

To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties?



To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties?





To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties? Rishi Sunak







To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties? Keir Starmer







To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties? Jeremy Hunt




























To what extent, if at all, do you have a favourable or unfavourable opinion of the following politicians and political parties? The Conservative party















Net favourable: November 2019 – January 2023








Generally speaking, do you think things in Great Britain are heading in the right direction or wrong direction?






## Direction of the country: January 2020 – January 2023

#### **Net right direction**







## Impact of the UK's decision to leave the European Union








Easing the cost of living is the public's main priority, followed by ensuring people get the NHS care they need quickly and reducing NHS waiting lists








## Expectations for Rishi Sunak's five pledges: Conservatives vs. Labour




