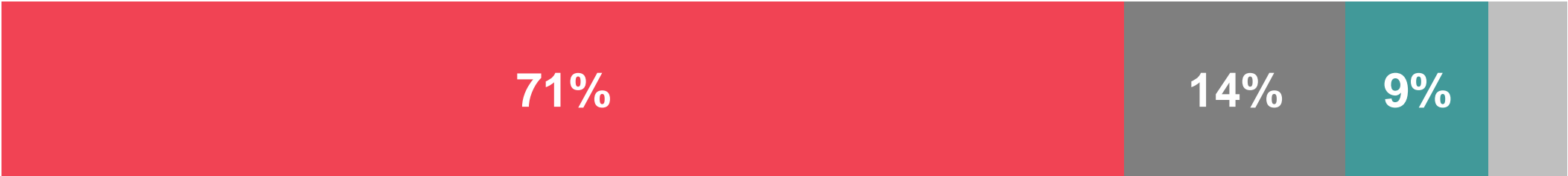

Thinking about the strikes that have been happening in Scotland in the last few months, how good or bad a job do you think the Scottish Government has done in handling these?

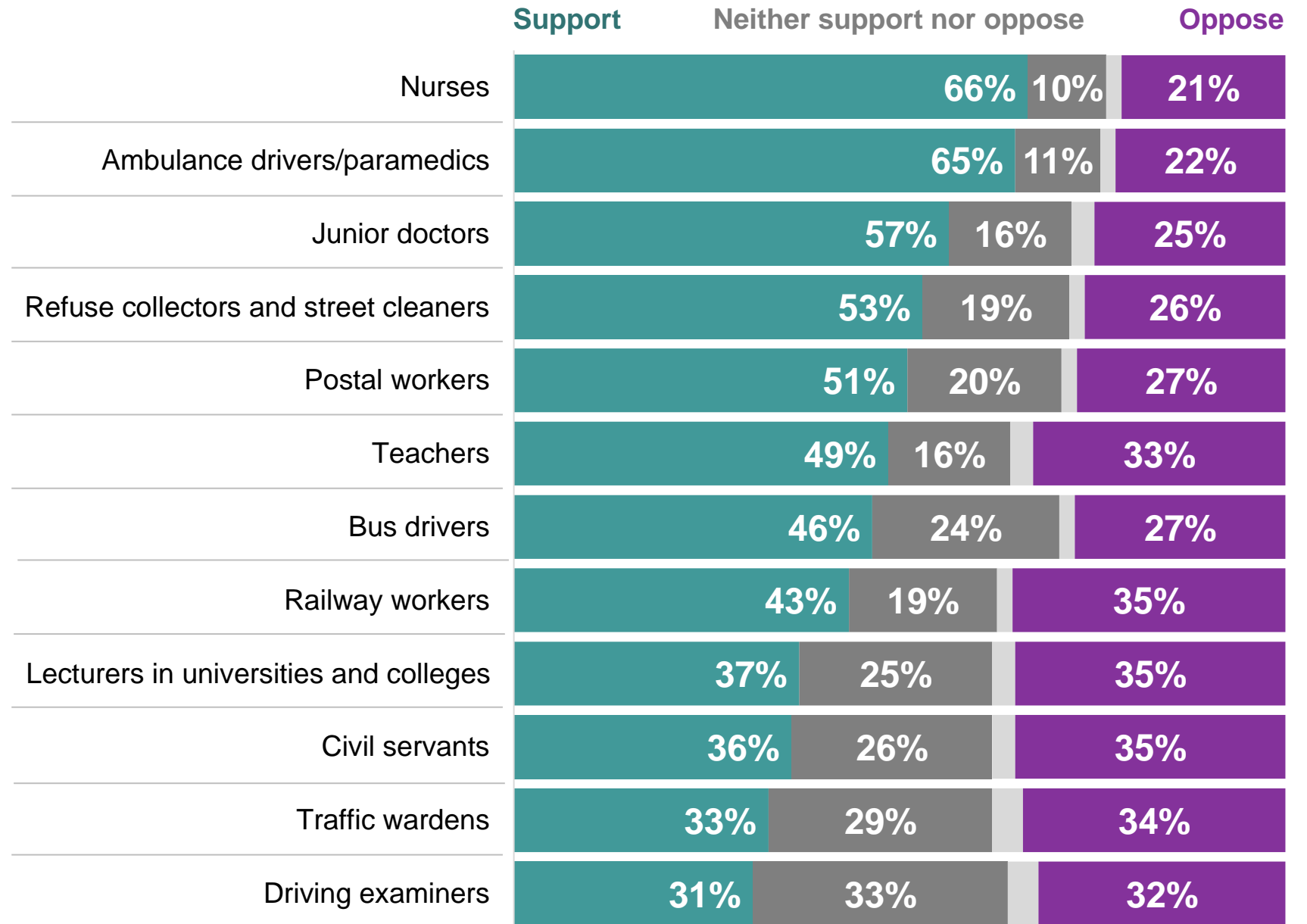


Thinking about the strikes that have been happening across England and Wales in the last few months, how good or bad a job do you think the UK Government has done in handling these?



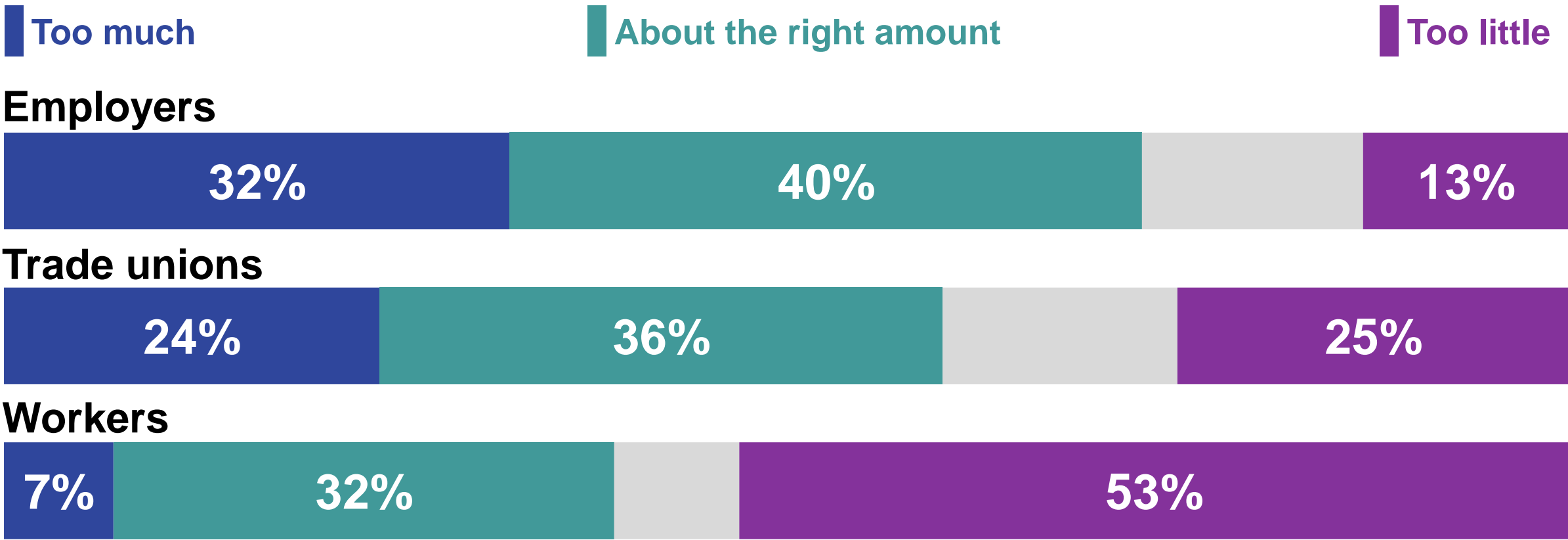

Do you think the following have too much, too little, or about the right amount of power in Scotland today?

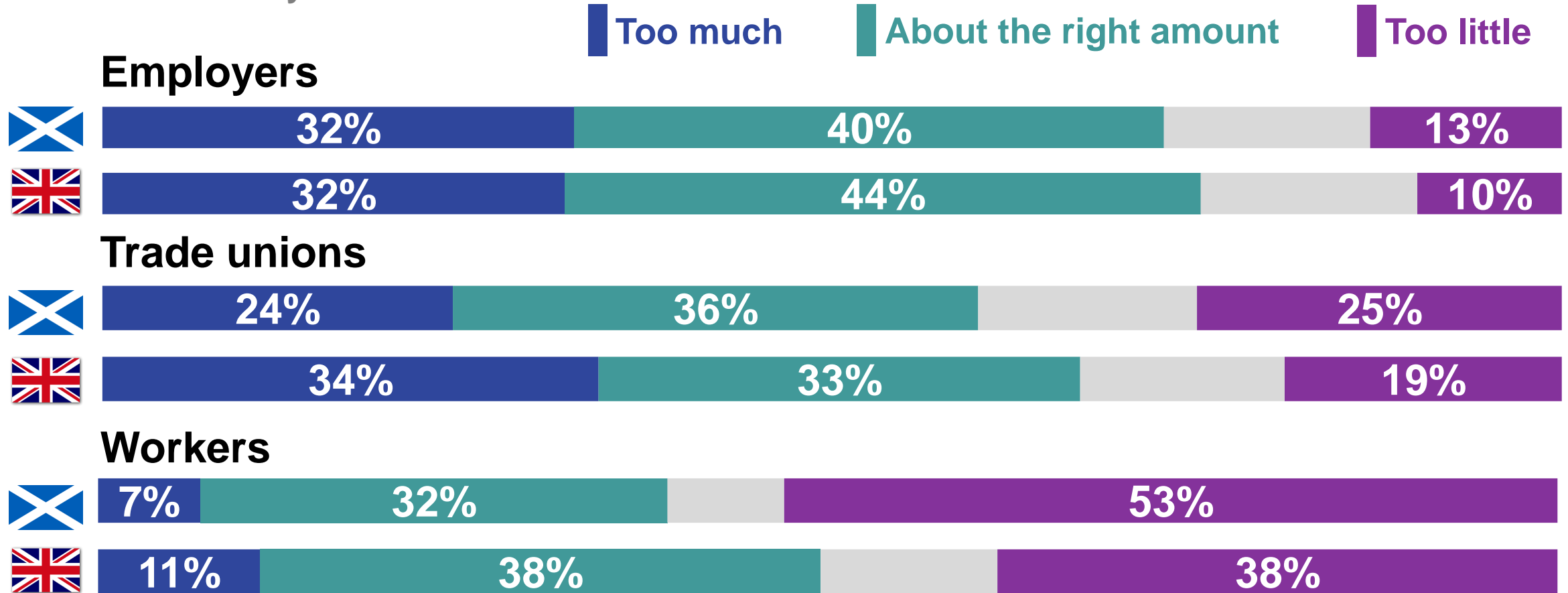
