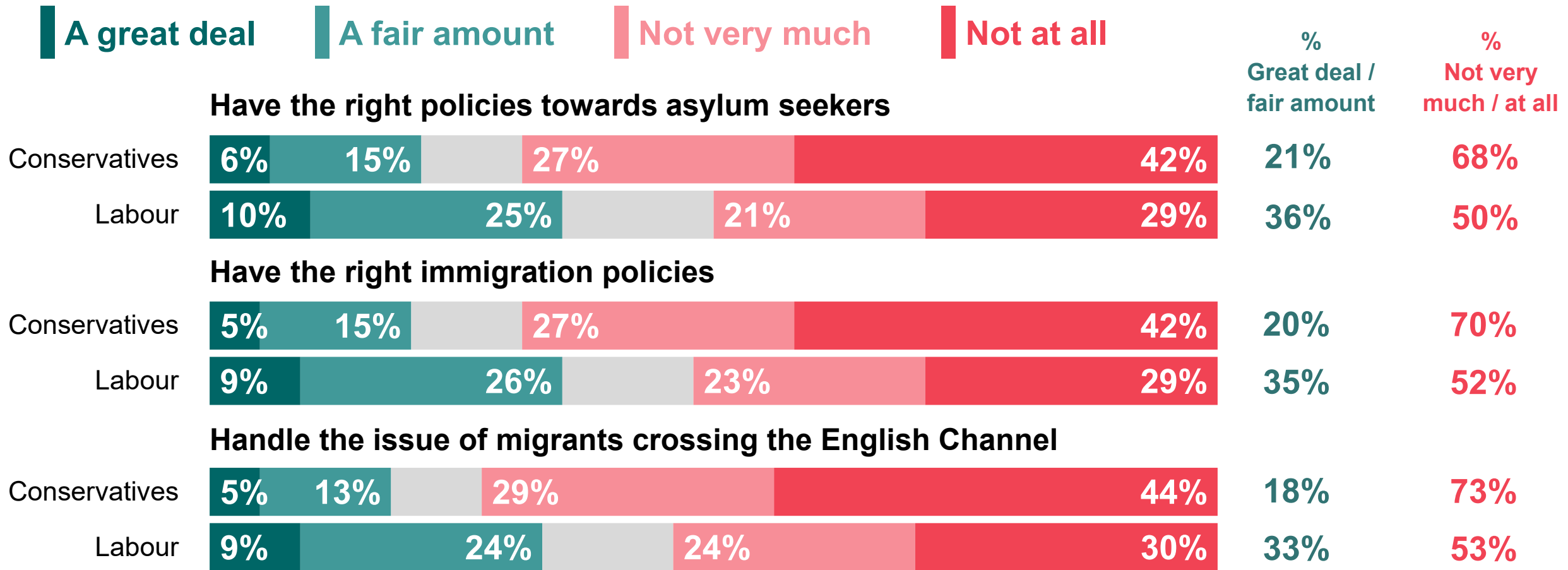

## Among 2019 Conservative party voters



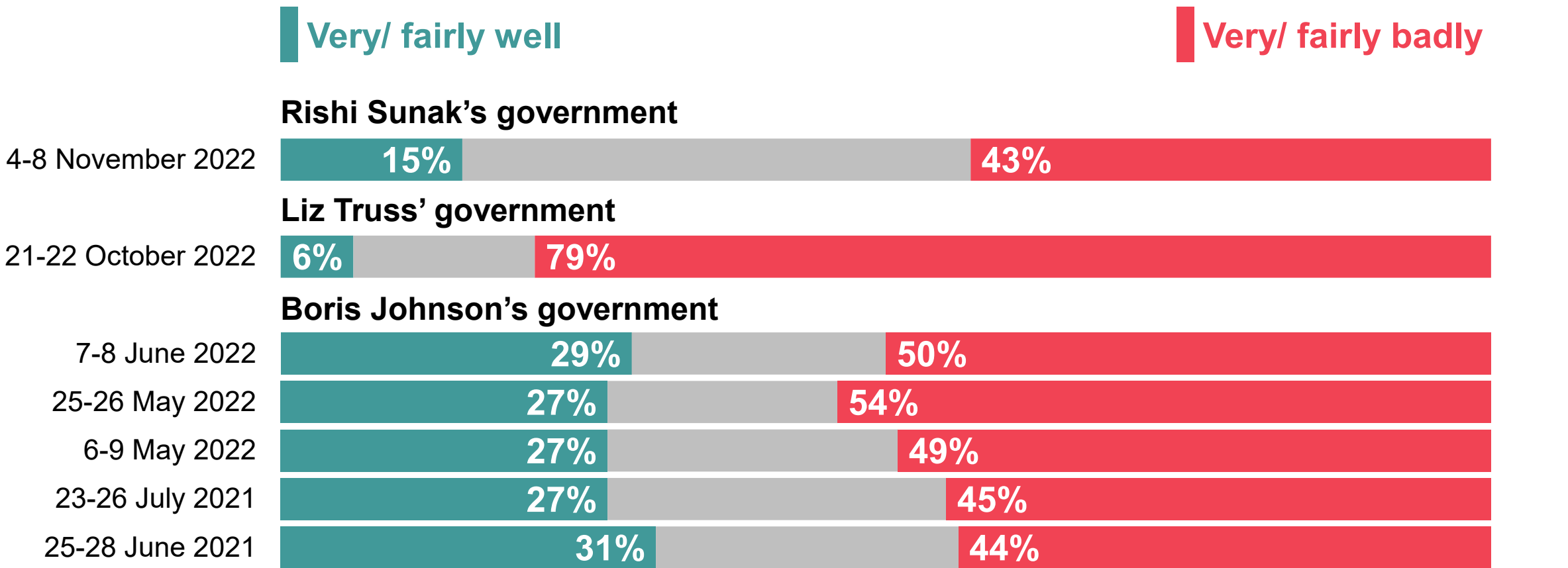

Would you say that the current Conservative government, led by Prime Minister Rishi Sunak, has done well or badly at running the country, or do you not have an opinion?

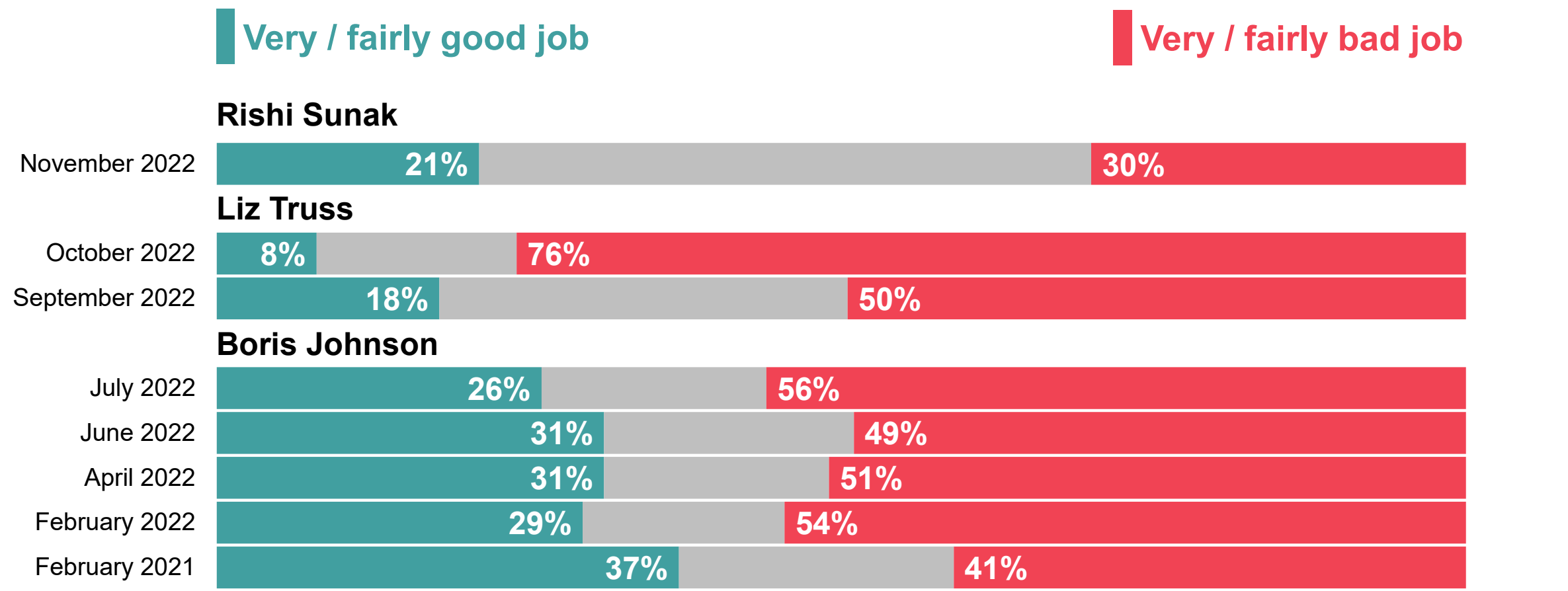

Based on his performance to date, would you say Rishi Sunak has done a good job or bad job as Prime Minister, or neither?

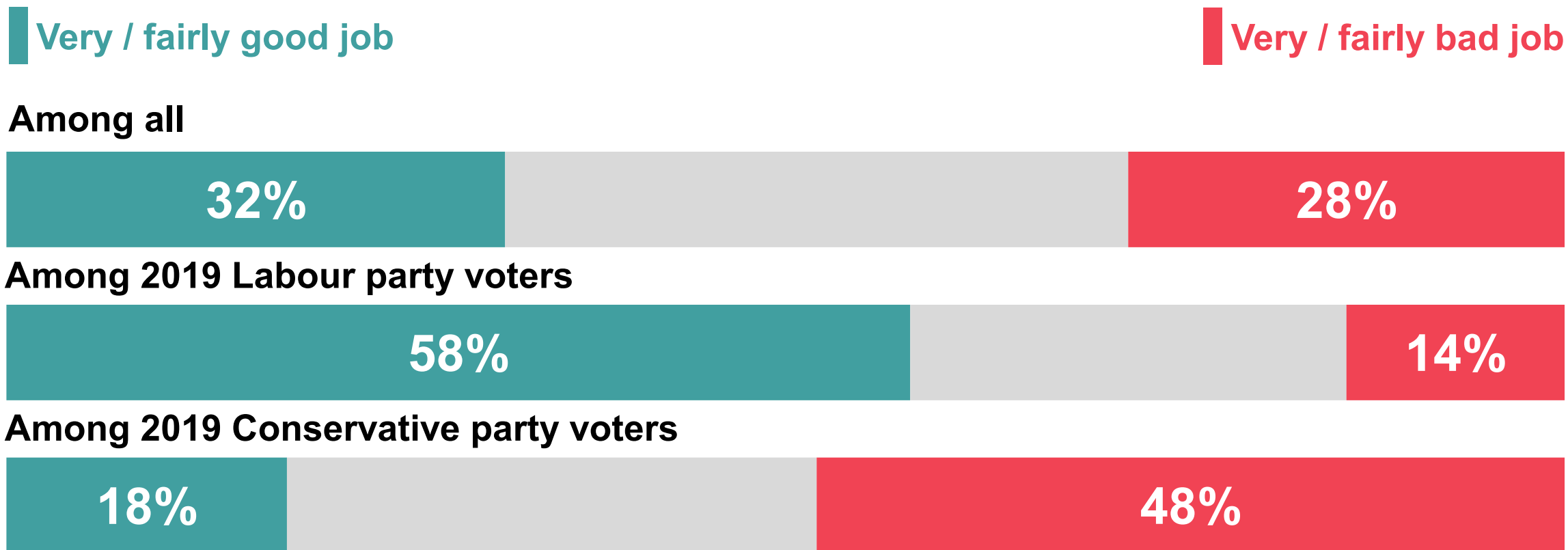
